Carmela and Daytona Lady are others with strong form claims, while Pillow Talk also makes the shortlist.

Parachute may benefit from first-time blinkers, while Skilled Warrior is interesting on his debut for Grant Tuer.

That being said, Search For A Song defeated him at Ascot in the Long Distance Cup in 2020, only to be outdone by Trueshan in the final stages. She has won a Group 3 at the Curragh since, but

may want slightly further to flourish nowadays. Tashkhan was far from disgraced during his last outing, but his track record at York isn't as impressive.
