Race Summary: Competitive. All of READY TO FLY, BROADWAY GIRL, QANABI, ONLY HEARTS and VIRGINIA SWEET have shown promise. BROADWAY GIRL found her debut a bit short and should relish this trip. Can go close. ONLY HEARTS has been getting going too late over shorter and is another who should come on in leaps and bounds over this distance. READY TO FLY was beaten under a length when running around the bend on debut and could be anything. She has drawn best of the above mentioned and could attract the most support. VIRGINIA SWEET knows this track and trip but has drawn widest.

CAN'T CATCH ME needed her debut learning experience and should improve but LITTLE MISS KJ finished ahead of her and has drawn better. It could get close. The latter's stablemate, HOLD MY HAND, is a well-bred filly who is likely to attract support. More first-timers in it - follow the betting closely.

But Highveld raider FLOREANA ISLAND has fair form and has early speed so could get away from her field on local debut. She has drawn well alongside SLURRICANE. KING'S SPEAR has run two good seconds in a row and could get rewarded if not minding the switch to turf. NDAKA is better on the turf and could also get his act together.

She wasn't far off star three-year-old Rain In Holland and rates a big chance. KEEP ON DANCING is a lot better than her last try at this venue and has drawn well. CAPETOWN BEAUTY is an improving youngster - watch out.

GAINSFORD is another who may yet not have shown how good he really is. CRIMSON KING, SHAMPOMPO SHAMPIZI, CROWN TOWERS and TRISTFUL are capable.
