- **2. WITTELSBACH -** Decent 5th on debut in a Conditional over 1600m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on the 8th of September 2025. Good place chance
- **3. AU DELA DES MERS -** Tough 6th in a Conditional over 1600m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on the 8th of September 2025. Others preferred
- **4. WOOD LAND -** Finished 6th in a maiden over 1600m at Toulouse on the 24th of September 2025. Top choices are more attractive

Summary: MY CALYX CEN (7) put up a cracking effort on debut when finishing second over the course and distance and firmly looks the right candidate that will take a power of beating here. WITTELSBACH (2) delivered a decent educational effort on debut and with the experience under the belt, he can definitely hold a solid podium place. CIAO NENE (5) is another candidate that can run into the places in this small field. WESTMINSTER COYOTE (6) completes the mix.

- **4. BELLA JOSEPHINE -** Supplemented Bella Josephine finished 6th in a Claimer at Pompadour on the 31st of August 2025. One to overlook

However, VALTRADA (5) did finish ahead of the top choice and could be a major threat again. LANA ZAIN (2) was encouraging on debut when running fifth and could finish closer this time around. LADY SOFIA (11) wraps up the mix.

- **3. BECHO -** Finished 8th in a Class 3 Handicap over 1600m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on the 29th of September 2025. Larger quartets contender
- **4. STARECTO -** Finished 8th in his penultimate start over 3000m in a Class 4 Handicap at Dax. Others preferred on form

- **2. DAKOVKA -** Pleasing 3rd in a Class 4 Handicap over 1600m at Toulouse on the 24th of September 2025. Include in all plays
- **3. DAYSANIYA -** Sweet 3rd in a Class 4 Handicap over 2000m at La Teste-Bassin Arcachon on the 25th of September 2025. Good each way shout
- **4. GUERREIRA -** Finished 3rd in a Handicap over 1600m at San Sebastian on the 31st of August 2025. Meets a tougher field this time
- **5. ANGEL CHARLY -** Bold winner in a Class 4 Conditional over 2100m at Dax on the 13th of September 2025. Can follow up

Summary: ANGEL CHARLY (5) comes into the race off a strong win and can follow up on her last performance in this type of race. DAYSANIYA (3) is in fine shape and never far off the action. If the top choices fluffs her lines, this filly could easily have the upper hand and claim victory. AFRICAN GREY (11) is always in the thick of things and a similar effort can be expected. DAKOVKA (2) deserves some serious consideration after running two consecutive solid thirds.

- **1. NATIONAL SERVICE -** Disappointing form of late and finished 7th in a Group 3 at Baden-Baden over 1200m on 31 August. Better judged when winning over this course and distance in June. Not out of it
- **2. MAJOR OAK -** Unreliable and ran 9th in a Conditions race at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 5 October. Did better over this track and trip before that and could earn some money
- **3. SWEET CHOP -** A winner last time out of a Conditions race over this track and trip on 25 September. Can be a danger off this handicap mark
- **4. FORCHESTER -** In good form of late and finished third in a handicap over this track and trip on 20 September. Can be competitive yet again
- **5. TERRITORYWAR -** Only modest of late and was fifth in a handicap over this course and distance on 20 September. Might play a minor role
- **6. TERTIUS -** Very consistent and was a runner-up in a handicap over this course and distance on 20 September. Can go one better in this competitive race
- **7. FORZA CAPITANO -** Only modest of late and finished 9th in a handicap over this course and distance on 20 September. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- **8. TORPEN -** In good form and was a winner of a handicap over this track and trip on 20 September. Carries a 3kg penalty but is not out of it
- **9. TUDO BEM -** Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a claimer at this track over 1100m on 30 September. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **10. STORMYGO -** Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in a handicap at Le Lion-d'Angers over 1400m on 20 September. Could earn some more money

Summary: A very competitive opening event. TERTIUS (6) always gives of his best and will be right there at the finish yet again. A winning turn, perhaps? SIMPLY LOVELY (11) struggled at Deauville but is much better at this track and can contest the finish. FORCHESTER (4) is usually very competitive and is clearly not out of it in this line-up. NATIONAL SERVICE (1) has to give weight to all his rivals but does like this track and trip. SWEET CHOP (3) could also be a danger off this handicap mark.

- **1. SENEQUE -** A good winner of a Conditions race over this track and trip on 25 September. Big chance to follow up
- **2. LYNEHAM -** A winner on debut in a Conditions race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1600m on 8 September. Tougher task but may well be up to it
- **3. IMPERIOR -** Showed promise when a winner on debut in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 1300m on 12 September. Can challenge for top honours
- **4. CHILL Y FLAMA -** A good third in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 26 September. Can be competitive once again
- **5. BOURG ACHARD -** Finished 7th on debut in a Conditions race over this track and trip on 15 September. Needs to do a bit more to win
- **6. ST MARKSMAN -** Showed some improvement and was fifth in a Conditions race over this coursea and distance on 15 September. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **7. LADY STARLIGHT -** Has not show much and was 8th in a Conditions race at this track over 1000m on 14 April. Returns from a break and needs to find a few lengths to win

Summary: SÉNÈQUE (1) showed improvement after a promising debut and was a good winner over this course and distance. He looks likely to follow up. IMPERIOR (3) did all that was needed to win on debut, and the runner-up has won since. LYNEHAM (2) won well at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat on debut and could be anything. CHILL Y FLAMA (4) did beat SÉNÈQUE (1) before, so cannot be written off from winning this as well.

- **1. OTHON -** Not disgraced when fourth in a claimer at Dax over 1400m on 21 September. Can get involved with the finish once again
- **2. MONCLAR -** Has run well twice, the latest when fourth in a Conditions race at Salon-de-Provence over 1800m on 30 September. Should be a threat at this level
- **3. STRONG TEA -** Finished 9th on debut in a claimer at this track over 1400m on 30 September. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **4. AMELIA -** Only four of late and was fifth in a claimer at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1100m on 6 October. Has won twice in this division and is not out of it
- **5. STUDEN KLADENETS -** A two-year-old colt by Kircaali out of Karamelek who makes his debut. Watch the betting for clues
- **6. PLAY THE GAME -** Not disgraced when fifth in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 26 September. Has a place chance in this line-up
- **7. ROSE PRAIRIE** Very consistent and was fourth in a claimer at Argentan over 1900m on 8 October. Capable of making the frame
- **8. CLAUDIA CHOP -** Finished 6th on debut in a claimer at Dax over 1400m on 21 September. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- **9. ALINKA -** A winner of a claimer at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 3 September. Looks capable of doubling up in this line-up
- **10. ASPRILA -** A two-year-old filly by Territories out of Dutch Shadow who makes her debut. Her Dam never raced. Watch the betting

Summary: ALINKA (9) showed improvement when dropped to this division and was a good winner at Lyon-Parilly. She sets the standard for the race. MONCLAR (2) was not disgraced in his two starts so far and would not be a surprise winner on his first run in a claimer. ASPRILA (10) has already won a couple of claimers and can be right there in the mix of things. OTHON (1) was not disgraced at Dax and can shine again.

- **1. LE CENTRAL -** In good shape and was third in a handicap at this track over 1100m on 2 October. Can be competitive once again
- **2. TREMBLANT -** Did not show his best when 7th in a handicap over this track and trip on 20 September. Be right there at the finish this time
- **3. KOULIKORO -** Has struggled of late and finished 8th in a handicap at Vichy over 1400m on 22 September. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **4. JUMANO -** Unreliable but was runner-up in a handicap at Craon over 1300m on 28 September. Can get involved with the finish
- **5. BOKEN -** Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a handicap at this track over 1100m on 2 October. Needs major improvement to win
- **6. KHAN -** Only modest of late and was unplaced in a handicap at this track over 1100m on 1 September. Can be a threat off this handicap mark
- **7. BLUE DREAM -** Much improved of late and was a winner of a handicap at this track over 1100m on 2 October. Carries a 4kg penalty but can follow up
- **8. AIR DE SAMBA -** Unreliable and was uplaced in a handicap over this track and trip on 2 October. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **9. LES TROIS VALLEES -** Battling to find best form and was 9th in a handicap at this track over 1100m on 2 October. Capable of better but others make more appeal
- **10. COLD PLAY -** Battling to regain best form and was unplaced in a handicap at Compiegne over 1600m on 24 September. Unreliable but might play a minor role
- **11. SHADE -** Only modest of late and was 10th in a handicap at Fontainebleau over 1000m on 21 September. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

Summary: BLUE DREAM (7) has made significant improvement of late. He will need to overcome a 4kg penalty for his latest win but may well be up to it. TREMBLANT (2) seems better than his last run over this course and distance and could be the threat. LE CENTRAL (1) has been doing very well of late and can challenge for top honours again. KHAN (6) has struggled recently but is capable of winning off a dropping handicap mark.

- **1. ANSSIO -** Not disgraced when fifth in a Conditions race at Vichy over 2000m on 22 September. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal
- **2. VEGETALE -** Did not show her best when unplaced in a handicap at Deauville over 1600m on 19 August. Has done well on this surface and could earn some money
- **3. AL MAX -** Has improved of late and was a winner of a Conditions race at this track over 1600m on 1 September. Can double up trying a handicap
- **4. GEOPOLITICAL** Very consistent so far and was third in a Conditions race at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 1600m on 8 August. Can be a serious threat first time in a handicap
- **5. HAZA -** Did not show his best when 8th in a handicap at this track over 1600m on 30 September. Capable of better and could play a minor role
- **6. MON COMEDIEN -** Did not show his best when 9th in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 2000m on 9 October. Has won at this course and is not out of it
- **7. MINO GALESTE -** Has struggled of late and was 10th in a handicap at this track over 1600m on 30 September. Capable of a a surprise back on this surface
- **8. BOTICELLI -** Very consistent and was a runner-up in a handicap at this track over 1600m on 30 September. Can go one better trying this surface
- **9. GOLDEN ALQA -** Knocking at the door and was runner-up in a claimer at Lyon-La Soie over 2150m on 3 October. Has a place chance in this line-up
- **10. RIDE ON -** Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a handicap at this track over 1600m on 30 September. Needs to do more to win this race
- **11. KHYRILOVITCH -** Only modest of late and was unplaced in a claimer at this track over 1600m on 1 September. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

Summary: BOTICELLI (8) is clearly capable of winning off his current mark. The only question he has to answer is whether he can show that form on this surface. GEOPOLITICAL (4) has yet to win but has been very consistent so far and should be a threat on handicap debut. AL MAX (3) picked up a confidence-boosting win and is a possible contender now trying a handicap. NEUSCHWANSTEIN (15) has won on the PSF, so is another to consider.

- **2. LISIPPO -** Has yet to show much and was unplaced in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 2000m on 3 June. Needs to do more to win this race
- **3. LA FERRETCAPIENNE -** Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in a handicap at La Testa-du-Buch over 1400m on 25 September. Yet to win a race but can go one better
- **4. FADO -** Only modest of late and finished 6th in a claimer at this track over 1900m on 20 September. Could earn some minor money
- **5. STAR OF ARTABAN -** Has only been modest so far and finished 6th in a handicap at Fontainebleau over 2200m on 21 September. Capable of improvement and has a place chance
- **6. ZAMPANU -** Did not show his best when 8th in a Conditions race at Royan La Palmyre over 1600m on 20 September. Should be a threat back in a handicap and trying this surface
- **7. PONY BOY -** Unreliable and was unplaced in a handicap at this track over 1600m on 30 September. Did better before that and could be a lively danger
- **8. BEECHCRAFT -** Only modest of late and ran 6th in a handicap at Deauville over 1500m on 30 August. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- **9. PIECE MAITRESSE -** Did not show her best when 10th in a claimer at Nort-sur-Erdre over 2500m on 5 October. Yet to win a race but might play a minor role
- **10. QUI EVIDAMENT QUI -** Unreliable and was uplaced in a handicap at Fontainebleau over 2200m on 21 September. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **11. TIME TO GALI -** Has struggled of late and was 9th in a claimer at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 8 October. More is needed to win this race
- **12. DOUBLE JEU -** Has really struggled this year and was unplaced in a handicap at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 1400m on 2 July. Needs major improvement to win
- **13. CIACCINO -** Only modest of lare and finished 7th in a handicap at Amiens over 1650m on 28 September. Yet to win a race and others make more appeal
- **14. MISTER BRYAN -** Battling to find best form and finished 8th in a claimer at Angers over 2100m on 22 September. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **15. IMAYA -** Did not show her best when 9th in a handicap at Deauville over 1500m on 30 August. Seems better on the grass but is not out of it

Summary: TWARAB (1) needs to prove that he is as good on this surface, but he has also been in very good form of late and gets the vote to score. LA FERRETCAPIENNE (3) is in very good shape and looking to break the ice after 32 starts without success. IMAYA (15) has not shown her best form on this surface but is capable of winning a race of this nature. ZAMPANU (6) was runner-up in a handicap on his penultimate start and can go one better.
