### Seoul Race 3: Class 5 (1400M) Handicap / KRW 45 Million

Fillies and mares only (1) RAON THE BELMONT had a poor day at the office last time out February 8<sup>th</sup> when only making it to midfield and never traveling. We'll draw a line through that and instead go on her class and distance win two starts back on December 28<sup>th</sup> and in this more limited company, give her another chance. (4) FINAL JILJU ran 2<sup>nd</sup> at big odds at class and distance on February 14<sup>th</sup> and while up 2kg in weight, can aim to repeat. (5) POETIC NUBI enters with recent form reading adequately and that's enough to have her among the place chances. (7) HAKSAN DAESE and (3) RED DRAGON others who can pick up in what is a weak race and where all of what passes for early speed is drawn wide.

### Busan Race 2: Class 6 (1400M) Special Weight A / KRW 30 Million

(8) SUCCESS DAY has been getting closer across his four starts so far, culminating in 2<sup>nd</sup> on his first try at this distance on February 13<sup>th</sup> when handy throughout. He can be on pace here and can go one better. Solitary debut-maker (2) WONDERFUL FASHION went through two trials, settling back in one and showing at the front in the other and finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> in both. He draws well to get forward early and can put in a bold showing in this company. (9) CARAT KING enters off a best to date 2<sup>nd</sup> at this distance on March 1<sup>st</sup>. He makes a quick return and an apprentice claiming 3kg keeps him competitive. (11) DOKKI TIGER and (6) ROYAL CRYSTAL others in the placing frame.

### Seoul Race 4: Class 5 (1300M) Handicap / KRW 45 Million

(10) CONCORD BLUE was a winner on debut over 1200M in January before running 3<sup>rd</sup> on his first try at this class over 1400M on February 8<sup>th</sup>. He draws wide here but should have enough about him early to get to the lead, and he is the one to beat. (9) ROAD TO STAR has a 3<sup>rd</sup> and a 4<sup>th</sup> in two starts at this level since getting his maiden win back in December. He can settle

behind the early speed here and be a threat late on. (5) LOVERMAN comes up in class having scored his maiden win at this distance on February 14<sup>th</sup>. The time wasn't quick, but he is down 2kg in weight and he can be competitive. (4) BLISS STAR and (6) THUNDER MARVEL are others in the hunt.

### **Busan Race 3: Class 5 (1400M) Handicap / KRW 45 Million**

(9) BUNKER BUSTER got his maiden win at start two at the end of January and then came desperately close to following up when 2<sup>nd</sup> on his first try at this class and distance on February 27<sup>th</sup>. He comes up 1.5kg in weight, but he will be on pace, and he is favoured to go one better today. (1) BREEDO ARENA came from off the pace to win over this distance two starts back and while she only finished midfield over 1300M on her first try at this level two weeks ago, she carries a light weight and can be in the finish here. (11) DREAM RACER has beaten a couple of today's rivals in both his latest two outings, most recently when 4<sup>th</sup> at this class and distance on February 1<sup>st</sup> and should beat plenty again. (12) SUCCESS COW and (3) TIP TAP others with place chances.

### **Seoul Race 5: Class 4 (1600M) Handicap / KRW 60 Million**

(8) GLOBAL HAMSEONG was a winner at class 5 level over 1300M two starts back before running 5<sup>th</sup> of ten on his first try at this class and distance on February 14<sup>th</sup> when coming from well back. He can settle back again here and could prove too strong late on. (7) MUSKET CLEAVER had a hard time when drawn in the widest gate over 1700M on his first try at this class on February 7<sup>th</sup>. This is his first time at a mile and if he gets a good start he can be on pace and potentially go all the way. (2) SAHARAMOND beat a couple of these on his way to a fair 5<sup>th</sup> at 1700M on January 18<sup>th</sup> and while up 4kg in weight with no apprentice claim, he can beat plenty again. In a race without much depth, (4) KING KALLE and (6) CHANG CHANG SOCKS are the next bests.

### **Busan Race 4: Class 5 (1200M) Handicap / KRW 45 Million**

Nothing enters this race in much resembling form, but the best is (5) ROAD TO ACE. He was ordinary on his return from six months out in December but was an improved 5<sup>th</sup> over 1200M on January 25<sup>th</sup>, beating a couple of today's rivals. He has won at this trip before and third-up this preparation, he can be peaking fitness wise. (1) FLYING THE FORD has been ordinary in his latest two but he won at this class over a mile in December and the inside gate and an apprentice claim should make him competitive here. (9) GOOGLE CAR has a win and two placings from five attempts at the distance which is enough to draw a line through his latest two and give him a chance. (11) BLACK JILJU and (8) TAEYANG EUTTEUM others who can arrest their respective recent slumps.

### **Seoul Race 6: Class 4 (1700M) Handicap / KRW 60 Million**

We'll take a chance on (4) GANGCHEOL JEONSA here. He mixes his form and had a poor day at the office when well supported last time out over 1800M but at the start before he ran a solid 3<sup>rd</sup> in better company than this. He draws well and could even be an each-way price. (1) CAMP DAIVD is another form mixer but if he can reproduce his effort on February 7<sup>th</sup> when he was an on-pace class and distance 3<sup>rd</sup>, then he should get closer today. (6) BLACK SIDAE has a win and five placings from eleven tries at this distance and under a light weight, can be very competitive. (10) BLOOD MOUNTAIN was a bog price class and distance winner on January 31<sup>st</sup> and warrants more respect here. (7) BAZOOKA BOY could challenge for minors.

### **Busan Race 5: Class 4 (1400M) Handicap / KRW 75 Million**

Fillies and mares only. (2) ARI DRAGON races twice last summer for a win and a 2<sup>nd</sup> place and then didn't race again until January. She picked up from where she left off with 2<sup>nd</sup> over

1300M on January 11<sup>th</sup> and then won from a wide draw over 1300M on February 13<sup>th</sup>. She is up in class and slightly in trip but looks to have plenty of potential for more. It's a long time since (11) JINJU BIT got her sole victory to date but she hasn't been far away in recent starts and she can run into some money here. (7) FLY TO THE MOON enters off a 4<sup>th</sup> place over 1200M on February 6<sup>th</sup>. She is yet to win in thirteen attempts but has twelve top five finishes and should be there or thereabouts again. (5) SEONGSIL SIHWA and (8) QUEEN AND SERVE others in the frame.

### **Seoul Race 7: Class Open (2000M) Weight for Age / Herald Business (KOR G3) / KRW 500 Million**

The first leg of the Stayer Series. (6) CLEAN ONE blitzed the Grand Prix, leading from gate to wire and winning by the biggest margin in thirty years. He races for the first time since, although he looked well in a February trial, and if he brings his form from that day, he will take some beating. (2) GANGPUNGMA was runner-up in both the President's Cup and the Grand Prix before winning at this distance at class 1 level at the end of December. He has a bit of an issue with the start which finds him at a disadvantage right away against the elite, but if he makes a clean getaway, he is a real chance. Reigning horse of the year (10) SPEED YOUNG won the President's Cup before finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Grand Prix. He showed he can turn his hand to anything by winning the Listed Segye Ilbo over 1200M three weeks ago and he will be challenging late. Defending champion (7) SUCCESS BAEKPA mixes his form but on his day can mix it with anyone. (5) YEONGGWANGUIFIRST could be the wildcard.

### **Busan Race 6: Class 3 (1600M) Handicap / KRW 75 Million**

(2) WONDERFUL JONES was a class and distance winner on February 6<sup>th</sup> when on pace throughout and scoring comfortably. He comes up 3.5kg in weight, but that's balanced by a better draw, and he will be a short price to repeat. (5) WIDAEHAN SEONTAEK is vastly experienced and while he doesn't win out of turn, he came from off the pace to run 4<sup>th</sup> at 1400M on January 25<sup>th</sup> and this is the kind of race he can place in. (3) JULGEOUN

DONGHANG won at this distance on January 25<sup>th</sup>, settling midfield and running on. She is up in class but down in weight and from a good gate, she can measure up. (10) DAEHO NARA and (8) VERLUC among plenty of other place chances.

### Seoul Race 8: Class 4 (1300M) Handicap / KRW 60 Million

(1) REVERENCE ran a fair 4<sup>th</sup> over a mile at this class on February 14<sup>th</sup>, running on from midfield but not being able to get up in a close finish. He drops back to a trip at which he is two for two, and he can return to winning ways today. (5) ROYAL SOCKS is a three-time winner at this distance, most recently at class 5 level in January when he made all. He was a close 2<sup>nd</sup> in a quick race on his first try at this class on February 7<sup>th</sup> and an apprentice claim today keeps his weight from going up by much and keeps him competitive. (10) WHIZ PERFECT got his maiden win at start two over 1200M on February 14<sup>th</sup> from the front, and while he has to contend with plenty of weight and a wide gate, he can measure up. (4) GLOBAL KINGDOM and (7) BILLION BOY among others to consider.

### Busan Race 7: Class 2 (1800M) Handicap / KRW 90 Million

(6) GEUMA GUTTY returned from three months out to run 2<sup>nd</sup> in December and then 3<sup>rd</sup> on February 13<sup>th</sup>, both at this class and distance and both times with notable rivals today behind him and only Oasis Red (twice) and Young Skywalker ahead of him. Third-up this preparation, he can be peaking and he can win. (5) UNJU GUY was beaten by Geuma Guty in both the December and February races but was close in 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>. In between those he added a 2<sup>nd</sup> of his own, beating plenty of the others who go here, and he shapes as a big danger today. (4) DOCTOR CAPTAIN was 3<sup>rd</sup> behind Unju Guy in January and can be a place chance again. (12) GREAT BOY and (7) DOCTOR KINGDOM others in the mix.

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### Seoul Race 9: Class 3 (1800M) Handicap / KRW 75 Million

(10) GEOTEN GANGHO has placed three times at this distance and while he was a well beaten favourite when 6<sup>th</sup> last time out on February 14<sup>th</sup>, today he gets a 3kg apprentice claim which should bring him right into things. He can settle behind the speed and can run down plenty. (6) NURI CHEONWANG was a winner over this distance at class 4 level last October and has a 4<sup>th</sup> and a 3<sup>rd</sup> in two starts since at this level. He'll sit handy here and is a danger. (4) K POWERFUL beat Nuri Cheonwang when trying to lead from gate to wire on January 31<sup>st</sup>. He'll lead again here and can be in this a long way. (11) WHITE CARLA and (7) LEGEND WOW are others in the frame.

### Seoul Race 10: Class 3 (1200M) Handicap / KRW 75 Million

(2) WE GO HIGH was an all the way winner of a fast race over this distance at the end of last November. He hasn't raced since and he missed six weeks of work at the start of this year through injury. He has been back in training since February 26<sup>th</sup> and while he is up in class and match fitness must be taken on trues, he has plenty of ability. (9) DREAMER WHIZ was a desperately close 2<sup>nd</sup> at class and distance on January 31<sup>st</sup>, flashing home from a long way back to just miss out. An apprentice stops his weight from going up and he'll have every chance late on again. (3) NAVY CAPTAIN was a close class and distance 3<sup>rd</sup> at big odds on March 1<sup>st</sup> coming from off the pace and makes a quick return here with respect warranted. (5) BEST SUN and (10) TOHO SKY other place chances.
