The 48,000gns purchase is a half-sister to this year's Ribblesdale Stakes winner and she gets the nod to maintain her unbeaten record. Nurseclaire has been highly tried after winning on her racecourse bow and she merits the utmost respect in these calmer waters, while Fonteyn is a newcomer to note.
