RACE 1: HAVANA GREY AT WHITSBURY MANOR STUD HANDICAP

Seneca Chief Glamorous Breeze Melody King

SENECA CHIEF carries a 4lb penalty for winning here last Friday, when he got the better of Glamorous Breeze. The latter is better off at these weights but, while she has the potential to improve for the fitting a first-time visor, the former is fancied to back up that victory. Melody King's recent consistency brings him into the equation as well.

- 1 SENECA CHIEF Winner of six races at 5f on good ground and on the all-weather. A winner at 10-3 over this course and distance (good) on his latest outing earlier this month, beating Glamorous Breeze by 1/2l. Carries a 4lb penalty today for that success. Has also won at Salisbury this season.
- 2 PETTOCHSIDE Has won 18 races from 5f to 6f on ground varying from good to firm to heavy and on the all-weather. Finished 6l behind Just That Lord when fourth of 5 at 12-1 on his latest outing at Windsor over 5f (good to firm) earlier this month. Has won at Bath and Ascot this season.
- 3 BELLA NOTTE A winner at 7f on good ground. Finished 6l behind Moraweth when last of 6 at 13-2 on her latest outing at Lingfield over 7f last month.
- 4 MELODY KING Successful at 5f and 7f on good ground. Third of 8 behind Glorious Rio beaten 1/2l at 9-5fav on his latest outing at Hamilton over 5f (good) last month.
- 5 DURDLÉ DOOR A winner at 7f on the all-weather. Beaten 6l behind Hala Joud at 12-1 when 9th of 12 on her latest outing at Lingfield over 7f in June.
- 6 GLAMOROUS BREEZE A winner at 5f on good to firm ground. Beaten 1/2l by Seneca Chief when second of 6 at 5-4fav on her latest outing over this course and distance (good) earlier this month.
- 7 THE DALEY EXPRESS Winner of seven races from 5f to 6f on ground varying from good to firm to heavy and on the all-weather. Third of 6 behind The Princes Poet beaten 2 1/4l at 13-2 on his latest outing at Windsor over 5f (good to firm) last month.

Bath over 6f (firm) earlier this month. Has won at Windsor and Lingfield this season.

10 FIRENZE ROSA She has won four times at 5f on ground varying from good to soft to heavy. Beaten 7l behind Atty's Edge at 18-1 when last of 7 on her latest outing at Goodwood over 5f (good) last month.

RACE 2: TIME TEST EBF NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE)

Goldspur Wolsey Luis Fernando

GOLDSPUR boasts a smart pedigree, being a son of Dubawi out of a Group 1-placed dam, and Charlie Appleby's colt warrants the utmost respect on his racecourse debut. Wolsey was bought for \$275,000 at the Keeneland yearling sale last September and the son of Kitten's Joy is a half-brother to a US Grade 1 winner. Luis Fernando is bred to stay well and is of interest, along with Kaatibb and Cabrakan.

Wodeton Damaar Atheby

WODETON cost 100,000 pounds at the Arqana Breeze-Up sale at Doncaster in May and this half-brother to a Listed winner gets the vote to make a winning start to his racing career. Damaar comes from the family of Gold Cup winner Order Of St George so he may need further in time to be seen to best effect. Atheby ran in the Solario Stakes here behind Reach For The Moon last month and the drop in class puts him into the reckoning.

RACE 4:CHASEMORE FARM FORTUNE STAKES (LISTED)

Mostahdaf Perotto Sir Busker

MOSTAHDAF had excuses when last seen in the Group 1 St James's Palace Stakes, being hampered at a crucial stage. The son of Frankel recorded a win in the Listed Heron Stakes over this C&D in May and he can get his career back on track here. Perotto was an eye-catcher at Goodwood and could be the main threat now dropping in grade. Sir Busker has been performing with consistency this season and is likely to figure in this contest, while Bell Rock and Rhoscolyn also hold claims.
