Fairview Polytrack, 15.11.2024, Race 1, Gallops, 1200m, Poly, R75.000, 12:20GMT+2

Race Summary: HAPHAZARD was slowly away and showed signs of inexperience on debut. She takes on males this time but can go one better. HOUSE OF SUSSEX has improved of late and might try and make all the running as the track has been playing that way recently. HAT MAN showed improvement last time and could have more to offer. AMERICAN PITBULL tries the Polytrack for the first time and could improve. VELVET VALOUR and WAR OF HEARTS have struggled so far but are capable of improvement. SILVERY SURFER makes his debut and could be ready for it.

MISS VALENTYNA makes her debut but trainer Gavin Smith has won many races likes this and she would not be a surprise winner. CAPE FLOWER tends to lack a strong finish but has a place chance. LAUGH TILL I CRY showed improvement last time and is not out of it. MILLION REASONS, ROYAL VENUS and CHOC' LATE are all capable of getting involved with the finish.

Stable companions PEARLY ASH and TAKE YOUR TIME are both improving and can make the frame.

NOTHINGELSEMATTERS has a place chance. PUERTO PLATA (ARG) is in good form and should contest the finish again. SLAINTE MHATH likes the Polyrack and needs to be included in all bets.

BUSH TRACKER has not won for some time but is still effective and should contest the finish. GLOBAL ALLY and PASSCHENDAELE are consistent and are both capable of earning some more money.

FLOWER FESTIVAL has been very consistent of late and has a winning chance. RAIN BIRD has improved of late and could be a threat again. MARSHMALLOW has talent but does not always show it. MILLIONDOLLAR GIRL and MY TRUE LOVE can also be considered possible winners.

Turffontein Standside, 15.11.2024, Race 1, Gallops, 1400m, Turf, R105.000, 15:35GMT+2

Race Summary: MOCHA MACAROON would not be winning out of turn. She has the form and experience to be a factor at the finish. EXCEEDINGLY GLAM has finished 2nd in consecutive recent outings and needn't improve much to go one better. GREAT NOTION and LAPIS LAZULI could have a say if building on the progress they showed last time. MIST IN IRELAND is engaged to run a day earlier but will play a leading role if taking her place in this lineup. Debutante HEAD TO THE STARS needn't be special to make her presence felt in this company. Watch the betting.

Race Summary: LETS PLAY POKER is overdue a maiden win and given his pedigree, should improve sufficiently over this extended trip to open his account. Younger rivals SERRANO and BEYNAC receive 2kg and should pose a threat - both have more scope for improvement after recent gelding operations. CHABAL made a pleasing introduction and would have come on appreciably with the benefit of that experience so must be respected. Filly THE MIGHTIEST fits a similar profile and gets weight from her male rivals. Well-bred newcomers PRAETORIAN, INCLUSION and COUNT HUHTIKUU are worth a market check on debut.

Both will play leading roles if taking their places in the lineup. VAR PARK and KINDRED HEART are competitive off their current marks and should have a say. Returning VELDSKOEN is lightly raced and dangerous to discount on his reappearance. Improving BASINGSTOKE will be tested at this level but is not without a chance in her bid to complete the hat-trick. Consistent CAPTAIN EFFICIENT won't be far off the mark under just 53.5kg.

Race Summary: COSMIC STAR sets the standard and should play a leading role back in a handicap off a 1-point lower mark in his peak outing. However, preference is for stablemate KARANGETANG whose 4-point penalty for a last-start 1000m success is negated by his rider's 2.5kg allowance. ROLLWITHTHEPUNCHES and YAMADORI are hard-knockers who have the means to make their presence felt. Filly VIRGINIA BEACH is quick and likely to acquit herself competitively under 54kg.

Race Summary: MIA MOO won a similar contest over 1160m on her reappearance last month and will enjoy dropping back in trip off an unchanged mark after finishing a close-up 2nd over 1500m three weeks ago. This distance should also suit BOSUM BUDDY who is 2kg better off with the selection for 1.90 lengths. BAKWENA is unexposed so open to improvement, and will fare better back against her own sex, having faced male opposition last time. Last-start winners FASTNET FILLY and KOMMETJIE STORM also have scope to improve and should be competitive after recent course-and-distance victories. Don't ignore MISS SCALETTA.

Race Summary: Cases can be made for most but it could pay to side with lightly raced SUKHUMVIT who, like most of Silvano's progeny, improve with age. She finished ahead of several re-opposing rivals when 2nd in an 1800m Grade 3 recently and should confirm her superiority off an unchanged mark and similar weight terms. LADY FALLON, JULIET TANGO, CHAMPAGNE COCKTAIL, CAPE LIGHTS and DONNA MO are held on that form but could pose more of a threat over this shorter trip. KEY ELEMENT ran well in defeat in a 1450m Grade 2 last time and should enjoy this extended trip. ANDI'S GIRL is progressive and should have a say.

Race Summary: BIRTHRIGHT edged STREWN SKY (2.5kg better off) in a recent 1800m meeting on this course with the help of his rider's 2.5kg claim but doesn't benefit from a weight allowance in this rematch. Both wore first-time blinkers on that occasion, so it is interesting the latter has been declared to run without the headgear. Last-start maiden winner PANNING GOLD opened his account over this distance on the Inside track and will appreciate switching to the Standside track with just 52kg to carry on handicap debut. Consistent CELTIC RUSH has the form and experience to acquit himself competitively too.

MISS LIA confirmed the promise she showed as a juvenile by winning on her seasonal comeback and this extended trip should unlock further improvement. GREENHOUSE fits a similar profile and should be competitive. Fellow 3yo PALACE DANCER and hard-knocker PRINCESS ILARIA have the form and experience to also get involved.
