RAGING MOON (1) raced green on debut at long odds and was not far back while RATTLE THE PEACE (7 and CARDINAL CHIEF (6) may be worth following in the betting. (Andrew Harrison: 8-1-7-6).

KING BAVARIAN (1) was a runaway winner on the poly last outing but got a six-point rise in the handicap. He does have a light

weight. KING CELTILLUS (4) is still a maiden but has not been far back at recent outings and will only have 49kg on his back. (Andrew Harrison: 6-7-2-1).
