

# R3 LE MANS [L-H]

# C1 - PRIX D'ARNAGE - 2300m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Condition - Flat - EUR € 15,100

- **1. MAJOR STAR -** 3yo gelding by King Edward out of Passing Sale mare Rose Star trained by David Cottin. All four of the mare's progeny that have raced have won
- **2. MARTAGNAN D ATHON -** 3yo gelding by Telecaster out of Ange Gabriel mare Bella Dona D'Aton trained by P&C Peltier. Third foal to race with mare having produced one winner
- **3. MAGNUM D'ERABLE -** 3yo gelding by Beaumec De Houelle out of Cokoriko mare Gitane Bleue trained by Patrice Quinton. Mare won the Gr3 Prix Yves D'Armaille at Lignieres in 2019. Only raced foal has 2 wins and 5 places from 8 starts
- **4. MARCHE AVANT -** 3yo gelding by Doctor Dino out of Dom Alco mare Visionice trained by Francois Nicolle. Dam won on the Flat before going on to capture a Listed Hurdles race. Third foal to race, no winners
- **5. MARIACHI -** 3yo gelding by Karaktar out of Linda's Lad mare Belle lle trained by Yannick Fouin. Dam has produced two winners
- **6. MERCI MIMI -** 3yo filly by Jeu St Eloi out of Dom Alco mare Terenice trained by Yannick Fouin. Half-sister to 10-time winning hurdler Happy Day
- **7. MAHAURI SEA -** 3yo filly by Bathyrhon out of Great Pretender mare Bubble Sea trained by Gregoire Leenders. Dam ran 3rd in the Gr1 Prix de Craon and so far two of her foals have run for just one win

**Summary:** Field is made up of some interesting first-timers but based on breeding MARCHE AVANT (4) looks the runner to beat. His dam had a win and two places on the Flat before moving on to hurdle racing where she won a Listed race. MAHAURI SEA (7) is another from a strong female line as her dam was a five-time winner. MAJOR STAR (1) is a half-brother to Gr3 runner-up Glory Star and all of the dam's progeny to have raced have won. MARTAGNAN D ATHON (2) is also well related.

# C2 - PRIX JEAN DE NICOLAY - 1950m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 2 - Flat - EUR € 20,100

- **1. GALAGOS -** Ran 3rd in a Conditions race over 2100m at Tarbes on 12 October. That was an improved run trying further and he could be competitive
- **2. ALWAYS WELCOME -** Won a conditions race over 2000m at Fontainebleau on 3 November. He has placed in a Listed race and seems to have struck up a winning combination with Delphine Santiago
- **3. BELIEVER -** A disappointing 7th race in a Conditions race over this course and distance on 29 October. That was his first run back after a 5-month break and he is better than that last run. Will be fitted with blinkers for this race
- **4. LOVE IS GOLD -** Ran 5th in a Handicap over 1900m on the sand at Deauville on 20 October. However, finished 3rd in a Handicap at this course in his penultimate start
- **5. LADY ANGELINA** A reasonable 3rd in a Conditions race over 1650m at Machecoul on 2 November. Tries further for the first time and takes on stronger
- **6. SEPULVEDA -** Last time was 10th in a Handicap over 2500m at Saint-Cloud on 26 October. Ran 2nd over this track at trip on her penultimate start so must have a place chance at least
- **7. SUNSHINE BABY -** Finished 9th in a Listed race over 2000m at Compiegne on 10 October. Drops in class this time and is now trained by Mickaël Berto so improvement is anticipated

**Summary:** ALWAYS WELCOME (2) comes off a gutsy victory, and reconnected with winning rider Delphine Santiago, who gets a weight allowance, could notch up a quick double. BELIEVER (3) did not show his true ability in his first run back from a break but he has been racing well against stronger and must be considered. LOVE IS GOLD (4) finished fifth in a Quinté+ recently and has form at this course. SUNSHINE BABY (7) comes in with a light weight and drops in class.

# C3 - PRIX DE TRANGE - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - Class 2 - Flat - EUR € 24,700

- **1. REDOUTABLE -** A well-beaten 4th in a Conditions race over 1600m at Nantes on 1 November. That was an improved run though and perhaps there is more to come
- **2. HEY JO -** Won a Maiden over 1600m at Lignieres on November. That was only his second start and he could have a lot more in the tank
- **3. WESTMINSTER COYOTE -** Won a Maiden over 1600m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on 4 November. A fluent winner on that occasion and should have more to come
- **4. LIKE LINDY -** Ran 5th in a Conditions race over 1300m at Chantilly (sand) on 28 October. This filly is the top rated runner in this line-up and back on turf could have the edge
- **5. REMENBER CHOPE** Finished 4th in a Handicap over 1400m at Chantilly (sand) on 31 October. Tries this distance for the first time but should handle it
- **6. FELINI -** Unraced 2yo gelding by Zelzal out Dragon Pulse mare Shdedah trained by Edouard Monfort. Dam has produced just one winner
- **7. LADY TEDSMORE** A decent enough 4th in a Maiden over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on 16 October. Coming into this with just 53kg on her back, could have a say in the finish

**Summary:** This race could be a close tussle between LIKE LINDY (4), who showed a touch of class when winning on the straight course at Deauville course in August, and supplementary entry WESTMINSTER COYOTE (3). The latter has only raced three times and has improved with each effort, winning confidently last time out. LIKE LINDY (4) could have the edge as she has a 1.5kg advantage. (4)LADY TEDSMORE (7) and HEY JO (2) have only raced twice and should make rapid progress.

# C4 - PRIX DU CREDIT AGRICOLE - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Claiming - Flat - EUR € 14,400

- **1. MISTY CITY -** A moderate 5th in a Handicap over 1200m at Fontainebleau on 13 November. On best form could run into a place
- **2. AMELIA** Finished 4th in a Claimer over 1200m at Fontainebleau on 3 November. That was a slightly better effort but she still needs to up her game to feature
- **3. LOVE ADDICT -** Won a Claimer over 1200m at Agen on 26 October. That was only her third run and there could be more improvement to come
- **4. PEPIER -** A close-up 2nd in a claimer over 1200m at Fontainebleau on 3 November. It was his first run at this level and had blinkers fitted. Should be right up there again
- **5. TOMOE GOZEN -** A poor 9th in a Conditions race over 1600m at Chantilly on 8 November. Has been mediocre in both her starts and is best ignored
- **6. GLORIOUS CROSS -** Was 8th in a Maiden over 1600m at this course on 29 October. There will need to be massive progress if she is to feature
- **7. JOUE CHOPE -** Ran 12th in a Handicap over 1400m at Chantilly on 31 October. She drops sharply in class and this race looks ideal for her to pick up a first win
- **8. NOIRA -** Encouraging 5th in a Maiden over 1600m at this track on 29 October. That was his first run after gelding and we should see even more progress this time
- **9. PROCEED WITH SPEED -** Finished 5th in a Claimer over 1500m at Deauville on 7 November. Running well enough to be competitive at this level, especially as he will be fitted with blinkers for this race

**Summary:** A Handicap looked too strong for JOUE CHOPE (7) last time but dropping to a Claimer with Sebastiano Deriu in the irons, she looks ideally weighted to shed her Maiden. PEPIER (4) only found his stable companion too good last time when fitted with blinkers. He retains the headgear and should be competitive. NOIRA (8) showed more promise in his first run after gelding and looks a threat while PROCEED WITH SPEED (9) is back on turf after two moderate runs on sand, and has blinkers fitted.

# C5 - PRIX DE PARISLONGCHAMP - 3200m (a2m) - TURF - Maiden - Flat - EUR € 15,600

- **1. BLACK SHEEP -** Pleasing 3rd in a maiden over 2900m at Amiens on the 10th of November 2025. Looks to have a strong place chance
- **2. MAGIC TRIP -** Discouraging debut finishing 15th in a Conditional over 2700m at Les Sables on the 11th of October 2025. Others weigh more attraction
- **3. MR TEE** Ran 6th on debut in a Conditional over 2950m at Machecoul on the 19th of October 2025. Can finish closer than his debut start
- **4. GOT MAN -** Good 2nd in a Conditional over 3200m at Le Mans on the 29th of October 2025. Has an each way chance on form
- **5. POTTER NICOLIERE -** Inconsistent 9th in a Handicap over 2900m at Amiens on the 29th of October 2025. Others preferred on form
- **6. QUEEN D'AUNOU -** Good 3rd in a Conditional over 2400m at Clairefontaine on the 24th of October 2025. Can break the maiden spell
- **7. STAR MAUVE -** Finished 7th on debut over 1950m in a Maiden at Le Mans on the 29th of October 2025. Improvement can be expected
- **8. MYRIADE MAG -** Trying 5th on debut in a Conditional over 2950m at Machecoul on the 19th of October 2025. One for the backend of quartets
- **9. BELLE ETINCELLE -** Not the greatest run finishing 8th in a Conditional over 3200m at Le Mans on the 29th of October 2025. One to overlook
- **10. FREENESS -** Improved into 2nd in a maiden over 3000m at Angers on the 22nd of September 2025. Strong win chance
- **11. BRYVIDO -** This gelding is out of the 5 time winning mare Fidji D'Arcis who performed over the flat and hurdles in her career. Debut experience is needed here
- **12. PYRAVOL LAUJAC -** This gelding is out of the 4 time winning mare Pyragon who featured in minor Handicaps in her career. He may need the outing
- **13. ZENON -** This gelding is out of the unraced mare Dona Pepita. Hard to make a case for and the betting could be a better guide
- **14. MISTERROMINO -** Out of the 2 time winning mare Sister Flo. This gelding has found a tough field to make a bold appearance
- **15. FINE PLUME D'AVRIL -** This filly is out of the mare Fine Plume who raced once and did not feature well in her career. One to respectfully pass by here

**Summary:** QUEEN D'AUNOU (6) is a filly that has run three times with promise and has the urge to break her maiden spell. The greenlight points in her direction to claim her victorious throne. FREENESS (10) made massive improvement when finishing second over a further distance and if the top choice fluffs her lines, she could take full advantage of that. GOT MAN (4) delivered a solid second over the track and trip and returns where it would be of no revelation if he makes amends for his last run. BLACK SHEEP (1) holds a solid place chance.

# C6 - PRIX DE SAINT-GEORGES-DU-BOIS - 3200m (a2m) - TURF - Maiden - Flat - EUR € 11,900

- **1. MOPSO -** Good 3rd in a Conditional over 2400m at Toulouse on the 27th of October 2025. Strong winning chance
- **2. KOWALSKI -** Pleasant 5th in a Class 3 Handicap over 2500m at Croise-Laroche on the 3rd of November 2025. Good each way shout
- **3. VERT ET MER -** Improved into 5th in a Conditional over 2400m at Lignieres on the 16th of February 2025. Returns after a lengthy layoff and may need one more to bring him on
- **4. POULORIUS -** Ran 14th in a Handicap over the hurdles over 3900m at Auteuil on the 27th of September 2025. Erratic but capable
- **5. JAZZ ROQUE -** Decent 3rd in his penultimate start over 3700m in a Handicap at Craon on the 28th of September 2025. Place chance at best
- **6. ALLIED POWERS -** Ran 9th in a Conditional over 3200m at Le Mans on the 29th of October 2025. Returns to track and trip and could give a better account
- **7. MISS DONNA -** Ran another 6th in a Conditional over 2900m at Argentan on the 8th of October 2025. Others preferred
- **8. JOLITA DE VIETTE -** Discouraging 10th in a Conditional over 3200m at Le Mans on the 29th of October 2025. One to respectfully pass by
- **9. YAMAMAH -** Finished 11th in a Conditional over 1950m at Le Mans on the 29th of October 2025. One to overlook here
- **10. MAGIC MARVEL -** A winner in a Listed over 3900m at Auteuil on the 25th of June 2025. Returns after 5 months and give be involved if the run is not needed
- **11. HARSHAN -** This gelding is out of the unraced mare Hello Sindarella. Hard to make a case for him but top choices look more attractive
- **12. SO LATE -** Out of the mare Sotunza who raced 5 times in her career but did not feature well enough. This gelding will need the educational experience
- **13. BARON DE FLANDRES -** This colt is out of the 2 time winning mare Ghur who raced over the hurdles and Steeplechase. He could put up a decent debut run
- **14. LYLOUMEL -** This filly is out of the 1 time winning mare Miss Flicka who raced 17 times in her career. Others seem more intriguing here
- **15. BUGATTI DESJY -** This filly is out of the 3 time winning mare Sea Dame who featured in the steeplechase and hurdles races. She could be anything in the making



**Summary:** MOPSO (1) seems to be enjoying the French tracks against the Spanish surfaces where he started his career. His last run when finishing third was a credible effort and can pursue breaking the maiden shackles off his hooves here. KOWALSKI (2) is always there and thereabout and seems to be enjoying the flat surfaces. He can threaten the top selection. JAZZ ROQUE (5) has been featuring in the steeplechase races of late but he did finish fourth four starts back over the flat and can give a good account. BARON DE FLANDRES (13) debuts and could be anything in the making.

### C7 - PRIX BERNARD DE WILDENBERG - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 14,400

- **1. BIG FREEZE -** Ran 8th in a Class 3 Handicap over 1200m at Fontainebleau on the 3rd of November 2025. Others preferred
- **2. CHUNKA WAKAN -** Solid 2nd in a Class 4 Handicap over 1600m at Nantes on the 1st of November 2025. Certainly can go one more
- **3. CAP SKIRRING -** Decent 2nd in a Class 4 Conditional over 1200m at Agen on the 26th of October 2025. Does bump a tougher opposition here
- **4. NO TIME -** Hard trying 4th in a Class 3 Handicap over 1400m at Compiegne on the 10th of October 2025. One to include in all plays
- **5. STRANGER -** Finished 7th in a Class 4 Handicap over 1500m at Deauville on the 22nd of October 2025. One to overlook here
- **6. RUE MIA -** Discouraging 10th in a Class 3 Handicap over 1200m at Fontainebleau on the 3rd of November 2025. Others seem more intriguing
- **7. RED THE WEST -** Good 3rd in a Class 4 Handicap over 1600m at Nantes on the 1st of November 2025. Bold winning chance
- **8. HYPNOTIZED -** Finished 8th in a Class 4 Handicap over 1600m at Nantes on the 22nd of May 2025. Returns after a break and may need it
- **9. NOUR AYA -** Inconsistent 8th in a Class 4 Handicap over 1600m at Lignieres on the 1st of November 2025. Erratic but capable
- **10. EL PROFESSOR CHOP -** Pleasant 4th in a Class 4 Handicap over 1600m at Lignieres on the 1st of November 2025. Good place chance
- **11. GIN GEMBRE -** Trying 6th in a Class 4 Handicap over 1500m at Deauville on the 22nd of October 2025. One for larger exotics

**Summary:** RED THE WEST (7) and CHUNKA WAKAN (2) are no strangers to each other when meeting in their last start and renew their rivalry in this event. They are confidently selected to fill in the first and second place position and certainly have the form to back them up to do so. EL PROFESSOR CHOP (10) is always finding himself being involved in the shakeup and in this sort of field, he can be entangled in the action. GIN GEMBRE (11) completes the quartet chance.

# C8 - PRIX DU MESNIL - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 16,300

- **1. COUR DU ROI -** Finished 9th in a Class 3 Handicap over 1500m at Deauville on the 22nd of October 2025. One to overlook
- **2. ON LOCKDOWN -** A firm winner in a Class 3 Handicap over 1400m at Compiegne on the 10th of October 2025. Bold winning chance
- **3. ESSAI TRANSFORME -** Hearty 6th in a Class 4 Conditional over 1650m at Amiens on the 10th of November 2025. One for larger exotic plays
- **4. KALEOCREEK -** Trying 5th in a Class 4 Handicap over 1400m at Nancy on the 18th of October 2025. Good place chance
- **5. GALIK -** Ran 7th in a Class 4 Handicap over 1600m at Nantes on the 1st of November 2025. One for the larger backend of quartets
- **6. GENERALAY -** Disappointing 14th in a Class 3 Handicap over 1200m at Fontainebleau on the 3rd of November 2025. Others weigh more attraction
- **7. DZARINA -** Ran 7th in a Class 4 Handicap over 1400m at Clairefontaine on the 24th of October 2025. Others make more appeal
- **8. KATHALINA -** Good 3rd in a Class 4 Handicap over 1600m at Nantes on the 1st of November 2025. Include in every play
- **9. PROLETARIAT -** Discouraging 10th in a Class 3 Handicap over 1400m at Chantilly on the 8th of November 2025. One to respectfully pass by
- **10. TOOCOOLFORSCHOOL** Inconsistent 10th in a Class 4 Handicap over 1600m at Nantes on the 1st of November 2025. Erratic but capable
- **11. THE CAT'S -** Finished 9th in a Class 4 Handicap over 1650m at Amiens on the 29th of October 2025. Others preferred
- **12. RED IN SIGHT -** Supplemented Red in sight finished 15th in a Class 3 Handicap over 1200m at Fontainebleau. Takes a step down in class and must redeem herself

**Summary:** Supplemented RED IN SIGHT (12) does not spark the eye at first glance as she has been slightly off form but has taken on a stronger sort. She steps down in class and has every chance to polish up on her current state. ON LOCKDOWN (2) was a solid winner over the distance and it would be of no surprise if he follows up on his win. KALEOCREEK (4) is always in the thick of things and if he remains wise here, he could give the top two a run for their money. ESSAI TRANSOFRME (3) wraps up the mix.
