Mellow Yellow ran a similar sort of race at Newcastle on her racecourse bow, and she looks a lively threat. Better is expected of Delphinus for last year's winning stable, while newcomer Peripatetic is another to consider.

Successful at Goodwood on her most recent start, MADAME TANTZY can follow up last year's victory in this contest. The daughter of Champs Elysees arrives off 5lb higher and with conditions in her favour, she is preferred to Anghaam, who has won three times this season and there were excuses for her latest defeat at Lingfield. The unexposed Mobadra is another who warrants serious consideration on her handicap debut.

2 CASPIAN QUEEN She has won four times from 5f to 7f on firm and good to firm ground and on the all-weather. A winner at 6-4 at Chepstow over 7f (firm) on her latest outing last month, beating Bolly Bullet by 2 1/4l. Has also won at Kempton this season.

3 ANGHAAM She has won three times at 1m on good to firm and soft ground. Well beaten at 15-2 behind Mrs Fitzherbert when last of 7 on her latest outing at Lingfield over 1m last month. Has won 3 times this season.

4 LAST SUNSET A winner at 7f on the all-weather. Finished 2 3/4l behind Star Jewel when fifth of 6 at 9-1 on her latest outing at Thirsk over 7f (good) earlier this month.

5 MOBADRA A winner at 4-1 at Haydock over 1m (good to firm) on her latest outing in July, beating Evident Beauty by 1l.
