

R1 Longchamp [R-H]

C1 - PRIX DE BELLEVILLE - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Newcomers - Flat - EUR € 45,700

- **1. EBIYAR -** Colt by Siyouni, the dam won a Group 2 race and was Listed placed. Stable runners are well-tuned for their debut. Leading contender with Mickael Barzalona on top
- **2. MOONROSE -** Gelding by Sea The Moon, the dam never ran. Likely to improve for this debut run unless the betting says otherwise
- **3. ZITTO** Gelding by Seahenge, the dam was placed once. Improvement is expected from this debut run and is best watched for the time being
- **4. KINESIS -** Colt by Study Of Man, the dam won 1 race. Looks good on paper and from a respected stable. Monitor the betting patterns for clues
- **5. SOUDYA -** Colt by Lawman, the dam won 2 races over middle distances. Stable runners tend to improve for a few runs. One to watch on debut
- **6. LIFETRACK -** Colt by Zarak, the dam won 1 race—nice pedigree and from a respected trainer who knows the time of day. Any market support should be noted
- **7. AERONEF -** Colt by Sea The Stars, the dam won 3 races, including a Listed race. He is a half-brother to Sacred Spirit, who has won a Listed race. Judging by jockey bookings, he could be the second choice for his owners, but warrants respect
- **8. KAVARI -** Colt by Dark Angel, the dam won 1 race and was placed in a Listed race. He is a half-brother to Sober a (Gr.2) winner. From a top stable and the choice of Maxime Guyon. A bold show on expected

Summary: EBIYAR (1) boasts a strong pedigree, being by Siyouni and out of a high-class mare who was Listed-placed and a Group 2 winner. He looks capable of making a winning debut. KAVARI (8) is the pick of Maxime Guyon and is a half-brother to Group 2 winner Sober. He should be involved at the business end. AERONEF (7) also makes plenty of appeal on paper—his half-brother, Sacred Spirit, is a Listed winner, so he merits respect. KINESIS (4) is another well-bred type and should be kept safe.

C2 - PRIX DE LA CHAPELLE - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Newcomers - Flat - EUR € 45,700

- **1. SODA ZABEEL -** Filly by Sea The Stars, the dam won 3 races, including a Listed and a Group 1 in Italy over 1600m. Well-bred and is one to keep an eye on in the betting market
- **2. MERCI CHERI -** Filly by Dabirsim, the dam won 2 races, including a Group 3 race. Her trainer knows the time of day, and this filly is one to watch in the betting for clues
- **3. HEROISTE -** Filly by Muhaarar, the dam was placed twice. From a respected trainer who has his newcomers well-tuned. Monitor the betting patterns for clues
- **4. MELANTHA -** Filly by Camelot, the dam won 4 races, including a Listed race, and was placed in Group 3 races and a Grade 1 in the USA. One to watch closely in the betting market for any market moves
- **5. SILVER JEWEL -** Daughter of Magna Grecia, the dam won 3 races, including a Listed race, and was placed in a Group 3. Choice profile and from a good stable. The betting can be the best guide to expected performance
- **6. MAINTAIN -** Filly by Kingman, the dam won 3 races, including a Listed and a Group 3, and was placed in Group 2 races. She is a half-sister to New Ground (Group 1 placed, Epsom Derby, Grand Prix de Paris). She can be involved at the finish
- **7. LA JUSTICIERE -** Filly by Justify, the dam never ran. She is a half-sister to Champagne Anyone, who won a Grade 2 in the USA. Andre Fabre trains, and she is one to pay attention to
- **8. GLOBAL ASSET -** Daughter of Wootton Bassett, the dam won 3 races, including a Listed race, and was placed in three Group 1 races. Bold show can be expected on her debut

Summary: GLOBAL ASSET (8) has a taking profile and is a half-sister to the classy Glycon, who has won in Group 2 and Group 3 company. She will be expected to make a winning debut at the expense of another well-bred filly in MAINTAIN (6), who is a half-sister to New Ground, who is a winner twice and has been Group 1 placed this year in the Epsom Derby and the Grand Prix de Paris. HEROISTE (3) and LA JUSTICIERE (7) both look good on paper and could be well above average.

C3 - PRIX DU CONSEIL DE PARIS - 2200m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Gr2 - Flat - EUR € 119,000

- **1. CASAPUEBLO -** Placed 2nd on his last two starts, the latter over 2500m in the Grand Prix de Deauville (Gr.2) on August 30th. He might need a few of these to falter
- **2. DUBAI HONOUR -** Ran well to be 2nd at Baden-Baden (DEU) in the Wettstar.de 155 Grosser Preis von Baden (Gr.1) on September 7th. Travels over from the UK and can feature
- **3. JUNKO -** Solid performer in Group races, who was a decent 2nd over 2400m in the Grosser Preis von Berlin (Gr.1) at Hoppegarten (DEU) on August 10th. Decent placed form at this track before and can score
- **4. PATH OF SOLDIER -** Two unplaced runs of late, 4th before that on July 6th at Hamburg-Horn (DEU) in the German Derby over 2400m. Can be opposed in a strong Group race
- **5. CONVERGENT -** Honest performer who scored over 2400m in a Group 3 race at Leopardstown on September 13th. He is improving and warrants respect
- **6. YELLOW JERSEY -** Unbeaten in three runs, the latest success over 2000m in a Class 1 race at Deauville on August 14th by 3L. He is on an upward curve and deserves to step up in class today
- **7. BAY CITY ROLLER -** Two solid 2nd placed efforts of late, the latter over 1950m in the Prix Dollar (Gr.2) at this track on October 4th. Capable of being competitive

Summary: A competitive Group 2, with a lot of closely matched rivals. JUNKO (3) could be the one to come out on top. He was a good second in the Grosser Preis von Berlin (Gr.1) at Hoppegarten last time in August and is a marginal choice ahead of DUBAI HONOUR (2), who also seems in top form with a decent second in the Wettstar.de 155 Grosser Preis von Baden (Gr.1) on September 7th. YELLOW JERSEY (6) steps up in class and is on an upward curve, while BAY CITY ROLLER (7) also merits serious consideration.

C4 - PRIX RIEUSSEC - 3100m (a2m) - TURF - Class 2 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 50,900

- **1. PENTAOUR -** 5th last time out, a win before that over 2800m in a Class 2 handicap at Compiegne on June 21st. He will strip fitter for his recent run 15 days ago and can have a say
- **2. ANNABEL'S GHOST -** Course winner over 2600m in April, he has been a tad below par on his last two starts, but can bounce back to form. He ran a good race when 3rd at Dieppe three starts ago in July in a Class 2 over 3000m. Player
- **3. HASTA LA VISTA -** 5th on his last run over 2800m in a Class 2 handicap at Compiegne on September 16th. More is required in what looks like a stronger race
- **4. RIKA DE LA VIS -** Two tame efforts since she won over 2400m at Chantilly on July 20th in a Class 3 race. She lacks consistency
- **5. XYLOPHONE -** Two wins of late, the latter over 2400m at Saint-Cloud on October 9th in a Class 3 handicap. In form, but this could be a step too far
- **6. STEP MORNING -** Unplaced last time out in September, a win before that over 3000m at Senonnes in a Class 3 handicap on August 2nd. This will require more to score
- **7. VENTOSILLA -** Placed 3rd on her last run over 2300m in a Class 3 handicap on September 22nd. Likely to find a few of these too smart
- **8. WOOT CITY -** Four unplaced efforts of late, placed over this course twice in the spring of this year in a Class 2 and Class 3 race. He can get back on track and be involved
- **9. SUPER ALEX -** 6th on his latest start over 2800m at Compiegne on September 16th in a Class 2 handicap. Among the leading each way contenders
- **10. TIC TAC -** Has failed to trouble the judge in five runs this year, the latest when well beaten at Compiegne on June 21st in a Class 2 handicap over 2800m. Best avoided until showing an improved performance
- **11. ACOTANGO -** Placed 2nd on his last start over 2400m in a Class 3 handicap at Saint-Cloud on October 9th. One to keep onside
- **12. HATIM -** Credible effort to be 3rd at Compiegne on September 16th in a Class 3 handicap over 2800m. Others rate higher
- **13. KER STORMY -** Two unplaced runs of late, a win previously over 2650m at Chateaubriant on August 21st in a Class 3 race. Place chance
- **14. MEHLANGO -** Fair effort to be 3rd over 2400m at Saint-Cloud on October 9th in a Class 3 handicap. One to look at each-way
- **15. BADEN ROCKS -** 5th on his last run in September, a win previously over 3200m at Deauville on August 26th in a Class 3 handicap. Has work ahead of him to be involved
- **16. LORENZO DE MEDICI -** Several good runs this year, a decent 2nd two runs back over 3200m in a Class 2 handicap at Deauville on August 26th. Ought to be in the shake-up



Summary: ANNABEL'S GHOST (2) can return to form after a couple of below-par efforts and is best judged on his third-place finish at Dieppe in July in a Class 2 race over 3000m. He's also a course winner, having scored over 2600m here in April. WOOT CITY (8) has been out of sorts recently but has shown solid course form in the past, with a pair of placings in the spring. MEHLANGO (14) looks a reliable each-way option for punters, while LORENZO DE MEDICI (16) carries a light weight and can run well again. ACOTANGO (11) leads the remainder and is capable of being involved in the finish.

C5 - PRIX CASIMIR DELAMARRE - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Listed - Flat - EUR € 47,600

- **1. VILLA CASTELLO -** Fair effort to be 4th over 2000m in a Listed race at Saint-Cloud on October 3rd. Ought to be involved at the business end
- **2. QUALIXIA** 5th last time out over 1800m in a Listed race in Germany in September, a win previously over 2000m at Vichy in a Class 3 race was a decent effort on August 7th. In the mix
- **3. IRADIE -** Two unplaced runs of late, 6th on the most recent over 2000m in a Listed race at Saint-Cloud on October 3rd. Has work to do
- **4. WALDORA** Five unplaced efforts of late, 9th on the latter over 2000m in a Listed race at Saint-Cloud on October 3rd. Look for an alternative
- **5. RAINBOWS EDGE -** Solid run to be 2nd over 2000m in a Listed race at Saint-Cloud on October 3rd. She makes the trip from the UK and can play a lead role
- **6. SERINES -** 6th last time in a Class 1 handicap on October 4th, a win before that at Chantilly in a Class 2 handicap on September 1st over 1600m. One to consider each-way
- **7. EUBOA -** Unplaced last time, 3rd previously over 2400m in a Listed race at Clairefontaine on August 2nd. Can make the frame at nice odds
- **8. GALAXY -** Recent success over 1600m at Dortmund (DEU) in a conditions race on September 21st. This will be a much stiffer challenge
- **9. VELIKAYA -** Good win by 4.5L over 2000m in a handicap on September 19th at Saint-Cloud last time out. She is improving and can follow up despite the rise in class
- **10. DUNE -** Recent success over 1950m at Le Mans on October 6th in a Class 2 race. One to pay attention to despite the step up in grade
- **11. YOGA MASTER -** Two unplaced runs since she won over 1600m in a Class 2 race at Parislongchamp on May 15th. Capable of being involved
- **12. MIMOS** Three unplaced runs since a 4th in a Group 3 race at Deauville on April 8th over 1400m. Highly tried of late, and the ease in class is a positive

Summary: VELIKAYA (9) looked like a filly on an upward curve when scoring by over four lengths at Saint-Cloud in a handicap in September. She is a marginal choice ahead of the English raider RAINBOWS EDGE (5), who has Oisin Murphy booked to ride and ran well when second at Saint-Cloud in a Listed race on October 3rd. VILLA CASTELLO (1) was back in fourth in the same race and should have a say in proceedings. QUALIXIA (2) and DUNE (10) make up the shortlist.

C6 - PRIX DE SAINT-CYR - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Listed - Flat - EUR € 50,300

- **1. MEDUSA MERGER -** Hearty 6th in a Group III over 1600m at Deauville on the 16th of August 2025. Must be an inclusion in all perms
- **2. ASHIKIDAH** A winner in a Handicap over 1400m at Saint-Cloud on the 19th of September 2025. One to include in all bets
- **3. NARKALA -** A firm winner in a Class 3 Conditional over 1600m at Craon on the 29th of September 2025. Can strongly follow up here
- **4. NAINA** A winner in a Conditional over 1400m at Newmarket on the 4th of October 2025. Hard to recommend here
- **5. MIRACLE BEAUTY -** Encouraging win in a Conditional over 1400m at Fairyhouse on the 22nd of September 2025. Can make her presence felt
- **6. MORGAN BAY -** Lightly raced finishing 4th in a Listed over 1400m at Saint-Cloud on the 3rd of October 2025. One to keep an eye out on for future races
- **7. BLAZING SPIRIT -** A winner in a maiden over 1350m at Lyon Parilly on the 16th of September 2025. Tough opposition at hand
- **8. ALSABA -** Solid effort finishing 4th in a Listed over 1600m at Chantilly on the 28th of June 2025. Can erupt the finishing line
- **9. VERSE OF LOVE -** Pleasant 3rd in a Class 1 Conditional over 1600m at Lyon Parilly on the 21st of September 2025. Quartet contender
- **10. SANTA SAVANA -** Ran 3rd in a Listed over 1400m at Baden Baden on the 6th of September 2025. Others make more appeal
- **11. SCATTERING LIGHT -** Finished 4th in a Listed over 1400m at Dusseldorf on the 5th of October 2025. One to respectfully pass by
- **12. PARIS BABE** Discouraging 16th in a Listed over 1400m at Baden Baden on the 6th of September 2025. Top choices are strongly fancied
- **13. CELESTIAL ORBIT -** Credible 4th in a Listed over 1600m at Sandown on the 17th of September 2025. Can feature into the backend of quartets
- **14. SONADOOR -** Finished 7th in a Class 2 Conditional over 1600m at Compiegne on the 24th of September 2025. Others weigh more attraction
- **15. BEAUJOLAIS NOUVEAU -** Tough 11th in a Conditional over 1200m at Ripon on the 27th of September 2025. One to overlook here
- **16. ALREYYAH -** Finished 7th in a Class 2 Handicap over 1400m at Deauville on the 28th of August 2025. Others preferred
- **17. SECRET WOOD -** Finished 4th in a Listed over 1200m at Deauville on the 10th of August 2025. Very much capable of a honest account of herself



18. DASH OF AZURE - Phenomenal 2nd in a Listed over 1400m at Ascot on the 4th of October 2025. Strong winning chance in this field

Summary: NARKALA (3) delivered a passionate win in her last start and will be trying her heart out to claim her first Listed race here. She is lightly raced and on ability she ticks all the boxes. DASH OF AZURE (18) makes her French soil debut and ran a superb second at Ascot in a Listed in her recent outing. She looks poised to strike and can do so if the top choice is not alert. ASHIKIDAH (2) comes into the race off a win over the distance and must be given serious consideration. ALSABA (8) must be included in all betting calculations.

C7 - PRIX DE LA CHAUSSEE - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Class 3 Handicap - Flat - EUR € 28,800

- **1. THE ANGEL KING -** Forgivable 15th in a Handicap over 1600m at Chantilly on the 30th of September 2025. Can make amends and redeem himself
- **2. ETEL DU NINIAN** Supplemented Etel Du Ninian was a winner in a class 3 Handicap over 1400m at Parislongchamp on the 7th of September 2025. Include in all plays
- **3. LA MANDALA -** Ran 12th in a Class 2 Handicap over 1400m at Compiegne on the 21st of July 2025. Hard to recommend
- **4. ALABAMA MOON -** Tough knocking 9th in a Class 2 Handicap over 1400m at Deauville on the 28th of August 2025. Drops in class and can feature now
- **5. O SOLE MIO -** Good 3rd in a Handicap over 1400m at Parislongchamp on the 4th of September 2025. In good shape and has an each way shout
- **6. GAULOIS GLORIEUX -** Pleasant 5th in a Class 3 Conditional over 1600m at Craon on the 29th of September 2025. Good place chance on form
- **7. PUMALIN PARK -** Off form finishing 13th in a Class 2 Handicap over 1400m at Parislongchamp on the 7th of September 2025. Others preferred
- **8. ZEOLAKIS -** Disappointing 9th in a Conditional over 1000m at Baden Baden on the 31st of August 2025. Others weigh more attraction
- **9. PAINTELLO -** Decent 4th in a Class 3 Handicap over 1200m at Chantilly on the 20th of September 2025. Could feature into larger exotics
- **10. WHITE PLATIN -** Tough 8th in a Class 3 Handicap over 1400m at Lion D'Angers on the 20th of September 2025. Inconsistent form to trust
- **11. LIGHT WAKEUP -** Finished 13th in a Class 1 Handicap over 1600m at Parislongchamp on the 4th of October 2025. One to respectfully pass by
- **12. FAR BEYOND -** Ran 5th in a Handicap over 1400m at La Teste-Bassin Arcachon on the 25th of September 2025. Erratic but capable
- **13. MY BLACK LADY -** A winner in a Class 3 Handicap over 1600m at La Teste-Bassin Arcachon on the 6th of September 2025. Does meet a tough opposition here
- **14. STELLANIA -** Finished 4th in a Class 3 Handicap over 1400m at Lion D'Angers on the 20th of September 2025. One to overlook
- **15. KEREMET -** Trying 7th in a Handicap over 1600m at Lyon Parilly on the 17th of May 2025. Returns after 4 months and good give a good account
- **16. KELLY KEY -** A winner in a Class 3 Handicap over 1400m at Compiegne on the 24th of September 2025. Lurker chance to disrupt the 4th place spot



Summary: THE ANGEL KING (1) can be forgiven for his below par last run as his penultimate run when finishing third in his post maiden run shows he is capable. He is lightly raced and could make a redeeming presence felt. O SOLE MIO (5) delivered an encouraging third over the course and distance and has every chance to go one more as he features on the track and trip again. KEREMET (15) has had only five career starts and this colt could finish much closer than his last two starts suggest. ALABAMA MOON (4) wraps up the mix.
