RACE 2: GO RACING WITH VICKERS.BET RESTRICTED MAIDEN STAKES (GBB RACE)

Shawnee Warrior Foursome All Go

SHAWNEE WARRIOR showed plenty of promise on his racecourse debut at Wetherby over 7f earlier this month, finishing a length and three-quarters behind the winner despite a dwelt start. He looks bred to appreciate this step up in trip and rates a solid contender having run on late in the aforementioned contest. Another who could improve from her debut is Foursome, having not been able to reach the leaders over slightly further last month, while All Go could use Callum Hutchinson's 5lb claim to her advantage.

- 1 EGOISTE Unplaced in both starts. Beaten 8l behind Atheby at 66-1 when 9th of 10 on his latest outing at Nottingham over 1m (good) last month.
- 2 SHAWNEE WARRIOR Half-brother to Prince Of Arran, won three times between 1m and 2m including a Group 3 race. Third of 11 behind Kind Gesture beaten 1 3/4l at 9-1 on his racecourse debut at Wetherby over 7f (good) earlier this month.
- 3 KOTYONOK Unplaced in both starts. Beaten 12l behind Warren Point at 200-1 when eighth of 9 on his latest outing at Doncaster over 1m 2f (good) earlier this month.
- 4 SNOOZE LANE Half-brother to Marie's Diamond, won seven times between 5f and 1m including a Group 3 race. Well beaten at 25-1 behind Asgoodassobergets when last of 8 on his racecourse debut at Wolverhampton over 1m 4f in April.
- 5 STRICTLYAPRINCE Half-brother to Our Little Pony, won seven times at 5f and 6f. Beaten 17l behind Knightswood at 125-1 when seventh of 8 on his racecourse debut here over 1m 4f (good) earlier this month.
- 6 DIAMOND GIRL Unplaced in both starts. Finished 13l behind Flamenco Fan when sixth of 7 at 40-1 on her latest outing at Windsor over 6f (good to firm) last month.
- 7 FOURSOME Half-sister to Peace And Plenty, won twice at 1m 2f. Finished 6l behind Atheby when sixth of 10 at 3-1 on her racecourse debut at Nottingham over 1m (good) last month.
- 8 ALL GO Placed in three of four starts. Third of 6 behind Spells At Dawn beaten 1l at 4-1 on her latest outing at Beverley over 7f (good to firm) last month.

Agapanther King Of War Amjad

AGAPANTHER previously won over this distance at Kempton last month and was not disgraced in second behind Pablo Del Pueblo over 6f on her latest attempt. She remains 4lb higher than her last winning mark but Harry Davies' 5lb claim makes her look feasibly treated in this contest, so she gets the vote ahead of King Of War who could prefer further to succeed. The David Evans-trained Amjad is another who is likely to require a stiffer stamina test having stayed on over 1m previously.

JACKMEISTER RUDI had been knocking on the door prior to getting off the mark at Brighton on his latest start and the son of Churchill is open to further improvement off a 3lb higher rating. Hope Probe's recent course form is likely to see him enter calculations, in particular his victory over 5f last time, while Iconic Knight and Bondi Girl are others with viable claims.

- 1 AVIARY Placed twice in nine starts. Beaten 11l behind Light Up Our Stars at 20-1 when 11th of 13 on her latest outing at Wolverhampton over 1m 1f in October last year. Having her first run for a new stable today, previously with B R Millman.

- 2 **ICONIC KNIGHT** Winner of six races from 5f to 7f on ground varying from firm to soft and on the all-weather. Third of 5 behind Street Parade beaten 3/4l at 5-1 on his latest outing at Brighton over 5f (good to firm) earlier this month.
- 3 **JACKMEISTER RUDI** Won on his latest outing when 11-8fav at Brighton over 6f (good to soft) earlier this month, beating Boom The Groom by 1 1/4l.
- 4 **DIVA DANCER** Yet to place in eight starts. Beaten 12l behind Fox Hill at 14-1 when seventh of 10 on her latest outing at Nottingham over 6f (good) earlier this month.
- 5 **HOPE PROBE** Successful at 5f and 7f on good to firm and good ground. Won on his latest outing when 7-4fav here over 5f (good) earlier this month, beating Iconic Knight by 1 3/4l.
- 6 **MORE THAN LIKELY** Winner of five races at 6f on ground varying from firm to good and on the all-weather. Finished 5l behind Hope Probe when last of 5 at 10-3 on her latest outing here over 5f (good) earlier this month.

- 3 FOR PEAT'S SAKE A winner at 5f on the all-weather. Finished 4l behind Blazing Hot when fifth of 9 at 11-2 on his latest outing at Newcastle over 5f in January.

- 3 CONQUERING Unplaced in both starts. Well beaten at 100-1 behind Special Envoy when 13th of 14 on his latest outing at Windsor over 1m 2f (soft) earlier this month.
