### RACE 1: RACING TV PROFITS RETURNED TO RACING HANDICAP

**Exquisitely      Mary Of Modena      Firenze Rosa**

EXQUISITELY has stepped forward since joining her current stable, following a win at Ffos Las with a last-gasp Goodwood defeat. She appears to have more to offer and is expected to confirm her latest effort with Mary Of Modena. The latter has scored twice on soft ground this season, though, and still commands plenty of respect, while others to note include Firenze Rosa and Bang On The Bell.

- 1      EXQUISITELY      A winner at 5f on heavy ground. Beaten a nose by Dream By Day when second of 7 at 13-2 on her latest outing at Goodwood over 5f (good) last month.
- 2      TRUSTY RUSTY      Winner of five races from 5f to 6f on good to firm and good ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 9l behind Good Earth at 80-1 when 13th of 14 on her latest outing over this course and distance (good) last month.
- 3      EM JAY KAY      Successful at 5f and 6f on the all-weather. Finished 5l behind Dark Side Thunder when fifth of 8 at 5-2fav on his latest outing at Southwell over 6f in April.
- 4      MARY OF MODENA      Winner of five races from 5f to 6f on good and soft ground. Finished 2l behind Dream By Day when fourth of 7 at 6-1 on her latest outing at Goodwood over 5f (good) last month. Has won at Newmarket and Windsor this season.
- 5      HARB      He has won three times from 5f to 6f on the all-weather. Beaten 14l behind Shoot To Kill at 10-1 when 12th of 13 on his latest outing at Brighton over 1m (good) last month.
- 6      BANG ON THE BELL      Winner of six races from 5f to 6f on good and soft ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 5l behind Nelson Gay at 15-2 when seventh of 9 on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 5f earlier this month. Has won 3 times this season.
- 7      PAPABELLA      Unplaced in all four starts. Beaten 9l behind Hurt You Never at 22-1 when last of 11 on her latest outing at Newbury over 6f (good to firm) in June.
- 8      FIRENZE ROSA      Winner of six races from 5f to 6f on ground varying from good to soft to heavy. Finished 5l behind dead-heaters Joy Choi and Tilia Cordata when fifth of 6 at 10-3 on her latest outing at Salisbury over 5f (good) last month.

### RACE 2: BRITISH STALLION STUDS EBF MAIDEN STAKES (GBB RACE)

**Whiskey Pete      Kingdom Of Time      Dambuster**

Ralph Beckett has enjoyed a strong season with his juveniles and WHISKEY PETE appears more than capable of shedding his maiden tag at the third attempt. Bred to stay well, as a half-brother to Candleford and Atty Persse, he has made the frame at Newmarket and Haydock, and the stiffer test

of stamina on this occasion is likely to yield further progression. Kingdom Of Time finished fourth at Newmarket on debut and is entitled to step forward with a tongue-tie now applied. Dambuster boasts a smart pedigree and has to be respected, as does Always A Star.

- 4 GO DADDY Foaled 23 Jan. Half-brother to Inteldream, won twice at 1m 4f and 1m 6f. Placed once in two starts. Beaten 8l behind Going The Distance at 11-4fav when eighth of 9 on his latest outing at Ffos Las over 7f (good to soft) last month.
- 5 KINGDOM OF TIME Foaled 2 Mar. Dam won twice at 7f. Finished 4 1/2l behind True Wisdom when fourth of 7 at 7-2 on his racecourse debut at Newmarket over 1m (good to firm) last month.
- 6 MUTTASIL Foaled 23 Feb. Dam won at 7f.
- 7 SCREAMING EAGLE Foaled 26 Mar. Dam unraced.
- 8 SUPERPOSITION Foaled 11 Feb. Half-brother to Poetic Union, won at 6f. Placed once in two starts. Third of 8 behind Mai Dubai beaten 1 3/4l at 11-10fav on his latest outing at Southwell over 7f last month.

**RACE 3: FOLLOW RACINGTV ON X NOVICE STAKES (GGB RACE)**

**The Line Navy Jack Winterfair**

THE LINE made a promising start to his career when third over 5f at Ascot in May and the son of Caravaggio, who has been gelded since, is expected to benefit from stepping up in trip, given the manner of his finishing effort. Navy Jack was disappointing when a beaten favourite at Newbury, but he is better judged on his C&D second the time before. Winterfair, whose dam is a half-sister to Camelot, and Imperial Guard appeal most of the newcomers.

**RACE 4: CHASEMORE FARM FORTUNE STAKES (LISTED)****Knight Chindit Sir Busker**

Chindit was a commanding winner of the Superior Mile at Haydock but while he merits respect, Richard Hannon's entire might struggle to concede 9lb to the unexposed KNIGHT. The son of Mehmas was collared late on in the Celebration Mile at Goodwood but first-time cheekpieces could

eke out further improvement, and he won the Horris Hill in testing ground around this time last year. The returning Sir Busker can follow the pair home.

- 1 CHINDIT Has won eight races from 7f to 1m on ground varying from good to firm to good to soft. A winner at 5-2 in the Group 3 Superior Mile Stakes at Haydock over 1m (good) on his latest outing earlier this month, beating Light Infantry by 2 1/4l. Has also won at Ascot this season.
- 2 EYDON A winner at 1m 1f on good ground. Finished 4 1/2l behind Coroebus when fourth of 15 at 33-1 on his latest outing in the Group 1 Qipco 2000 Guineas at Newmarket over 1m (good) in April last year. Having his first run for a new stable today, previously with Roger Varian.
- 3 RAADOBARG Winner of five races from 7f to 1m on ground varying from good to firm to soft - heavy. Finished 2 1/2l behind Poker Face when fifth of 10 at 8-1 on his latest outing at Deauville over 1m (soft) last month.
- 4 SIR BUSKER Winner of six races from 6f to 1m 2f on ground varying from good to firm to good to soft and on the all-weather. Beaten 6l behind Lord North when 10th of 14 on his latest outing in the Group 1 Dubai Turf Sponsored By DP World - Turf at Meydan over 1m 1f in March.
- 5 KNIGHT Successful twice at 7f on good to soft and heavy ground. Beaten 1/2l by Angel Bleu when second of 7 at 11-2 on his latest outing in the Group 2 William Hill Celebration Mile Stakes at Goodwood over 1m (soft) last month.
- 6 LORD OF BISCAY Successful at 7f and 1m on good to firm and good ground. Finished 2 1/2l behind Mr Moliere when fourth of 12 on his latest outing at Chantilly over 1m (good to soft) in July.
- 7 SILVER SWORD He has won three times at 1m on good to firm ground and on the all-weather. A winner at 15-2 at York over 1m (good to firm) on his latest outing last month, beating Catch The Paddy by 3/4l. Has won 3 times this season.
- 8 PURPLEPAY She has won four times from 1m to 1m 1f on soft ground. Finished 4l behind Heredia when sixth of 10 at 11-1 on her latest outing over this course and distance (good) earlier this month.
- 9 BREEGE A winner at 5f on good to firm ground. Finished 6l behind Heredia when fifth of 13 at 3-1fav on her latest outing at Haydock over 1m (good to soft) last month.
- 10 NOVUS She has won three times from 6f to 1m on soft ground. Finished 2 1/4l behind Heredia when fourth of 10 at 25-1 on her latest outing over this course and distance (good) earlier this month. Has won twice at Goodwood this season.
