### RACE 1: CAZOO FLORIDA HANDICAP

**Songo**                      **Wots The Wifi Code**                      **Colinton**

SONGO won in decent style when returning to the Flat at Bath earlier in the month and a 5lb rise might not be enough to stop him from backing that performance up. Wots The Wifi Code has taken his form to a new level this season and the extra couple of furlongs may yield further improvement, while Colinton and Screaming Petrus appeal most of the remainder.

- 6            WOTS THE WIFI CODE                        He has won three times from 1m to 1m 2f on good to soft ground. Third of 8 behind Billy Roberts beaten 1 1/4l at 7-2 on his latest outing at Ripon over 1m 2f (good) earlier this month.
  
- 7            SONGO                                         Winner of five races from 1m 2f to 1m 4f on good to firm and good ground and on the all-weather. Won on his latest outing when 13-8fav at Bath over 1m 4f (good to firm) earlier this month, beating Gold Standard by 2l.
  
- 8            INNSE GALL                                    Successful at 1m and 1m 2f on good and good to soft ground. Beaten 18l behind Star Shield at 13-2 when 9th of 11 on his latest outing at Newcastle over 1m in November last year.

BANDINELLI arrives having won four of his last five outings, which included his return from a break at Kempton in March, and the son of Dubawi remains open to further improvement on just his third start over 2m. Goobinator was last seen on the Flat when fourth in the Cesarewitch at Newmarket and he is likely to enter the reckoning along with Melrose winner Valley Forge, who may have needed his first run of the season at Newmarket, and Alright Sunshine.

3      DARK JEDI                                      He has won four times from 7f to 1m 4f on ground varying from good to soft. Beaten 18l behind Gaassee at 16-1 when 10th of 11 on his latest outing at York over 1m 4f (good) earlier this month.

4      SKYCUTTER                                      Successful twice at 1m 2f on soft ground; has also won two hurdles (latest NH win was in December last year). Finished 5l behind Baryshnikov when fifth of 7 at 17-2 on his latest outing at Chester over 1m 2f (good to soft) earlier this month.

5      MERVEILLO                                      He has won three times from 1m 2f to 1m 4f. Finished 8l behind Ahorsewithnoname when fourth of 7 at 33-1 on his latest outing at Newbury over 2m (good) last month.

6      JUST HUBERT                                      Winner of seven races from 1m 2f to 2m 5f on ground varying from good to firm to good to soft. Beaten 9l behind Juan De Montalban at 25-1 when 11th of 16 on his latest outing at Ascot over 1m 4f (good) earlier this month.

7      GOLDEN FLAME                                      He has won three times from 1m 4f to 1m 6f on good to firm ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 9l behind Cemhaan at 17-2 when seventh of 9 on his latest outing at Newmarket over 1m 6f (good to firm) earlier this month.

9 VALLEY FORGE Successful at 1m 4f and 1m 6f on good to firm and good ground. Finished 5l behind Cemhaan when fifth of 9 at 5-1 on his latest outing at Newmarket over 1m 6f (good to firm) earlier this month.

10 GOOBINATOR He has won three times from 1m 4f to 2m on good to firm and good ground and on the all-weather; has also won three hurdles. Finished 11l behind Buzz when fourth of 32 at 14-1 on his latest flat outing at Newmarket over 2m 2f (good) in October last year.

MIGHTY ULYSSES didn't quite appear to get home over 1m2f in Epsom's Derby trial, having raced freely in the early stages, before making amends back over this trip in a novice event at Newmarket last Friday. Benoit De La Sayette partners the colt once again, taking a valuable 5lb off, and victory here could propel him towards Pattern class. Spirit Catcher (first) and Dirtyoldtown (second) were closely matched at Musselburgh last month and similar is expected on this occasion. Whoputfiftyinyou, unbeaten in three outings, and Tollard Royal are others who are capable of a decent showing.

In a competitive renewal of this contest the marginal preference is for GO BEARS GO, who was a Group 2 winner and Group 1-placed over 6f last year. The son of Kodi Bear confirmed his well-being when winning at Ascot last month and it would be no surprise to see the consistent colt make the frame once again. Wings Of War was behind the selection at Ascot but first-time cheekpieces may bring about some improvement, while the highly-progressive El Caballo is another with strong form claims.

Although the sole Group 1 winner in the field, Winter Power returns for her seasonal reappearance and her best efforts have come away from this venue, so it may be best to look elsewhere. With that in mind, course specialist CAME FROM THE DARK gets the nod to land the spoils despite failing to fire at Newmarket last time out. The Ed Walker-trained gelding can record a fourth course victory, while Mondammej also demands respect after an encouraging effort at Newmarket last time out.
