Alsvinder Stronsay Alex Gracie

ALSVINDER returned to winning ways at Ayr earlier in the month when taking advantage of his much lower turf mark and the eight-year-old is capable of backing that performance up. Stronsay has been in mostly consistent form in recent weeks and he is expected to give another solid account following his recent third at Hamilton. Alex Gracie, who finished second at Nottingham on her return last week, and Gullane One are others worth considering.

He should prove hard to catch with the same tactics in this field, though recent winner Merry Secret will make sure he has company at the head of affairs. Time Has Wings is another danger at these weights but may struggle to get home in a fast run race.

She has the perfect draw in the one stall to try the same tactics and may win her first race in clsoe to a year. Denzil's Laughing looks interesting having won over course and distance off this mark in April in lesser grade, as does Militia who is on a handy rating he has won from before, and represents the in-form Paul Midgley stable.
