RACE 1: BRITISH STALLION STUDS EBF MAIDEN FILLIES' STAKES (GBB RACE)

Immortal Beauty Lady Hollywood Radio Goo Goo

IMMORTAL BEAUTY shaped with considerable promise when third on her debut at Ascot, when displaying signs of greenness, and the daughter of Cotai Glory is expected to step forward from that display. Lady Hollywood warrants plenty of respect following her second at Catterick earlier in the month, while Radio Goo Goo, who has run with credit on each start, and newcomer Keep Bidding appear best of the remainder.

Secret State Laasudood Fresh Fancy

SECRET STATE built on a promising display in the Wood Ditton at Newmarket when going one better to score at Chester earlier in the month and the drop back in trip is unlikely to be an issue for Charlie Appleby's colt. Laasudood won on his second outing at Kempton in October and the son of War Front is capable of further improvement, while others to consider include Fresh Fancy, Sikorsky and La Yakel.

Ciao Adios Dansemai By Pass

CIAO ADIOS is bred to improve for the step up to a mile and the use of Liam Browne's 7lb claim is likely to aid her cause in a contest lacking much depth on paper. Dansemai improved on her handicap bow when third at Southwell and she is of interest along with By Pass, who sports a visor for the first time following her recent fifth at Brighton.

Caradoc Dubai Mirage Dark Shift

Godolphin look to have a couple of solid chances with Dubai Mirage and Dubai Icon, who were both last seen running at Meydan earlier this year, while course scorer Dark Shift is likely to improve on his comeback effort at Ascot. However, CARADOC is fancied to notch his first win since September 2019. He posted a solid fifth-placed effort on his comeback run at Newbury last month and a subsequent runner-up finish at Goodwood was arguably a career-best performance. He seems trip-versatile and the ground should be fast enough for him today, so a big run looks on the cards.

Sid's Annie Gangway Australian Harbour

SID'S ANNIE has done little wrong in six all-weather starts and 1m victories at both Kempton and Southwell earlier this year show her to be heading the right way. This step up in trip is unlikely to pose any problems and, providing she takes to turf, the hat-trick seeking filly could prove a tough nut to crack. Gangway has won two of his last three outings and looks an obvious danger, while Australian Harbour, Fifteenthamendment and Shivraj add further spice to the race.
