RACE 1: TELLISFORD HANDICAP

Buy Me Back Libertine Belle Spring Bloom

BUY ME BACK arrives here on the back of victories at Windsor and Brighton in recent weeks and a 5lb penalty may not be enough to stop her from making it a hat-trick this afternoon. Libertine Belle was a bit disappointing at Newmarket last time but is a player based on her previous success at Goodwood, while Spring Bloom and Spurofthemoment also merit consideration.

RACE 2: MARTIN DENSHAM MEMORIAL EBF MAIDEN STAKES (GBB RACE)

Dukedom King's Guard Thesis

This is traditionally a very strong maiden, with the subsequent 2000 Guineas winner Kameko featuring on the recent roll of honour, and DUKEDOM could add his name to that list today. The son of Dubawi is out of a Group 3-winning and multiple Group 1-placed mare and he was unfortunate to bump into an exciting prospect when finishing second on his debut over C&D earlier in the month. With that experience under his belt, the Queen's colt should be hard to stop this afternoon. King's Guard has filled second place in both of his previous starts and should be in the mix once again. Thesis is arguably the most interesting newcomer, being a half-brother to Fillies' Mile winner Quadrilateral, although Bullet Force and Majalh also merit consideration.

INSPIRAL created a big impression when winning on debut over 7f at Newmarket last month and that form was boosted when the second and third fought out the finish of a similar race a couple of weeks later. This daughter of Frankel is likely to improve significantly for that experience and she should be capable of making her mark at this level. Wild Beauty also looks to have a very bright future, having defied a penalty when scoring in a novice event at Newbury a month ago, and she could be the main threat to the selection. Others to note are Sunstrike, Allayaali and Qipao.
