Puntastic

The William Haggas-trained VINTAGE CHOICE made a promising start when finishing third in the Convivial maiden at York last month and the son of Lope De Vega may not require much improvement in order to land this contest. Out From Under's latest disqualification (when passing the post first at Ffos Las) can probably be excused on the basis of inexperience at this stage and he looks the main threat to the selection, with Puntastic also worthy of respect after showing encouragement when fourth on his debut at Haydock.

AWEEDRAM cashed in on a reduced mark when last seen at Chester and was given a 5lb rise for his return to form. That success has subsequently been boosted and the five-year-old gelding still looks well treated on his old form and can add another victory to his career tally here. Whatwouldyouknow could be the main danger if building on his Wolverhampton win, while Golden Dove also merits consideration after some consistent displays.

1 AWEEDRAM He has won three times from 1m to 1m 2f on ground varying from good to firm to soft. A winner at 8-1 at Chester over 1m 2f (good to soft) on his latest outing last month, beating Fairmac by 1 1/2l.

2 SANDRET He has won three times from 6f to 1m 2f on good to firm and good ground and on the all-weather, but last win was over two years ago. Third of 4 behind Fairmac beaten 2l at 8-1 on his latest outing at Haydock over 1m 2f (good to firm) earlier this month.

3 WHATWOULDYOUKNOW Has won nine races from 1m 1f to 1m 2f on good to firm ground and on the all-weather. A winner at 15-2 at Wolverhampton over 1m 1f on his latest outing last month, beating Glendun by 3 1/2l. Has won 3 times this season.

4 KEHAILAAN A winner at 1m on the all-weather. Finished 8l behind Pistoletto when fifth of 6 at 10-3 on his latest outing at Chelmsford City over 1m 2f earlier this month.

5 FREAK OUT A winner at 7f on good ground. Beaten 14l behind Bookmark at 22-1 when seventh of 8 on his latest outing at Chester over 1m 2f (good) earlier this month.

6 BULLS AYE A winner at 7f on good ground. Finished 4 1/2l behind Gweedore when sixth of 8 at 4-1 on his latest outing at Musselburgh over 1m (good to soft) earlier this month.

7 DR RIO He has won three times from 7f to 1m 1f on good and soft ground and on the all-weather, but last win was over two years ago. Beaten 5l behind Trinity Girl at 10-1 when seventh of 11 on his latest outing at Doncaster over 1m 4f (good) in June. Having his first run for a new stable today.

8 GOLDEN DOVE A winner at 1m 1f on soft ground. Third of 6 behind Golden Hind beaten 1 3/4l at 2-1 on her latest outing at Thirsk over 1m 4f (good to firm) earlier this month.

STRAWBERRY JACK should appreciate this ease in grade and looks to be well treated at the weights. The five-year-old gelding as already tasted success at Bath this season and has strong form in small fields. Streak Lightning could be the danger if bouncing back to form after a disappointing run on his stable debut at Pontefract, while Elusive Heights and Mythical Madness also have to be considered.

Well beaten at 14-1 behind Enigmatic when last of 10 on his latest outing at Pontefract over 1m (good to firm) earlier this month. Has won at Beverley and Newcastle this season.

2 MYTHICAL MADNESS Has won 12 races from 1m to 1m 2f on ground varying from good to firm to good to soft and on the all-weather. Finished 9l behind Curtiz when sixth of 7 at 12-1 on his latest outing at Epsom over 1m (good) earlier this month. Has won twice at Epsom this season.

3 PALAZZO He has won four times from 7f to 1m on the all-weather. Finished 5l behind Lexington Warfare when sixth of 11 at 20-1 on his latest outing at Newcastle over 7f earlier this month.

4 STRAWBERRY JACK He has won four times from 7f to 1m on good to firm ground and on the all-weather. Finished 9l behind Rhubarb Bikini when sixth of 8 at 5-1 on his latest outing at Chelmsford City over 1m last month.

Hurstwood hinted at a return to form at Pontefract and is likely to be on the premises if building on that run, while Gullane One and Secret Equity also make the shortlist.

3 HURSTWOOD He has won four times from 5f to 6f on good to firm and soft ground and on the all-weather. Finished 2l behind Motawaazy when fourth of 12 at 11-1 on his latest outing at Pontefract over 6f (good to firm) earlier this month.
