C1 - PRIX DE BILLERE - 1400m (a7f) - ALL WEATHER - Maiden - Flat - EUR € 21,000

- **1. MUENCHEN -** Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in a Conditions race at Toulouse over 1600m on 24 September. Can go one better
- **2. REVE DU FRAISSE -** Showed some improvement second time out and was third in a Conditions race at La Testa-du-Buch over 1900m on 25 September. Can contest the finish
- **3. ROCKONADO -** Unreliable and finished 6th in a Conditions race at Dax over 1200m on 5 October. Might play a minor role at best
- **4. FIERY KITTEN -** Finished 8th in a Conditions race at Dax over 1200m on 5 October. Did better on debut but needs to find a few lengths to win
- **5. SHEMANA -** Has struggled so far and finished 9th in a claimer at Toulouse over 1600m on 3 September. Needs major improvement ro win
- **6. VOLKONSKHA -** Consistent and was runner-up in a Conditions race at Toulouse over 1400m on 10 October. Be right there at the finish
- **7. ROMAN MOON -** Has not shown much so far and finished 7th in a Conditions race at Dax over 1200m on 5 October. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **8. LUMENYA -** Only modest so far and finished 7th in a Conditions race at Toulouse over 1600m on 24 September. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **9. WITE TOAST** Has run well in both starts and was third in a Conditions race at Dax over 1200m on 5 October. Can make the frame
- **10. ROSAY BAY CEN -** Showed some improvement when 6th in a Conditions race at Toulouse over 1600m on 24 September. Might play a minor role at very best
- **11. MARYCHA -** A two-year-old filly by Morandi out of Marie Shams who makes her debut. Her Dam won once in just 6 start. Watch the betting

Summary: MUENCHEN (1) is threatening a first win. He was beaten by a good sort last time out and looks the right one for this opening event. VOLKONSKHA (6) has finished runner-up in three of her six starts and should be a threat once again. REVE DU FRAISSE (2) showed improvement second time out but may need further than this distance. WHITE TOAST (9) has run well in both starts and can make the frame.

C2 - PRIX DE GABASTON - 2000m (a1m1/4) - ALL WEATHER - Maiden - Flat - EUR € 21,000

- **1. LA FAMA -** Showed some improvement when third in a claimer at Auch over 2000m on 5 October. Could make the frame
- **2. FANCY -** Unplaced on debut in a Conditions race at Toulouse over 1600m on 24 September. Capable of improvement and might play a minor role
- **3. L'ABBAYE -** Not disgraced when fifth in a Conditions race at Salon-de-Provence over 1800m on 30 September. Capable of contesting the finish
- **4. NEBULEUSE'K -** Did not show on debut when 9th in a Conditions race at La Testa-du-Buch 1900m on 25 September. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- **5. TOUCH IN THE NIGHT -** Has struggled so far and was usnplaced in a Conditions race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1600m on 14 October. Needs major improvement to win
- **6. NERIDA -** A good third on debut in a Conditions race at Toulouse over 1600m on 24 September. Should be a threat this longer distance
- **7. LA ALMADIA -** Disappointing last run when 6th in a Conditions race at La Testa-du-Buch over 1900m on 25 September. Could earn some minor money
- **8. XINGA -** Has not shown much show so far and finished 7th in a claimer at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1000m on 29 April. Returns from break and others are preferred
- **9. I AM STILL STANDING -** Showed promise on debut when fifth in a Conditions race at Marseille-Borely over 1800m on 13 October. Big chance with improvement likely
- **10. DIVA CHIQUITA -** Showed some improvement when runner-up in a Conditions race at La Testa-du-Buch over 1900m on 25 September. Can go one better
- **11. EAGLE SPEED -** Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Conditions race at Toulouse over 1400m on 10 October. More is needed to win

Summary: I AM STILL STANDING (9) ran well in a good field of colts on debut. This looks a weaker race, and she should make a bold bid for victory. NERIDA (6) ran well on debut and can do even better over this longer distance. DIVA CHIQUITA (10) showed improvement in her second start and should appreciate this track and trip, so it would not be a surprise if she won. L'ABBAYE (3) is capable of improvement and can earn some prize money.

C3 - PRIX D'ARETTE - 2000m (a1m1/4) - ALL WEATHER - Class 2 - Flat - EUR € 20,100

- **1. SHARP RISE -** Has struggled of late and finished 9th at Toulouse over 2400m on 17 September. Likes this track and is capable of an upset
- **2. EUGENE SMITH -** Unreliable of late and was fifth in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 25 September. Capable of winning a race of this nature
- **3. MORPHEWAN -** Not disgraced when fourth in a Conditions race at Marseille-Borely over 2000m on 27 September. Likes the PSF and can win
- **4. ETATIQUE -** Unreliable and was fifth in a handicap at Toulouse over 2000m on 1 October. Has a place chance on best form
- **5. TOIMY SON -** Not reliable and finished fifth in a Conditions race at La Testa-du-Buch over 1900m on 25 September. Can make the frame
- **6. AGADOR -** Very consistent and was runner-up in a Conditions race at Dax over 2300m on 31 July. Can be competitive yet again
- **7. VALZAK -** Has really struggled of late and was unplaced in a handicap at La Testa-du-Buch over 2000m on 27 July. Needs major improvement to win
- **8. NOBLEMAN -** In good form and was fourth in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1600m on 29 April. Returns from a break but is not out of it

Summary: A competitive field. MORPHEWAN (3) has yet to win a race this year but has contested stronger races than this in most of his recent starts. He likes the PSF and could be ready to score. EUGENE SMITH (2) has been only fair of late but performs well at this track and should be involved in the finish. NOBLEMAN (8) returns from a break but would not be a surprise winner. AGADOR (6) is very consistent and can shine once again.

C4 - PRIX D'ARUDY - 2000m (a1m1/4) - ALL WEATHER - Maiden - Flat - EUR € 21,000

- **1. PLUTARQUE -** Has run well in both starts and was fourth in a Conditions race at Toulouse over 1600m on 24 September. Be right there at the finish
- **2. MOUSTIQUE -** Unreliable and finished fifth in a Conditions race at La Testa-du-Buch over 1900m on 25 September. Has a place chance in this line-up
- **3. CAPITOL HILL -** In good shape and was third in a claimer at Toulouse over 1600m on 1 October. Might play a minor role at best
- **4. HERCULE STAR -** Not disgraced when fifth on debut in a Conditions race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1900m on 29 September. Should fight out the finish
- **5. GRASWANG -** A runner-up on debut in a Conditions race at Salon-de-Provence over 1800m on 13 September. Big chance in this line-up
- **6. TEXAS WOOD -** Not disgraced when 6th on debut in a Conditions race at Salon-de-Provence over 1800m on 13 September. Capable of improvement and could make the frame
- **7. ESPRONCEDA -** Finished 8th on debut in a Conditions race at La Testa-du-Buch over 1900m on 25 September. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- **8. DADDY MOON -** Finished 9th on debut in a Conditions race at La Testa-du-Buch over 1900m on 25 September. More is needed to win this race
- **9. NEWLOVE DE BRABOIS -** A two-year-old colt by Anodin out of Kalneyeva who makes his debut. His mother won 3 of her 22 starts. Watch the betting
- **10. THE FIST -** A two-year-old colt by The Grey Gatsby out of Mme de Montespan who makes his debut. His mother was unplaced in both starts. Watch the betting

Summary: GRASWANG (5) was narrowly beaten on debut, and that winner has scored at a higher level since. He looks the one to beat. HERCULE STAR (4) was not disgraced on debut, and improvement is likely, so he could be the biggest threat. PLUTARQUE (1) steps up in distance and should be competitive once again. TEXAS WOOD (6) has had only one start, is likely to improve, and can make the frame.

C5 - PRIX DE LONS - 1600m (a1m) - ALL WEATHER - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 12,500

- **1. KHAMALGANE -** In good form and was third in a Conditions race at La Roche-Posay over 1700m on 14 September. Has claims in this line-up
- **2. GOOD'ID -** Has some fair form and finished fifth in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1900m on 14 October. Can be competitive in this line-up
- 3. KHELYSTORM Has not shown much so far and was 6th in a claimer at Royan La Palmyre over 1600m on 20 September. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. JUBBAH -** Has struggled of late and finished 6th in a handicap at Tarbes over 2100m on 30 August. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **5. ROGUE STAR -** Showed some improvement when fifth in a handicap at Toulouse over 1400m on 10 October. Yet to win a race but might play a minor role
- **6. RICHMOND -** Unreliable and finished 8th in a Conditions race at Castéra-Verduzan over 1700m on 13 July. Has won at this track and is not out of it
- **7. MASDREAM -** Yet to win a race and finished 9th in a handicap at Toulouse over 1400m on 10 October. Others are much preferred
- **8. ROYAL VATI -** Only modest of late and finished 8th in a Handicap at Toulouse over 1400m on 10 October. Better on this surface and can get involved with the finish
- **9. ZASTER FOR ALL -** Unreliable and was third in a handicap at Toulouse over 1600m on 24 September. Can contest the finish once again
- **10. DO IT FOR ME -** Only modest of late and finished 6th in a handicap at Toulouse over 1400m on 10 October. More is needed to win this race
- 11. PETITE COQUINE Battling to regain best form and was unplaced in a handicap at Mont-de-Marsan over 1400m on 1 August. Needs major improvement to win
- **12. AL RASSOUL -** Did not show his best when 8th in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1900m on 14 October. Has a place chance in this line-up
- **13. BEST OFFER -** Has struggled all year and finished 6th in a handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 1500m on 8 October. Yet to win a race and others make more appeal
- **14. VLASIKHOVA -** Has struggled all year and was 10th in a handicap at Toulouse over 1400m on 10 October. Needs to do more to win a race

Summary: KHAMALGANE (1) has struggled in handicaps of late but ran well in a conditions race last time out and can win if repeating that level of form. ZASTER FOR ALL (9) is unreliable and has not been very good at this track, but he arrives here after a good performance and is not without a chance. GOOD'ID (2) has yet to win a race but is consistent and can be involved in the finish. ROYAL VATI (8) likes this surface and can get into the mix.

C6 - PRIX D'ARTIGUELOUTAN - 2000m (a1m1/4) - ALL WEATHER - Maiden - Flat - EUR € 11,900

- **1. ICONIC STARS -** Has shown improvement and was runner-up at Madrid over 1900m on 29 September. Can earn some more money
- **2. MARQUISIENNE -** Only modest of late and finished 6th at Cazaubon-Barbotan over 1900m on 29 September. Capable of an upset at this track
- **3. TAMAGHU -** Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Conditions race at Dax over 2300m on 21 September. Capable of better and has a place chance
- **4. SON OF REALITY -** Only modest so far and was fifth at Madrid over 1700m on 11 September. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- **5. GARE AU GORILLE -** Has some fair form and finished fifth in a Conditions race at Dax over 2100m on 5 October. Can make the frame
- **6. SPARK GOLD -** Finished 7th in a Conditions race at Niort over 2250m on 12 October. Capable of better but others are preferred
- **7. VIKTHOR -** Unreliable and finished 7th in a claimer at Dax over 2100m on 19 May. Returns from a break and needs to improve to win
- **8. FASCINANTE -** A four-year-old filly by Fas out of Astrobola who makes her debut. Her mother won her second start. Watch the betting
- **9. MALICIA -** Disappointing last run when 7th in a Conditions race at La Testa-du-Buch over 1800m on 16 June. In good form before that and can be competitive in this line-up
- **10. BOGOTA** Did not show her beat when unplaced in a Conditions race at Chantilly over 2000m on 28 April. Better this surface and can score returning from a break
- **11. ADA THORNE -** Disappointing last run when 8th in a Conditions race at Mont-de-Marsan over 2000m on 10 September. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
- **12. ISLAND SUNRISE -** Showed some improvement when fourth in a Conditions race at Nancy over 2000m on 12 October. Can contest the finish

Summary: BOGOTA (10) returns from a break after a disappointing last performance. Her form before that was good, and she can break the ice. ISLAND SUNRISE (12) is improving and can be a threat trying this surface for the first time. ADA THORNE (11) has not been reliable so far, but she is capable of contesting the finish if at her best. MALICIA (9) is better than her last run suggests and can be involved in the finish.

C7 - PRIX DE SAINT-FAUST - 1600m (a1m) - ALL WEATHER - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 14,400

- **1. BONDINI -** Disappointing last run when 6th in conditions at Dax over 2100m on 5 October. In good form before that and can contest the finish
- **2. HINAT -** Only modest of late and was 6th in a handicap at Toulouse over 1400m on 10 October. Yet to win a race but has a place chance
- **3. ENTRE NOUS -** Has struggled of latea and was 8th at Cazaubon-Barbotan over 1900m on 19 September. Capable of better and others are preferred
- **4. ROI DE FLANDRE -** Has struggled of late and was 9th in a handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 1500m on 21 June. Capable of better and could play a minor role
- **5. BLOOD DIAMOND -** Has struggled all year and was 6th in a handicap at Niort over 1400m on 14 September. On a long losing streak and others are preferred
- **6. PORT GALLAND -** Only moderate of late and was 8th in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1900m on 14 October. Needs to do more to win this race
- **7. LUCKY LADY -** Has struggled of late and was 14th in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1600m on 8 September. Might earn some minor money
- **8. SUPER CUTE -** Only modest of late and was 11th in a handicap at La Teste-de-Buch over 2000m on 25 September. Has run well at this track before and is not out of it
- **9. ODIN -** Only modest of late and was 7th in a handicap at Toulouse over 1400m on 10 October. Capable of better and has claims
- **10. OLIVA -** Has struggled of late and was 13th in a handicap at Toulouse over 1600m on 24 October. Likes this course and can get involved with the finish
- **11. GARCILASO -** Battling to regain form and was 9th at Cazaubon-Barbotan over 1900m on 29 September. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **12. LADY PINK -** Showed some improvement when 4th in a handicap at Toulouse over 1400m on 10 October. Can play a minor role
- **13. BALEGRIO -** Unreliable but was 3rd in a claimer at Royan La Palmyre over 1600m on 20 September. Victorious in July and can be a threat to these rivals
- **14. PAGANY -** Very consistent and was 3rd in a handicap at Toulouse over 1400m on 10 October. Big chance in this line-up

Summary: PAGANY (14) is improving and produced a good third at Toulouse earlier this month. She should strip fitter this time and can win a race of this nature. SUPER CUTE (8) has been disappointing of late but would not be a surprise winner over this track and trip. ODIN (9) is best judged on some solid runs earlier this year and must be respected for that. BONDINI (1) is not the most reliable but is another who could contest the finish.

C8 - PRIX DU PIC D'OSSAU - 1600m (a1m) - ALL WEATHER - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 16,300

- **1. NUIT D'ALIENOR -** Only modest of late and was 8th in a handicap at Toulouse over 1600m on 24 September. Better at this course and can upset
- **2. GOLDENSIM -** Disappointing last run when 10th in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1900m on 14 October. Capable of better but others are preferred
- **3. DANCE AHEAD -** Disappointing last run when 11th in a handicap at Toulouse over 1400m on 10 October. Consistent before that and can contest the finish
- **4. SIGMUND -** Finished 15th in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1600m on 8 September. Capable of better but others make more appeal
- **5. WATHAB -** Has some fair form and was 5th in a handicap at Toulouse over 1600m on 24 September. Capable of making the frame
- **6. VALINA -** Ureliable but was runner- up in a Conditions race at Auch over 2000m on 5 October. Should be a threat in this line-up
- **7. AZUR AS WELL -** Unreliable and finished 9th in a handicap at Toulouse over 1400m on 10 October. Capable of better and is not out of it
- **8. LOUIS SKI -** Did not show his best whe 12th in a handicap at Lyon-La Soie over 1800m on 3 October. Victorious in September but others make more appeal
- **9. OLAF THE BIG ONE -** Unreliable but was runner up in a Conditions race at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 8 October. Can go one better
- **10. DADAS BOY -** Dif not show his best when unplaced in a handicap at Agen-Le Passage over 1200m on 23 February. Does better at this track and has a place chance
- **11. GOLDEN CITY -** Has struggled of late and was 11th in a handicap at Toulouse over 1600m on 24 September. On a long losing streak and is best watched for now
- **12. POLIVATE -** Disappointing last run 13th in a handicap at Toulouse over 1400m on 10 October. In good form before that and is not out of it
- **13. MADIGAN** Unreliable and was 4th in a claimer at Pompador over 1200m on 7 September. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **14. XARUN -** Finished 7th in a handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 21 September. Victorious on two occasions this year but others are preferred this time

Summary: A very competitive lucky last race. OLAF THE BIG ONE (9) ran well at Marseille-Vivaux earlier this month and does like this surface, so could go one better. DANCE AHEAD (3) has performed well at this track in the past, so it might be worth ignoring a modest last performance. POLIVATE (12) had been threatening to win but produced a disappointing effort last time out. WATHAB (5) is consistent and should be a lively danger.
