Lady Loulou Infinitive Addosh

LADY LOULOU went close to getting off the mark when beaten a neck at Chelmsford earlier this month and the application of blinkers, combined with a step up in trip, could be in her favour. Infinitive is a well-bred filly who commands respect on her first start for David O'Meara following a runner-up effort over C&D in December. Addosh and Ready To Shine appeal most of the remainder.
