

**RACE BY RACE PREVIEWS: FAIRVIEW@2023.05.26**

**Fairview, 26.05.2023, Race 1, Gallops, 1200m, Turf, R65.000, 11:40GMT+2**

**Race Summary:** QUESTOR has not done much wrong in two defeats. He looks hard to oppose and I am sure jockey S'manga Khumalo would like to show us he can get the job done on him. ARTURO makes his debut representing a strong jockey-trainer combination. FUTURE AFRICA makes his debut and the betting should tell his story. SWISS WALT showed improvement after being gelded and is likely to improve further and can contest the finish. WINNING GRACE should come on from the debut effort.

**Race Summary:** Trainer Justin Snaith has brought a number of runners down for this meeting and RENOWNED could start things off nicely for him. He showed improvement off his debut and this is not a strong field so would not be a surprise winner. EMPIRE BLUE is probably looking for further but could run into some minor money. MANCHESTER FIGHTER has made the trip from the Western Cape so there could be improvement coming from him. PUBLIC BENEFIT has improved with each run and should be right there at the finish once again. SMART MASTER makes his debut and could be anything. THE CHARIOTEER can improve off a fair debut as well.

**Race Summary:** SAVIC may have met some fair horses of late and could be ready to win. AMAZING COLOURS has run well in all three starts so far and is sure to be right there once again. FIRE CHASER was not disgraced when fifth on debut and probably has more to offer so could be a danger. STAGE PLAY was only run out of it late on the Polytrack last week and could contest the finish. Stable companion EXCLUSIVELY YOURS also showed improvement last time and could earn some more money.

**Race Summary:** MOHANDAS is clearly better than his local debut. He dropped away at the finish on the Polytrack and is likely to bounce back. WOODLAND RIDGE has been in good form without winning and should fight out the finish. If current reserve runner MARI MARIE gets a run she might blow them out of the water as she was most unlucky on the Polytrack last week having been caught too far out of her ground on a day when front-runners rule the day. WESTERN JACK showed improvement after gelding and could do better this time. MISS TUCKER is better than her last run would suggest.

**Race Summary:** An interesting race. KHAYA'S HOPE was expected by most to be seen a few weeks earlier in a couple of features but appears in this. Hopefully all is well with him, and he could prove best of these if at his best. MOUNT ANDERSON and INHERIT THE RAIN have been in good form of late and could finish in the money. BUSH TRACKER was very impressive in his last two wins and is clearly a danger. SILVER FALCON is out at the weights but won well last time out and is sure to be a lively runner

for this.

**Race Summary:** An open-looking race. Trainer Candice Bass-Robinson sends out VENUS DE MILO and she looks a big runner. The Fairview track could still be soft for this meeting and this filly has recently run her best recent race on a soft track. She is, however, badly drawn and there are many dangers. SILVERY BLUE is in good form and deserves a winning turn. GET IT DONE showed improvement last time out and can go one better. SALIENT POINT won on local debut and could have more in the tank. ANGELSEA looked an unlucky loser last time out and could do better back on turf.

**Race Summary:** Western Cape-based trainers can dominate this race. HUNTING TRIP represents Snaith racing is on the up and has won both of her recent runs under jockey JP van der Merwe. She beat BODY ELECTRIC comfortably last time out and is better off at the weights this time so can follow up. PHEDRA has not been as good recently as she had been earlier this season but is speedy and will try to keep the locals hopes alive. WINTER FURI disappointed last time but will finish closer this time around.

**Race Summary:** FOREST SPY has let his supporters down, but his recent disappointing Polytrack runs has meant his merit rating has dropped and he could prove to be of some value in this line-up. It is a competitive race and not too many can be ruled out of winning the race. SPYDAS CORNER makes his local debut. He did well in KwaZulu-Natal and deserves respect. RIMAAH returns to the turf and could surprise. LEDELL'S ECHO is speedy and could make all the running. ANGEL DEB'S ran well above her rating last time out so has more in the tank.

CAITLYNS BOY has been impressive on the Polytrack since joining trainer Alan Greeff but can he do it on the turf? MADAME VICKI went too quickly for her own good last time out and could do better this time. SON OF ZEUS is unreliable but did win well last time out,
