### Busan Race 3: Class 6 (1300M) Special Weight A / KRW 40 Million

More three-year-old maidens and a few look ready to win. (3) HWANGWU JANGSA won two trials and then ran 3<sup>rd</sup> on debut over 1200M on April 9<sup>th</sup>. He overcame gate ten that day to reach a handy position and with the benefit of experience and a better draw, he can go close here. (8) ZETTA DREAM has a 2<sup>nd</sup> and a 4<sup>th</sup> from two starts so far, the latter at this distance. He can be on pace here and has solid chances. (11) THE PURE MAN beat Zetta Dream when 3<sup>rd</sup> over this distance on April 28<sup>th</sup>. That followed a 2<sup>nd</sup> on debut at 1200M. He drew the same gate last time out and proved himself able to settle back and run on and he can be a danger late on here. There are two debut-makers and (1) THUNDER GONGJU will have plenty of backers. She went through two trials, failing to qualify in the first of them behind Hwangwu Jangsa but was much better in the second when on pace and running 2<sup>nd</sup> in a quick time. She draws well here and can put in a bold first-up run. (4) THE BEST EVER debuted inauspiciously last year but looked much better when trialling up two weeks ago and is another to consider.

#### Busan Race 4: Class 6 (1400M) Special Weight A / KRW 25 Million

Tricky maiden with the form unconvincing for most. (9) SUCCESS BATTLE was a significant improver at start number three over 1200M on April 23<sup>rd</sup> when 3<sup>rd</sup> over 1200M, settling midfield and running on. Like most of the field he steps up to 1400M for the first time and it can suit. (6) JORDAN FIGHTING has been solid if unspectacular across four outings so far. In this company he should be on pace and solid if unspectacular may be enough to see him go very close. (2) KICK'N RUSH has a 2<sup>nd</sup> and a (dead-heat) 3<sup>rd</sup> to her name, both over 1300M. A previous attempt at 1400M didn't go especially well but she is nicely drawn here and should be ready for another go. (7) SUPER KANEL and (8) ECTON BATTLE among others in the placing frame.

### Busan Race 5: Class 5 (1400M) Handicap / KRW 40 Million

Competitive race. (8) SPECIAL WIND is the probable favourite despite still being a maiden after twelve attempts. He has no fewer than nine top-five finishes including last time out on April 28<sup>th</sup>

when he overcame gate eleven to run 2<sup>nd</sup> over 1300M with a couple of today's rivals behind him. He also has a 3<sup>rd</sup> place at this distance and today could be his day. If he does find one too quick again then it's most likely to be (11) GEUMA UNO. He ran 3<sup>rd</sup> in that April 28<sup>th</sup> race, a length and a half behind Special Wind. That was his second consecutive 3<sup>rd</sup> place finish, both times from the same gate as today and third-up this preparation, he may be peaking fitness wise. (2) DYNAMIC WINNER comes up in class and slightly in trip following a maiden win at start number four when she made all over 1300M. She comes down in the weights, draws well, and can measure up in this company. (3) POWER GUY, impressive n a trial earlier this month, and (6) MONEY BAG, are others in the hunt.

# Busan Race 6: Class 5 (1600M) Handicap / KRW 40 Million

(7) BLACK VOLT got his maiden win two starts back over 1200M before running 2<sup>nd</sup> at 1300M on his first try at this class on April 21<sup>st</sup>. He comes up to the mile for the first time, but his running style suggests it can suit and he is the one to beat here. (9) DAHAMKKEDALLIJA comes up in class having secured his maiden win at the third time of asking back in February, making all over 1300M. He's had sixteen weeks off since so comes in fresh and while a mile may be a hard ask first-up, he looks to have plenty of ability and should be competitive. (2) HEARTBREAKER is another up in class following a maiden win. In his case, it came over today's distance and while the time wasn't quick, he comes down in weight and draws well and can measure up. (10) NAKDONG JEONSA and (11) CUQUENAN among others in the frame.

### Busan Race 7: Class 4 (1400M) Handicap / KRW 75 Million

Fillies only here. (9) ATLAS comes in having run 5<sup>th</sup> of twelve in the first leg of the Triple Tiara, the Luna Stakes, over a mile n April 23<sup>rd</sup>. She is skipping next week's Korean Oaks and comes back into a class and a distance at which she won in January. She'll be close to the pace here and can win. (6) AREUMDAUN INYEON enters seeking a third consecutive win having scored in her latest two most recently at class and distance on April 14<sup>th</sup> when going right back before running on. She does come up a full 5kg from those wins, but she is tactically versatile, has good speed, and she has every chance here. (4) WONDERFUL APPEAL is also seeking a hat-trick. She comes up rapidly in class having won her latest two, both at 1300M. She draws nicely and she should be competitive

at this level. (2) UNJU MACH beat three of these on her way to 2<sup>nd</sup> place last time out and comes into a better gate today. She, along with (3) B. K. NEW MOON are the other main contenders for the places.

## Busan Race 8: Class 4 (1800M) Special Weight B / KRW 60 Million

(5) K GOLD BAR is up rapidly in class having own his latest two over 1400M and 1300M racing on pace both times. He also steps up to two turns for the first time but there is no reason why it can't suit and while today's set weights don't' do him any favours, he can make it three in a row. The main danger is (11) WONDERFUL CHANCE. He beat K Gold Bar when they raced over a mile at class 6 level, and he too tackles this grade of racing for the first time. He was a good winner over this distance on April 16<sup>th</sup> when he had to contend with a similarly wide draw, and he has every chance of backing up here. (10) DOCTOR PERSIA ran well for a close 2<sup>nd</sup> over 1400M three weeks ago. He has fared well over this trip too and should be close. (1) GEUMA INFINITE and (6) ADELE BOSS, the latter a class and distance winner who can have his latest from a wide draw forgiven, are others to keep safe.
