# C1 - PRIX DE SOISSONS - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Maiden Race - Flat - EUR € 18,000

- **1. LORD ASRIEL D ALME -** Showed minor improvement when 4h of twelve in a 9f maiden at Nort sur Erdre on 20 April over 1800m. More progress needed here
- **2. ADLAN SENORA -** Unplaced in both starts to date including at Compiègne over 2000m on 25 April last time out. Hard to make a case for
- **3. RECLAIM -** Finished really well when 4th of nine in a 1400m maiden at Compiègne on 25 April. A repeat of this effort shall see him break his maiden tag
- **4. KINEMATICA -** Ex-UK trained filly who enjoyed a couple of decent runs in France on the all-weather earlier this year. Unplaced last time in a Class 4 at Longchamp over 2000m but this looks an easier task
- **5. ASAMA -** Posted a good debut run in March 2024 at Lignières but was unplaced on her seasonal bow at Compiègne over 2000m on 25 April. Hard to fancy
- **6. KAMAKURA ONE -** Unplaced over hurdles at La Teste on 16 May when last seen in action. Had run well on the flat earlier in her career and cannot be ruled out
- **7. TRINITY -** Finished 7th in a Claimer at Longchamp on 24 April over 2000m in only run this season. Has too much to find and can be overlooked
- **8. SUNLIKE -** Twenty-two starts maiden who finished down the field on 4 May in a 1400m Longchamp handicap last time. Others are much preferred
- **9. ALCALA -** Finished 5th of eight in a maiden over 1800m on the all-weather at Lyon la Soie on 23 March. Can get involved at the finish
- **10. ZAUBA** Finished 6th of twelve on 2 August last year at Clairefontaine in a 2400m maiden when last seen in action. Off since then and first run for new connections
- **11. MATCHASSA -** Well beaten 4th of seven in a Class 4 at Orléans over 2200m last time out on 11 May. Must show vast improvement to feature
- **12. FIFTH ELEMENT -** Newcomer by Sea The Stars who is a half-sister to three winners in France and UK. Dam won two races in UK. Should be ready

**Summary:** ECLAIM (3) has been edging closer to a breakthrough, and his latest finishing effort at Compiègne was full of promise. He looks well-placed to shed his maiden tag and can get off the mark at the expense of KINEMATICA (4) who posted a pair of good efforts earlier this season on the all-weather and should not be bothered by the switch to the turf surface. ZAUBA (10) will be interesting to follow on return from a layoff in her first run for new connections. KAMAKURA ONE (6) switches back to the flat and could spring a surprise.

### C2 - PRIX MICHELINE LEURSON - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Class 4 Claiming Handicap - Flat - EUR € 10,500

- **1. COUR DU ROI -** Finished 6th in a Handicap at Saint-Cloud on 9 May over 1200m. Up in trip but down in grade and should have a big say
- **2. SAMAPY -** Good recent form and was 3rd in a mile Handicap at Saint-Cloud on 9 May. Has every chance on the back of this effort
- **3. SIM CARD -** Very consistent in the claiming division and was 3rd in a similar contest on the all-weather over 1900m at Deauville on 3 January. Off since then but hard to beat if fit
- **4. DORIANELLO -** Finished 4th in a 1400m Claimer on all-weather at Chantilly on 16 May. Up in trip here but a player all the same
- **5. HERNAN CORTES -** Unplaced in a mile Handicap at Nantes on 5 May. On a long losing run and is hard to make a case for
- **6. ALYAQUT -** Down the field in a Handicap at Saint-Cloud over 1400m on 13 May. Slight drop in class and blinkers again. Outside chance
- **7. GOLDEN BEACH -** Registered a sixth career victory in a claimer at Morlaix on 11 May over 1800m. Tougher task assigned today but can stake a claim
- **8. SWEEP AWAY -** Unplaced in a 1800m claimer at Fontainebleau on 12 April. Modest recent form and has work to do here
- **9. BONNIE ELIZABETH -** Finished mid-division in a Handicap at Strasbourg over 2000m on 8 May. Takes a drop in class and is not out of it
- **10. NORSK -** Bounced back to form with a close 3rd place in a Class 4 at Chateaubriant over 1950m on 12 May. In similar form will have his chances
- **11. LALA LIGHT -** Not disgraced when 5th of nine in a Longchamp Handicap over 1800m on 7 May. Easier task assigned here and can get involved
- **12. INCLINATION -** Last of ten in a Class 4 over 2000m at Longchamp on 7 May. Has long been struggling with form and is hard to make a case for

**Summary:** SIM CARD (3) is a consistent performer in claiming company and, despite a layoff since January, holds strong credentials in this modest field. If fit, he could prove the one to beat. SAMAPY (2) arrives in good form following a solid effort at Saint-Cloud and looks a key danger with conditions likely to suit. COUR DU ROI (1) was a winner in his last run in a claimer and warrants consideration. ALYAQUT (6) disappointed last time but has enough ability to bounce back and play a role if recapturing earlier form.

# C3 - PRIX YVES SAINT-MARTIN - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Maiden Race - Flat - EUR € 11,000

- **1. THINTHREAD -** Returns after a small break when finishing 4th in a Maiden over 1600m at Chantilly on the 20th of December 2024. If fit, could produce a winning comeback effort
- **2. SEA THE MAN -** Encouraging debut performance when finishing 2nd in a Maiden over 1600m at Nantes on the 9th of April 2025. Big run expected and possibly holds a winning chance
- **3. FERDINAND PREMIER -** Finished 6th on debut in a Maiden over 2000m at Chantilly on the 2nd of May 2025. Will look to improve and does have a place chance
- **4. HAYA LAND -** Finished 4th in a Maiden over 1700m at Saint-Brieuc on the 27th of October 2024. Returns after a 7 month break and might need the run back
- **5. MON BLACK DU LIVET -** Supplemented Mon Black Du Livet finished 9th in a Maiden over 2400m at Lion D'angers on the 6th of May 2025. Difficult to make a case for
- **6. COME ALONE -** Much improved last run finishing 5th in a Maiden over 1600m at Vichy on the 14th of May 2025. A similar effort could see him improving, one to throw into larger exotic perms
- **7. THE BIG TICKET -** Finished 9th in a Maiden over 1600m at Le Mans on the 3rd of May 2025. One to respectfully pass by
- **8. LE SID -** Finished 6th in a maiden over 1600m at Chantilly on the 16th of May 2025. Could pop up at the backend of quartets
- **9. SYRUS** Finished 6th in a Maiden over 2000m at Lion D'Angers on the 6th of May 2025. Hard to recommend with confidence
- **10. NABA QUEEN -** Went missing in her debut effort over 2000m in a Maiden at Lion D'Angers on the 6th of May 2025. Others weigh more attraction
- **11. GIANETTA -** Finished 9th on debut in a Maiden over 2300m at Le Mans on the 3rd of May 2025. Others make more appeal
- **12. BORNAWAY -** Pleasing 5th in a Maiden over 2400m at Lyon La Soie on the 30th of March 2025. Drops back in trip which she will enjoy contesting in
- **13. CIEL DE PARIS -** Supplemented and is out of the 2 time winning mare Princess Bianca while the sire, Persian King was a multiple Group winning horse. Will need the experience
- **14. LELIO -** Supplemented and is out of the unraced mare Baba Yaga while the sire, Galiway was a Listed winner and featured in Group contests. Will need the first time outing

**Summary:** THINTHREAD (1) returns after a five month break and tries the distance for the first time which could be the perfect trip for him and if strips fit, could make a bright winning appearance. BORNAWAY (12) was not disgraced when finishing fifth last time out but could have been a tad far for her. Bringing her back to the 1800m could be the ideal maiden breaking formula. SEA THE MAN (2) produced an eye-catching debut run when finishing second and will be of no surprise if he makes a winning stance. FERDINAND PREMIER (3) wraps up the top four mix.

# C4 - PRIX FREDDY HEAD - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Claiming - Flat - EUR € 13,000

- **1. GUNS AND ROSES -** A smart winner in a Claimer over 1100m at Le Mans on the 3rd of May 2025. A repeat of that run could see him following up here
- **2. NAZGUL BLOU** Is out of the 1 time winning mare Fifth Element while the sire, Toronado was a multiple Group winner. Might need the debut experience here
- **3. ANADONIYA -** Finished 5th on debut in a Claimer over 1200m at Lyon Parilly on the 8th of May 2025. Could be a lurker in the play to disrupt the 4th position spot
- **4. NEAR FLY -** Finished 6th on debut in a Class 3 Conditional over 1200m at Lion D'Angers on the 6th of May 2025. One for the backend of quartet plays
- **5. ACHILEA CHOPE -** Finished 5th over the 1200m trip in a similar Claimer contest at Saint-Cloud on the 13th of May 2025. One to throw into larger quartet plays as improvement was made when she went over 1200m
- **6. MADAME LY -** Pleasing effort when finishing 2nd in a Claimer over 1200m at Lyon Parilly on the 8th of May 2025. Knocking on the door and it can open here
- **7. ALGINE CHOPE -** Finished 7th in a Class 3 Conditional over 1200m at Lion D'Angers on the 6th of May 2025. Hard to fancy
- **8. WOODWOODED -** Finished 4th in a Claimer over 1200m at Saint-Cloud on the 13th of May 2025. Will look to improve and finish closer in this lineup
- **9. DELIRE D'AMOUR -** Good effort finishing 3rd in a Claimer over 1200m at Lyon Parilly on the 8th of May 2025. One for all exotic plays
- **10. ASENSEOFSERENITY -** Respectable effort finishing 2nd in a Claimer over 1100m at Le Mans on the 3rd of May 2025. Deserving of a bold eachway shout
- **11. CAPOUCHINE -** Finished 6th on debut in a Claimer over 1100m at Le Mans on the 3rd of May 2025. Others are much preferred

**Summary:** GUNS AND ROSES (1) and ASENSEOFSERENITY (10) are no strangers to each other when meeting in their last start but GUNS AND ROSES (1) was the victor and has all the equipment in his favor to follow up on his win. ASENSEOFSERENITY is 2,5kgs better off at the weight against the top selector which proudly makes her a huge threat and could see her making amends for her second place finish. MADAME LY (3) is not out of it producing a sparkling second over the distance and deserves major consideration. DELIRE D;AMOUR (9) has a top four chance.

# C5 - PRIX EVREUX PORTES DE NORMANDIE - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Claiming - Flat - EUR € 14,000

- **1. LA PAMPA -** Unplaced in a Handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 15 May. A penultimate start winner who debuts at this level and can be competitive
- **2. FOUR FOUR -** A winner in a Claimer at Lyon-Parilly over 1350m on 8 May. Should make a bold bid to follow up at this level. Good chance
- **3. ALEKSINE -** Unplaced in a Handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1600m on 4 May. A runner-up in the only Claiming attempt and is not out of it
- **4. REUX -** Fourth in a Claimer at Lyon-Parilly over 1350m on 8 May. The last three efforts at this level have been competitive and can make the frame
- **5. DESERT ROSE -** Fifth in a Handicap at Chantilly over 1200m on 6 May. Performs well at this level and can be competitive again
- **6. PEONE -** Finished 8th in a Condition race at Moulins over 1000m on 10 May. Unlikely to be involved in the finish
- **7. CHANT DU LOUP -** Finished 7th in a Condition race at Le Croise-Laroche over 1100m on 18 May. Needs to improve to feature
- **8. MAMINOA -** Fifth in a Condition race at Moulins over 1000m on 10 May. Will be fitter but needs to find a few lengths to win
- **9. ANDANTINI -** Well beaten 9th in a Claimer at Fontainebleau over 1200m on 21 April. Others make more appeal in this line-up

**Summary:** FOUR FOUR (2) made a winning introduction to the claiming category and needn't improve much to go in again. DESERT ROSE (5), returning to the category of her last success, and class-dropper ALEKSINE (3) seem most likely to trouble the selection. LA PAMPA (1) is also competitive for the places in her first appearance at this level.

### C6 - PRIX BERNARD DE SAINT-SEINE - 2500m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Maiden Race - Flat - EUR € 11,000

- **1. GOT MAN -** Finished 7th in a Condition race at Saint-Cloud over 2000m on 15 November. Unlikely to be involved in the finish
- **2. BATURHAN -** Fifth in a Condition race at Angers over 2300m on 26 April. Others are much preferred in this line-up
- **3. ANZOR -** Finished 8th in a Handicap at Saint-Cloud over 2400m on 4 April. Has performed well in higher grades since the debut and deserves some attention
- **4. BRASILIA -** Third in a Condition race at Angers over 2300m on 26 April. Improved the latest effort and can confirm that
- **5. SHAMASSA -** Third on debut in a Condition race at Le-Mans over 2300m on 3 May. Can get closer with the experience under the belt
- **6. DIAMOND LINE -** Finished 10th in a Condition race at Saint-Cloud over 2400m on 23 April. Probably best watched for now
- **7. BONJOUR MON AMOUR -** Finished 7th on debut in a Condition race at Le-Mans over 2300m on 3 May. Can get closer and has place prospects
- **8. THROUGH THE FLAMES -** Fifth in a Condition race at Lyon-Parilly over 2400m on 16 April. Should make a bold bid for victory. Good chance
- **9. QUEST FOR MAGIC -** Fifth in a Condition race at Le Lion-d'Angers over 2400m on 6 May. Two fair efforts to date, and is not out of it
- **10. POLITICIENNE -** Finished 8th on debut in a Condition race at Le-Mans over 2300m on 3 May. Others make more appeal in this line-up
- **11. ROBOT ROCK -** A 3-year-old gelding by Toronado out of Daidahana who makes his debut. Watch the betting as a guide to the chances

**Summary:** THROUGH THE FLAMES (8) ought to open her account sooner rather than later and gthis represents a good opportunity to break her duck. SHAMASSA (5), who made an encouraging debut at Le Mans, will likely give the selection most to fear. ANZOR (3) and QUEST FOR MAGIC (9) are genuine podium contenders and appeal most of the remaidner.

### C7 - PRIX THIERRY JARNET - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 14,000

- **1. ENNEDI -** Well beaten 10th in a Handicap at Le Croise-Laroche over 1100m on 18 May. Improvement is needed to feature
- **2. HIGHFIELD MYSTERY -** Finished 7th in a Handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 4 May. Holding form and can be competitive
- **3. INITIALS BEBE -** Unplaced in a Claimer at Chantilly over 1100m on 28 April. Returning from a short break, and can surprise
- **4. AMOUREUSE -** Well beaten 8th in a Condition race at Angers over 1350m on 26 April. Others are much preferred in this line-up
- **5. MOWAEVA** Fourth in a Handicap at Le Croise-Laroche over 1100m on 18 May. Impressed in the latest and warrants attention
- **6. TALLINSKI -** Fifth in a Handicap at Le Croise-Laroche over 1100m on 18 May. A runner-up in the only attempt on this track and can make the frame
- **7. JUMANO -** Finished 6th in a Handicap at Le Croise-Laroche over 1100m on 18 May. Not far behind MOWAEVA (5) and TALLINSKI (6) recently, and can make the frame
- **8. ACHKI -** A runner-up in a Handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 4 May. Seldom far off them and must be respected. Good chance
- **9. MOONWALKER -** Unplaced in a Handicap at Le Croise-Laroche over 1100m on 18 May. Unlikely to be involved in the finish
- **10. OPPORTUN -** Unplaced in a Handicap at Le Croise-Laroche over 1100m on 18 May. Poor form and others are preferred
- **11. RAVEN'S SPIRIT -** Well beaten 8th in a Handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 4 May. Unlikely to be involved in the finish
- **12. KANDERAS -** Finished 7th in a Handicap at Le Croise-Laroche over 1100m on 18 May. Others make more appeal in this line-up
- **13. SHAMASUN -** Finished 9th in a Handicap at Le Croise-Laroche over 1100m on 18 May. If in the mood, can have place prospects
- **14. MEHANYDREAM -** Well beaten 9th in a Handicap at Chantilly over 1400m on 10 April. Probably best watched for now, and needs to improve

**Summary:** Recent runner-up in a ParisLongchamp handicap ACHKI (8) seems close to his race and is good value to go one better. He sets the standard on recent form and a repeat of his last performance should suffice. MOWAEVA (5) fits a similar profile and is exocted to fight for victory. HIGHFIELD MYSTERY (2), the in-form TALLINSKI (6) and JUMANO (7) complete the shortlist.

### C8 - PRIX ALAIN DE ROYER DUPRE - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 16,000

- **1. KELLY KEY -** Third in a Handicap at Saint-Cloud over 1400m on 13 May. A proven sort who has every chance again and must be respected
- **2. THE CAT'S -** Unplaced in a Handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 15 May. Has good place prospects in this line-up
- **3. ITAEWON -** Unplaced in a Claimer at Chantilly over 1400m on 16 May. Others are much preferred in this line-up
- **4. GIORGIANA -** A runner-up in a Handicap at Saint-Cloud over 1200m on 9 May. In good form and should make a bold bid for victory. Good chance
- **5. BOMBEY -** Finished 10th in a Handicap at Le Croise-Laroche over 1100m on 18 May. Has excuses for the latest and can bounce back
- **6. COOLMEEN ROYAL -** A winner in a Handicap at Le Croise-Laroche over 1100m on 18 May. Has the confidence and can be involved in the finish again
- **7. SIXTUS -** Finished 8th in a Claimer at Chantilly over 1400m on 16 May. Equipped with a full set of blinkers, and can play a role in the finish
- **8. CHUNKA WAKAN -** Unplaced in a Handicap at Deauville over 1300m on 27 November. Might need the run back and needs to improve
- **9. BIENNE -** Finished 9th in a Handicap at Saint-Cloud over 1200m on 9 May. Can surprise on its best form and make the frame
- **10. MILL LANE -** Finished 7th in a Handicap at Mons over 1500m on 23 January. Others are much preferred in this line-up
- **11. ANDARTIS -** Finished 9th in a Handicap at Le Croise-Laroche over 1100m on 18 May. Others make more appeal in this line-up
- **12. PROXIMA CENTAURI -** Finished 10th in a Handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 15 May. Probably best watched for now, and needs to improve
- **13. BIG BOOTS -** Fifth in a Handicap at Wissembourg over 1350m on 18 May. Unplaced this year and is best watched for now
- **14. INTUITION** Well beaten 9th in a Handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 15 May. Unlikely to be involved in the finish

**Summary:** A recent 2nd at Saint-Cloud in this grade, GIORGIANA (4) need only produce a similar performance to fight for victory. KELLY KEY (1) returned to form at that venue last time and would every chance here with a repeat of that display. Last-start scorer COOLMEEN ROYAL (6) and class-dropper THE CAT'S (2) aren't incapable of getting into the picture either.
