**C1 - PERSONNEL DE HARAS - PRIX DE PONDRON - 1400m (a7f) - TURF -
Claiming - Flat - EUR € 23,000**

1. THE BOY CAN PLAY - Colt by Goken, the dam was placed a few times in France. Respected trainer and worth a market check for clues

2. DICIAMO - Good 2nd on the sole start in a claimer over 1400m at La Teste on July 15. Live contender with improvement expected

3. GOLDEN RUN - Two placed efforts, 2nd on the latest at Vittel in a maiden race over 1600m on July 19. Hard to rule out

4. MORNING DEW - In good form and finished 3rd in a Maiden at Aix Les Bains over 1,200m on 7 July 2026. One to pay attention to

5. GOOD BOY - Ran well to be 2nd at Nantes in a claimer over 1400m on July 1, he won a claimer on May 15 over 1200m. Key chance

6. MR SAY - Recent success over 1400m at Dieppe in a claimer on July 18. He has plenty of experience and can be on the premises

7. PINK PALACE - Well held last time over 1400m at Vichy in a maiden on July 20 when back in 13th place, can make the frame

8. ON THE ROCK BLOU - Colt by Romanised, the dam won 1 race over 2350m. Likely to improve for this run and is best watched with the future in mind

9. ARIA FRESCA - Finished 9th in a Maiden at Compiègne over 1,400m on 10 July 2026 when last appearing. Others look more likely to score

10. SHALOM - Two unplaced runs, well held in 11th over 1400m at this track on July 10 in a maiden race. Has work to do to be involved

Summary: GOOD BOY (5) has performed well in claiming company and looks like the safest option ahead of, MR SAY (6), who enjoys a useful weight advantage, and has strong claims of going close after success at Dieppe recently. Supplemented for the race, PINK PALACE (7) is an interesting runner on her first appearance in a claimer and should be competitive. DICIAMO (2) made a pleasing impression on debut and has the potential to improve.

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C2 - LEADERSHIP & MANAGEMENT - PRIX DE DRESLINCOURT - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - Class 2 - Flat - EUR € 25,600

1. IKOTOFETSY - Five unplaced runs this year, 8th on the latter over 1400m at this track in a Class 2 race on July 10. One to overlook

2. MISTER CHARMES - Finished 6th in a Class 2 at Chantilly over 1,600m on 24 June 2026. 3rd before that over 1600m in a Class 1 at Angers on June 8. Unlikely to trouble some of these

3. SOUL AMBASSADOR - Fourth in a Class 2 at Compiègne over 1,400m on 10 July 2026 and a win before that in late June at Deauville on the PSF over 1500m. Hard to ignore

4. VANVITELLI - Finished 7th in a Class 2 at this track last time on July 10 over 1400m, a win before that in a maiden over 1400m at this track in late April. Hard to recommend

5. MIA LOT - Nice win over 1600m in a Class 3 race at Parislongchamp on June 4 when last seen. More needed in what looks a stronger race

6. DEMAH - Finished last of 8 in the Prix De Sanringham (Gr.2) at Chantilly on May 31 over 1600m last time, a win previously on debut on April 22 on turf at Chantilly over 1600m. Player

7. SINDALAH - Finished 4th in a Class 2 at Chantilly over 1,600m on 24 June 2026. She won on her sole start on debut in October 22 over 1600m. Can be on the premises

8. CAUDRY - Finished 6th at Deauville in a handicap over 1900m on the PSF on June 26 last time out. Others seem better equipped

9. NO TURNING BACK - Runner-up in a Class 2 at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1,600m on 15 June 2026, which came after a win on debut in May over 1800m. Merits consideration

Summary: DEMAH (6), was not up to Group 2 class last time, but a win before that on debut was encouraging and she can be too smart for SOUL AMBASSADOR (3), who steps up in distance and was a creditable fourth in a strong Class 2 race when last seen at this track in June. SINDALAH (7) ran a creditable race when fourth at Chantilly in late June in a Class 2 race, and will find this company more to her liking. NO TURNING BACK (9) completes the shortlist.

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C3 - PERSONNEL DE SOIN BY RED MILLS - PRIX DE VILLERS COTTERETS - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - Flat - EUR € 20,100

- 1. DENNIS THE MENACE** - Showed promise and was third in a Maiden at Clairefontaine over 1,600m on 6 July 2026, and 2nd in a Class 3 on June 4th previously at Parislongchamp. Player
- 2. LEKER** - Runner-up in a Maiden at Lyon-Parilly over 1,600m on 22 June 2026. Can improve further and is one to keep onside
- 3. LANDREVIE** - Finished 7th on the one run over 1600m at Nantes in a claiming race on June 16. Can be overlooked in a better race
- 4. IRRESITIBLEMENT** - Fifth in a Maiden at Clairefontaine over 1,600m on 6 July 2026, and two placed runs before that. Place chance at best
- 5. SAYVILLE** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Maiden at Dieppe over 1,400m on 13 July 2026 last time . Others make more appeal
- 6. CITY SOLACE** - Fourth in a Maiden at Clairefontaine over 1,600m on 6 July 2026. Capable of making his presence felt and can be a threat
- 7. ZOAR** - Below par run over 1600m at Sluzewiec (POL) in a conditions race on July 5 when last seen, 3rd previously at this track over 1800m in a maiden on June 5. In the mix
- 8. SILENCIO** - Colt by Night Of Thunder, the dam was placed a few times. From a respected trainer that knows the time of day. The betting can be the most informative guide
- 9. VIENNA'S PRIDE** - Gelding by Wooded, the dam won 6 races. Nice profile and from a trainer that can have this newcomer well prepared. Watch the betting for clues

Summary: DENNIS THE MENACE (1) has been knocking on the door with a string of solid performances and looks to have been found an ideal opportunity to break his maiden. CITY SOLACE (6), from the Amy Murphy stable, wears blinkers for the first time, a change that could bring about further improvement and make him the chief threat. Well-bred newcomer SILENCIO (8) has plenty to recommend him on paper and is worth close attention in the betting. ZOAR (7) also enters the reckoning and should not be overlooked.

C4 - PERSONNEL ADMINISTRATIF - PRIX EULALIE - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - - Flat - EUR € 20,100

1. IMDALA - Tad below par on July 6 when back in 7th, 3rd previously on debut at this track over 1600m in a maiden on June 13. Can make her presence felt

2. VICTORIOUS ESCAPE - Good 2nd last time out on her second run over 1800m in a maiden race at this track on June 20. Live contender

3. KAPLYA - Two unplaced runs, the latter over 1400m at Dieppe in a maiden on July 13 when beating only two rivals. One to be overlooked

4. VICTORY PACE - Finished 5th on July 6 in a maiden at Clairefontaine last time, and a 2nd before that over 1600m at this track on June 13. Plenty of experience and she should not be excluded

5. ROMAN ROYAL - Showed some improvement when fourth in a Maiden at Clairefontaine over 1,600m on 6 July 2026. Ought to be in the shake-up

6. ILI PIKA - Nice debut to be 5th at Chantilly in a conditions race on the PSF on March 16 over 1600m. Smart pedigree and can improve from her first run and play a lead role

7. TABATA - Finished 6th at Lyon Parilly in a maiden over 1600m on her sole start on May 8. Maxime Guyon booked to ride and she warrants respect

8. QUELLIS - Finished 9th in a Maiden at Clairefontaine over 1,600m on 6 July 2026. Vast progress needed to make the frame

9. MLLE FLEURANT - Finished 8th on her second start over 1600m at Clairefontaine in a maiden race on July 6. Look for an alternative

10. BUENAVENTURA - Creditable 5th at Dieppe over 1400m in a maiden race on July 13 on her second start, after a 3rd on debut at this track in May. Others make more appeal

Summary: VICTORIOUS ESCAPE (2) sets the standard after a creditable runner-up finish over 1800 metres at this track on June 20 and looks the one to beat. IMDALA (1) is better than her latest performance suggests and is worth another chance based on her encouraging debut third. She rates as the main danger. TABATA (7) displayed plenty of promise on her first outing and, with Maxime Guyon taking the ride, commands plenty of respect. ROMAN ROYAL (5) is another progressive type who should not be underestimated.

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C5 - JEUNE ESPOIR BY PARIS TURF - PRIX DE LA THIERACHE - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - - Flat - EUR € 18,300

- 1. RUN VICTORIA** - Victorious in a claimer at Chantilly over 1600m on 7 July. tougher task this time but cannot be ruled out
- 2. TOCOA** - Finished 5th in a Maiden at Lyon-Parilly over 1,600m on 22 June. Has some fair form and could be a threat to these rivals
- 3. FORGOTTEN SON** - not disgraced when 6th in a handicap at Compiegne over 1600m on 16 July. Likely to improve and could contest the finish
- 4. ARMSTRONG GLORY** - Returned to form and finished 4th in a handicap at Compiegne over 1600m on 16 July. Capable of making the frame once again
- 5. ROMAN BOY** - Finished 13th in a handicap at Compiegne over 1600m on 16 July. Clearly capable of better and has a place chance
- 6. PRIMA LUCE** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1600m on 2 July. Big chance in this line-up
- 7. MAURICIA** - showed some improvement and was 4th in a handicap at Chantilly over 2000m on 19 July. has a place chance in this line-up
- 8. LAMIYA** - Only modest of late, finishing 9th in a Maiden at Saint-Cloud over 1,400m on 2 June. Capable of improvement and could be a threat
- 9. RADMILLA** - Only modest so far and finished 7th in a Maiden at Compiegne over 1,400m on 20 June. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 10. BLOOM DANCER** - Has only been modest so far and finished 5th in a Maiden at Deauville over 1,500m on 26 June. Could earn some minor money
- 11. MADAME MAGIC** - Did not show her best when 13th in a handicap at Compiegne over 1600m on 16 July. Capable of better and can make the frame
- 12. DELIRE D'AMOUR** - Finished 11th in a Class 1 Handicap at Baden-Baden over 1,600m on 7 June. Has not shown much and others are preferred

Summary: PRIMA LUCE (6) caught the eye with a strong late finish at ParisLongchamp on 2 July, making up significant ground in the closing stages. With that encouraging effort behind her, a first career victory appears to be only a matter of time. FORGOTTEN SON (3) is partnered by Maxime Guyon for the first time, an eye-catching jockey booking. LAMIYA (8) should be well suited by the return to a mile, a distance that promises to bring out further improvement. MADAME MAGIC (11) finished fourth at Lyon-Parilly in late June and is capable of playing a major role in this competitive contest

- 1. BELVEDERE PALACE** - Has really struggled of late and finished 9th in a Claimer at Longchamp over 1,600m on 9 July, Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 2. LALOU** - In good form and finished 3rd in a Claimer at Longchamp over 2,400m on 2 July. Should contest then finish once again
- 3. USER AMISTOSO** - Made short work of rivals in a Claimer at Longchamp over 2,400m on 2 July. Has won twice in last three starts and could score again
- 4. MORO** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class 4 Handicap at Vittel over 2,100m on 6 July. Has some fair and is clearly not out of it at this level
- 5. PERIHELIO** - Finished 9th in a Claimer at Longchamp over 2,100m on 15 June. Off form and others make much appeal
- 6. KERNO QUATZ** - Finished 3rd in a Claimer at Aix Les Bains over 1,800m on 7 July. In good form and can be a threat to these rivals
- 7. EVER FAST** - Finished 11th in a Class 3 Handicap at Longchamp over 1,400m on 9 July. Capable of making the frame at this level
- 8. FLY HALF** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a Class 3 at Longchamp over 2,400m on 14 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 9. POTE** - Unreliable and was 9th at Hamburg--Horn over 2000m on 4 July. Capable of a bit better but others make more appeal
- 10. COMBERMERE** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Claimer at Compiègne over 2,400m on 10 July. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 11. TAKEO** - Finished 6th in a Class 4 Handicap at Nancy over 2,000m on 5 June. Capable of doing better and might play a minor role
- 12. BURATTINA** - Finished 11th in a Class 3 Handicap at Deauville over 1,900m on 12 July. Has won at this course before and must be respected for that
- 13. FORCE TRANQUILLE** - Unplaced in a Class 3 Handicap at Clairefontaine over 2,900m on 3 July. Did win before that and is capable of an upset

Summary: USER AMISTOSO (3) has built an excellent record with Cristian Demuro, posting two victories and two third-place finishes from just four starts. This record makes him a strong and reliable proposition. LALOU (2) is a consistent performer at this level and has developed a productive association with Augustin Madamet., which makes her one of the principal dangers. MORO (4) has never finished outside the first four in three appearances in this grade. EVER FAST (7) drops back into claiming company, a move that could prove decisive. Despite taking on older rivals, he has the ability to make life difficult for the more experienced runners.

Handicap - Flat - EUR € 25,900**

- 1. JONIN** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class 3 Handicap at Compiègne over 1,600m on 9 June. Should be a real threat but does carry a penalty
- 2. E VA BIN** - Finished 12th in a Class 3 Handicap at Clairefontaine over 1,600m on 11 July. Capable of better but others make more appeal
- 3. AMOUAGE** - Finished 8th in a Class 3 Handicap at Deauville over 1,900m on 4 July. Capable of an upset on best form
- 4. MEISHO VELITE** - Made short work of rivals in a Class 3 Handicap at Chantilly over 1,600m on 24 June. Can double up carrying a penalty
- 5. ALCOTAN** - Finished fourth in a Claimer at Chantilly over 2,000m on 7 July. Will need to do more to beat these rivals
- 6. FASTER** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class 3 Handicap at Longchamp over 1,600m on 4 June. Quite capable of making the frame
- 7. ALYAQUT** - Finished 8th in a Class 3 Handicap at Compiègne over 1,400m on 16 July. Off form and others make more appeal
- 8. REMAMA** - Victorious last time out in a Class 3 Handicap at Compiègne over 1,400m on 16 July. Capable of doubling up
- 9. WHATAHERO** - Was only 8th in a Class 3 Handicap at Deauville over 1,400m on 26 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 10. ROYAL SHAKE** - Not disgraced when third in a Class 4 at Compiègne over 1,600m on 16 July. Unreliable but is capable of contesting the finish once again
- 11. HONGUEMARE** - Only modest of late and finished fifth in a Class 3 Handicap at Chantilly over 1,800m on 7 July. Has a place chance on best form
- 12. LES DIGGERS** - Unreliable and was upplaced in a Class 3 Handicap at Dieppe over 1,800m on 18 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 13. MARKSWOMAN** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class 4 Handicap at Vittel over 1,600m on 19 July. Can be competitive once again
- 14. HARTWOOD MAN** - Only modest of late finished 7th in a Class 3 Handicap at Longchamp over 2,000m on 14 July. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
- 15. KING HARTWOOD** - Finished 9th in a Class 3 Handicap at Chantilly over 1,600m on 24 June. Capable of doing better and might play a minor role



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Summary: MEISHO VELITE (4) arrives in excellent form after a recent victory under Laura Grosso, a partnership that has consistently delivered strong results. Proven on this track, she is well placed to follow up despite a rise in the weights. JONIN (1) has also been reassessed by the handicapper but boasts an effective partnership with Mathieu Calbrix. With that proven combination in the saddle, another bold showing looks likely. ROYAL SHAKE (10) made an encouraging start for new connections and has the potential to build on that performance. FASTER (6) may have slightly less room for manoeuvre under his current marks but all possesses the consistency to challenge for the minor placings.

VALLEE DE L'OISE - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - Class 2 Divided Handicap -
Flat - EUR € 50,900**

- 1. AFOGADO** - Finished 6th in a Class 3 at Clairefontaine over 1,400m on 3 July. Not reliable but is quite capable of making the frame
- 2. THOR LIGHTNING** - holding form and finished 4th in a handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 8 May. Tougher task this time but can earn some more money
- 3. BOTICELLI** - Finished 9th in a Class 2 Handicap at Chantilly over 1,900m on 19 May. Needed that run and is capable of bouncing back to score
- 4. REVERSO** - Not disgraced when 5th at ParisLongchamp over 1600m on 14 July. Has won at this course and is not out of it
- 5. ABIAT** - Only moderate of late and finished 7th in a Class 2 Handicap at Longchamp over 1,600m on 4 June. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 6. HARPER** - Threatening to score and was runner-up in a Claimer at Longchamp over 1,600m on 14 July. Can go one place better
- 7. DUBALAA** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class 2 Handicap at Compiègne over 1,600m on 25 May. Has claims in a race of this nature
- 8. DUTY** - Unplaced in a Class 2 Handicap at Saint-Cloud over 1,600m on 5 July. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
- 9. LETTY'S MARVEL** - Unreliable and finished 10th in a Class 3 Handicap at Saint-Cloud over 1,600m on 5 July. Successful before that and cannot be ruled out
- 10. KEANU** - Unplaced in a Class 4 Handicap at Nantes over 1,600m on 1 July. Clearly capable of better and has a place chance on best form
- 11. MON COMEDIEN** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Class 3 at Chantilly over 2,000m on 19 July. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 12. CAHAGNES** - unreliable and finished 8th in a Class 3 Handicap at Chantilly over 1,800m on 7 July. Victorious before that and could earn some money
- 13. SAXON VILLAGE** - Knocking at the door and was runner-up in a Class 3 Handicap at Saint-Cloud over 1,600m on 5 July. Can be very competitive yet again
- 14. GOLDEN BROWN** - Not reliable but was 5th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 9 July. Capable of a surprise when in the right mood
- 15. LEPARD** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Claimer at Aix Les Bains over 1,800m on 7 July. Others make more appeal
- 16. FORCEFULL** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a Class 3 at Chantilly over 1,400m on 19 June. Might play a minor role at very best



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Summary: DUBALAA (7) showed plenty of promise during his early career with Jérôme Reynier. While his new trainer has expressed slight reservations about the trip, he remains hopeful the colt will make a significant impact. HARPER (6) is another horse with solid claims off his current mark. Any ease underfoot would enhance his prospects considerably. BOTICELLI (3) makes another return from a layoff and may improve for the run, but that has not dampened the confidence of his trainer. SAXON VILLAGE (13) produced an excellent performance at Saint-Cloud and has reportedly come out of that race in great order. DUTY (8) should not be underestimated.
