C2 - PRIX DE BILHERES - 1600m (a1m) - ALL WEATHER - Class 2 Race - Flat - EUR € 27,000

- **1. LIXTA -** Talented filly with sound references/form credentials won twice in 3 starts before finishing 5th in a 1600m Listed race at Toulouse on 11 November. WIII be a factor
- **2. RETIRO -** Confirmed the promise of his debut 2nd over 1400m by winning his next start over 1600m at La Teste in early August. Disappointing 4th over 1400m at Dax on 7 September but the return to this trip will suit
- **3. KIRCHNER -** Won a 1600m newcomers' race at Chantilly on 21 September, and that race's form has worked out well. Follow
- **4. BIN ZARAK -** Consistent colt with undeniable means and sound references/form credentials never finished worse than 3rd in 4 starts (won once). Absent since finishing 2nd over 1350m at Lyon-Parilly on 29 September
- **5. O SOLE MIO** Won back-to-back sprints over 1100m and 1200m earlier this year but finished unplaced in 3 subsequent starts, twice over 1400m the latest (5th) at La Teste on 13 August. Returns off a mark 0,5kg lower
- **6. MARY JAYNE -** Opened her account at Chantilly last month over 1100m but finished a well-beaten 10th over 1200m in a Fontainebleau handicap on 14 November. For another day
- **7. RUE ROY -** Improved on her introductory 10th to finish a good 2nd over 1600m at Bordeaux on 5 November. Can earn a cheque

Summary: KIRCHNER (3) quickened in the manner of a smart sort when scoring on debut at Chantilly and that experience would've done him the world of good. With improvement expected on his reappearance, he is good value to keep his 100% record intact with class-dropper LIXTA (1) and consistent BIN ZARAK (4) likely to pose the biggest threats to his unbeaten status. The selection's stable companion RETIRO (2) completes the shortlist.

C3 - PRIX DU BOULEVARD DES PYRENEES - 1400m (a7f) - ALL WEATHER - Class 2 Race - Flat - EUR € 22,000

- **1. WE RIDE THE WORLD -** Versatile veteran with nothing to prove at this level and off his current mark. Finished an encouraging 4th over 1500m on PSF at Deauville on 9 November and will benefit from Manon Germain's 1,5kg allowance
- **2. NATIONAL SERVICE -** Lightly 7-year-old at the top of his game. Won a 1200m Quinte+ handicap at Chantilly before proving his competitiveness off this mark (under a 3kg penalty) when 2nd over 1400m at Vichy on 23 September
- **3. NOISY NIGHT -** Well-travelled hard-knocker with consistent form references in England, Germany and Spain. Debuting on French soil after finishing 8th over 1200m at Madrid on 20 October not taken lightly
- **4. WALLY -** On the podium in each of 6 starts this year, all on PSF won once, finished 3rd twice and 2nd three times. Runner-up over 1900m at Deauville on 1 August and boasts a 100% record (1 from 1) at this venue
- **5. LE SAGE -** Honest hard-knocker with the form and experience on this surface to play a role in the outcome. Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 5th on this course over 2000m on 19 October
- **6. ZALACAIN -** Out of sorts and unlikely to trouble the judge back on French soil after finishing 9th over 1600m in Madrid, Spain on 20 October. Others preferred

Summary: Sparingly raced NATIONAL SERVICE (2) and ultra-consistent WALLY (4) return from respective absences but have proven to run well fresh after a break. They could find themselves fighting for victory on their reappearances, with experienced WE RIDE THE WORLD (1) and well-traveled NOISY NIGHT (3) best equipped to expose any chinks in the armour of the aforementioned pair. LE SAGE (5) comes next.

C4 - PRIX D'ORTHEZ - 1600m (a1m) - ALL WEATHER - Newcomers Race - Flat - EUR € 23,000

- **1. ORLY -** Threat colt out of a well-bred unraced mare. Not taken lightly with Valentin Seguy aboard for Jean-Claude Rouget
- **2. CHARENGO** Damien de Watrigant-trained Shalaa colt supplemented to run in this race. Respected with Maryline Eon's 1,5kg weight allowance
- **3. STUPENDOUS HEART -** Gary Sanchez rides this Anodin colt on debut for trainer JA Ferreira De Oliveira. A watching brief is advised
- **4. ZVOKOKIEV -** Fas gelding trained by Jean-Claude Rouget who has booked Romain Dubord to ride this newcomer. Watch
- **5. LE TIRAILLEUR -** Expert Eye colt from the stable of Didier Guillemin who does well with young horses. Not taken lightly with Alexandre Gavilan in the saddle
- **6. VERMEER -** Samy Le Quilleuc rides this Golden Horde colt on debut for trainer Jean-Claude Rouget. Warrants respect
- **7. SHANCEL -** Shaman colt trained by Jean-Claude Rouget with one of the stable riders, Hugo Mouesan, engaged to ride. Keep safe
- **8. WARD KING -** Mickaël Forest rides this War Command gelding on debut trainer-owner Frédéric Sanchez. Watch for now
- **9. SIGNOR GALLI -** Thomas Blanchouin rides this Doris Schoenherr-trained Al Wukair colt on debut. Watching brief advised
- **10. MERLE NOIR -** Gutaifan gelding on debut for trainer-owner Guillaume Soulie who has engaged Damien Morin to ride. For another day
- **11. EPONINE -** This Philippe Sogorb-trained Tamayuz filly is the first foal out of a Listed-placed mare. Alejandro Gutiérrez Val rides
- **12. HELLO BELLA -** Gaël Lemer-trained Hello Youmzain filly debuting with Antoine Werlé in the saddle. Best watched for now
- **13. BEAUTIFUL MESS -** Well-bred Almanzor filly out of Marie Rossa who ran in the Group I Prix de Diane. Likely type on paper with Jean-Bernard Eyquem riding for Jean-Claude Rouget
- **14. OSAILYA -** Fabrice Veron rides this Gutaifan filly on debut for trainer Vitor Hugo Mendes Dos Santos. For another day
- **15. VINTUNA -** Van Beethoven debutante trained by Roberto-Carlos Montenegro. Clément Merille rides this filly first-up
- **16. MISS ALWAYS -** Marlène Meyer takes 1,5kg off the back of this Jimmy Two Times filly trained by Jean-Luc Pelletan. Watch for now



Summary: Jean-Claude Rouget saddles a formidable 5-pronged attack in this event for unraced 2-year-olds, among them well-bred filly BEAUTIFUL MESS (13) who appeals most with Jean-Bernard Eyquem booked to ride. However, stablemates SHANCEL (7) and ORLY (1) are also attractively bred newcomers so they aren't underestimated. EPONINE (11), the first foal of a well-performed mare, Didier Guillemin-trained LE TIRAILLEUR (5), and supplemented CHARENGO (2) are others not to be taken lightly.

C5 - PRIX DE MONT-DE-MARSAN - 2400m (a1m1/2) - ALL WEATHER -Handicap - Flat - EUR € 20,000

- **1. GOLDEN STATE -** Finished 9th in a Handicap at Toulouse over 2000m on 11 November. Track-suited but is stepping up in distance. Capable of contesting the finish
- **2. RAYO DE LUZ -** Unplaced in a Handicap at Deauville over 1900m on 3 November. Down in the weights and is track-suited. Is not out of it
- **3. PRETTY STORM -** Finished 6th in a Handicap at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 2400m on 22 October. A consistent sort that if taking to the PSF will be involved in the finish
- **4. LA CUESTIONADA -** Finished 10th in a Claimer at Deauville over 1900m on 24 October. Others are preferred in this line-up
- **5. ALMANSUR -** Finished 10th in a Handicap at Toulouse over 2400m on 23 October. Capable of making the frame. Good form before the latest moderate effort
- **6. ESCUDO D'OURO -** Finished 7th in a Conditions race at Mont-de-Marsan over 3000m on 16 November. Yet to win and first time in a Handicap
- **7. JUBBAH -** Finished 7th in a Handicap at Toulouse over 2000m on 11 November. Performed well on this track in January and is well-weighted
- **8. EL KALBITO -** Unplaced in a Handicap at Toulouse over 2000m on 11 November. Unplaced since winning in May
- **9. SEVEN ANGELS -** Finished 6th in a Conditions race at Toulouse over 2000m on 31 October. Unreliable and had a poor previous Handicap race in July
- **10. EXACTAMUNDO -** Finished 6th in a Handicap at Toulouse over 2400m on 23 October. Can play a minor role in the finish at best
- **11. LADY OF NABEUL -** Fourth in a Claimer at Chantilly over 2100m on 28 October. Seldom far off them and has joined the Frédéric Pardon stable. Deserves to be respected
- **12. LOPPORTUNISTE -** Finished 6th in a Conditions race at Mont-de-Marsan over 3000m on 16 November. Moderate latest effort after winning the penultimate

Summary: A very weak race. PRETTY STORM (3) is capable of winning a race like this but does try the PSF for the first time. LADY OF NABEUL (11) was not disgraced last time out and has been better in claimers but is not out of it. JUBBAH (7) likes this track and would not be a surprise winner. GOLDEN STATE (1) steps up in distance but does like this course and has a winning chance.

C6 - PRIX DE BIZANOS - 2400m (a1m1/2) - ALL WEATHER - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 14,000

- **1. PARABAK -** Not easy to trust and was 8th last time out in a handicap at Toulouse over 2400m on 11 November. Capable of winning a race like this
- **2. LUXU -** Unreliable and was 6th last time out in a Conditions race at Niort over 3100m on 20 October. Tackles stronger this time
- **3. LE QUEEN -** Has struggled of late and was 12th last time out in a handicap at this track over 1600m on 13 November. Capable of doing better but others are preferred
- **4. PEYRASSOL -** Yet to win a race but is in good form and was fourth last time out in a handicap at Toulouse over 2400m on 11 November. Be right there at the finish
- **5. CAFE SAIGON -** Not disgraced when 5th last time out in a Conditions race at Mont-de-Marsan over 1600m on 16 November. Can surprise this track and trip
- **6. ARMORIGENE -** Has struggled of late and was 15th last time out in a handicap at Fontainebleau over 3000m on 14 November. Capable of better and is not out of it
- **7. ATHELIA -** Unreliable and was tenth last time out in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1900m on 5 November. Capable of better and has a winning chance
- **8. LE RAFALE -** Very unreliable but was fourth last time out in a handicap at Mont-de-Marsan over 2000m on 25 August. Might need this run returning from a break
- **9. DIRTY DOZEN -** Disappointing recent form and was tenth last time out in a handicap at this course over 1600m on 13 November. Likely to do better this longer distance
- **10. GRISGRISES -** Unreliable and was 7th last time out in a handicap at Toulouse over 2400m on 23 October. Could play a minor role
- **11. FAN ZONE -** Did not show her best when 13th last time out in a handicap at Pornichet-La Baule over 2100m on 13 November. Might play a minor role
- **12. DE QUEVEDO -** Showed improvement when fourth in a handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 19 November. Has a place chance
- **13. MA CHERIE AMOUR -** On a long losing run and was 8th last time out in a Conditions race at Agen-The Passage over 1200m on 27 October. Tries a lot further this time
- **14. AL IMPACT -** Disappointing recent form and was tenth last time out in a handicap at Toulouse over 2400m on 2 October. Others are preferred

Summary: PEYRASSOL (4) has yet to win a race and is unproven on this surface but is also quite capable of winning a weak race like this. ATHELIA (7) is capable of better than the recent runs suggests and could be a lively danger if in the right mood. ARMORIGENE (6) is also capable of getting involved with the finish. PARABAK (1) is not easy to trust but is also not out of it.

- **1. THE MAGIC MAN -** Did not show his best when 13th last time out in a handicap at Toulouse over 2400m on 11 November. In good form before that and can bounce back to score
- **2. BECQUANON -** Has struggled of late and was 12th last time out in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1900m on 13 October. Others make more appeal
- **3. ELIOTT CHOP -** Very consistent of late and was third last time out in a handicap at Toulouse over 2400m on 11 November. Has a winning chance
- **4. TEMPLE GATE -** Has struggled of late and was 9th last time out in a claimer at Mont-de-Marsan over 2450m on 16 November. Needs major improvement to win
- **5. RUSHDY -** Finished 12th last time out at Madrid over 1800m on 19 May. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- **6. VIS LE REVE -** Unreliable and was 12th last time out in a handicap at Toulouse over 2400m on 2 October. Has won at this track and could be the surprise package of the race
- **7. CAVANI KAIZEN -** Unreliable and was 9th last time out in a handicap at La Teste-de-Buch over 2400m on 12 September. Has won on this surface and should be a threat
- **8. GREAT PROMISE -** Disappointing recent forma nd was 6th last time out in a handicap at Toulouse over 2400m on 11 November. Might earn some minor money at best
- **9. ASSIER -** Unreliable but was not disgraced when 5th in a handicap at Toulouse over 2400m on 11 November. Has won over this track and trip before and is not out of it
- **10. VERSION COX -** Showed some improvement when 6th last time out in a handicap at toulouse over 2400m on 2 October. Capable of an upset this track and trip
- **11. NOTRE HISTOIRE -** Did not show his best when 9th last time out in a Conditions race at Toulouse over 2000m on 18 September. Capable of playing a minor role
- **12. L'ARCHET -** Very consistent of late and was fourth last time out in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1900m on 5 November. May be better on the turf though
- **13. NANTMOR -** Unreliable and was 9th last time out in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1900m on 13 October. Others are much preferred
- **14. XARUN -** Has really struggled of late and was 17th last time out in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 12 November. Needs major improvement to win
- **15. PEDROZIO -** In good form of late and was victorious last time out in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1900m on 5 November. Can double up if in the same mood

Summary: PEDROZIO (15) has been very good of late winning twice. He carries a penalty for the latest win and still has to prove himself on this surface but gets the vote to score. CAVANI KAIZEN (7) is unreliable but does like the PSF and can contest the finish. ELIOTT CHOP (3) has been very consistent of late so should be very competitive again. THE MAGIC MAN (1) was in good form before a disappointing last run and can also make the frame.

- **1. NIKOLAJ -** Only modest of late and was 6th last time out in a handicap at Toulouse over 2400m on 11 November. Capable of earning some money
- **2. PHILIPPO -** Unreliable but was not disgraced when fourth last time out in a handicap at Toulouse over 2400m on 11 November. Can contest the finish again
- **3. MEXICAN DREAM -** Holding form and was third last time out in a handicap at Toulouse over 2400m on 11 November, Big chance in this line-up
- **4. MORANDI FIRST -** Only modest of late and was 7th last time out in a handicap at Toulouse over 2400m on 11 November. Might play a minor role
- **5. GLORIETTE SAN -** Only modest of late and was 6th last time out in a handicap at Toulouse over 2400m on 11 November. Capable of better and has a winning chance
- **6. ATLANTIGO -** Unreliable and was tenth last time out in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1900m on 22 November. Won his penultimate start and is not out of it
- **7. THIRD BATCH -** Did not show her best when 15th last time out in a handicap at Angers over 2300m on 21 May. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- **8. PRINCE ANODIN -** Unreliable and was fourth last time out in a claimer at Agen-The Passage over 1850m on 27 October. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **9. MOON DREAM** Not disgraced when 5th last time out in a handicap at Toulouse over 2000m on 17 November. A bit unreliable but is not out of it
- **10. PRINCE OF DAWN -** Did not show his best when 7th last time out in a claimer at Fontainebleau over 2200m on 4 November. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **11. TASHAAR -** Has struggled of late and was 8th last time out in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1900m on 26 October. Likes this course and can bounce to score
- **12. COCOON QUATRE -** Has lost her way of late and was 13th last time out in a handicap at Deauville over 2500m on 2 November. Needs major improvement to win

Summary: MEXICAN DREAM (3) has been holding her form well and gets a narrow nod to take out this lucky last race. TASHAAR (11) clearly likes this course so it is worth ignoring the recent runs and he will be a danger. PHILIPPO (2) is unreliable but does have a winning chance. GLORIETTE SAN (5) seems better than some modest recent runs and could make the frame this time.

- **1. QUE BELLA -** Did not show her best when 8th last time out in a Conditions race at Lyon-Parilly over 2400m on 8 November. Tries the PSF but can bounce back to score
- **2. MOOR MALPIC -** Disappointing form of late and was 8th last time out in a Conditions race at Nantes over 2400m on 1 November. Tries the PSF and has a winning chance
- **3. ETERNEL'S BEAUTE** Proved in need of the only run of this year when 6th in a Conditions race at Le Mans over 1950m on 2 November. Has ability and can bounce back to score trying further and the PSF
- **4. DEMPY -** Holding form and was fourth last time out in a Conditions race at Fontainebleau over 2000m on 14 November. Be right there at the finish once again

- **1. ZELMAN -** Has lost his way of late and was 14th last timje out in a handicap at Fontainebleau over 2000m on 14 November. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **2. CALADBOLG** Has struggled of late and was 14th last time out in a handicap at Chantilly over 1600m on 19 November. Others are preferred
- **3. MODERN LIGHT -** Improving and has won two of last three starts, with the latest being in a handicap over this course and distance on 3 November. Can follow up carrying a penalty
