

### **R3 SALON-DE-PROVENCE [R-H]**

# C1 - PRIX ALL IS VANITY - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Class 2 Race - Flat - EUR € 27,000

- **1. SHOOTING -** Has improved with each start and did win a Conditions race last time out at Marseille-Borély over this distance on 2 September. Deserves respect in this line-up
- **2. STARNBERG -** Did all that was asked of him when scoring a Conditions race on debut over this track and trip on 9 September. Can double up
- **3. DONEGAL -** Has some fair form and was not disgraced when fourth last time out in a Conditions race at Marseille-Borély over 1700m on 2 September. Not out of it
- **4. IOWA CITY -** Very consistent and was a winner last time out in a Conditions race at Marseille-Borély over this distance on 2 September. Can fight out the finish again
- **5. SIGNORIA PIAZZA -** Yet5 to win a race and was 5th last time out in a Conditions race at Vichy over 1600m on 24 September. More is needed to beat these rivals

**Summary:** A small field but only one of them can be safely discarded. STARNBERG (2) looked good when scoring on debut over this track and trip and would not be a surprise winner. IOWA CITY (4) is improving and won over this distance last time out and deserves respect for that win. DONEGAL (3) is consistent and will fight all the way to the line. SHOOTING (1) is improving and can also get involved with the finish.

# C2 - PRIX DES CIGALES - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 2 Race - Flat - EUR € 22,000

- **1. MORPHEWAN -** In good form and was third last time out in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1800m on 8 September. Better this distance and has a big winning chance
- **2. ANONYMOUS -** Very consistent and was third last time out in a claimer at Chantilly over 1900m on 21 September. Could earn some more money
- **3. BAY D'ARGENT -** Holding form well and was fourth last time out in a Conditions race at La Teste-de-Buch over 1600m on 13 August. Be right there at the finish
- **4. THUNDERSPEED -** Did not show his best when 12th last time out in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 2000m on 15 September. In good form before that and is not out of it
- **5. ROCQUEMONT -** Unreliable but was victorious in a claimer last time out at Marseille-Borely over 1700m on 16 September. Might play a minor role
- **6. SAINT HELLIER -** Has struggled of late and was 8th last time out in a Conditions race at Vichy over this distance on 15 August. Others are preferred
- **7. MUELHEIMER PERLE -** In good form and was victorious last time out in a handicap over this track and trip on 9 September. Tackles tougher but is not out of it

**Summary:** MORPHEWAN (1) is in good form and was not disgraced in a handicap last time out. Back in a conditions race he should prove hard to beat. BAY D'ARGENT (3) has been very competitive of late and will not go down without a fight for top honours. THUNDERSPEED (4) is better than the last run would suggest and can contest the finish. ROCQUEMONT (5) won a claimer last time out but can make the frame.

- **1. BANSHIE -** Did not show her best when well beaten last time out in a handicap at Lyon-Parilly over this distance over this distance on 17 September. Capable of making the frame
- **2. COSMOPOLITAINE -** Not disgraced when third on debut in a Conditions race at La Teste-de-Buch over this distance on 21 August. Can do even better with improvement expected
- **3. HOW DARE YOU -** Well beaten last time out when tenth in a Conditions race at Lyon-Parilly over 2200m on 24 June. Did better on debut and has a winning chance
- **4. GENERAL JONES -** A three-year-old colt by Al Wukair out of Mahabba who is making his debut. Watch the betting
- **5. SANNOM -** A three-year-old gelding by Wootton Bassett out of Meseika who is making his debut. Watch the betting
- **6. MAYKO -** A three-year-old gelding by Havana Gold out of Likelihood who is making his debut. Watch the betting
- **7. LADY TURNER -** A three-year-old filly by Al Wukair out of Cheeky Lady who is making her debut. Watch the betting
- **8. RIASSOU -** A three-year-old filly by The Great Spirit out of Manssouria who is making her debut. Watch the betting

**Summary:** An interesting race where there are some newcomers that could be very dangerous. GENERAL JONES (4) and SANNOM (5) both represent trainers that know what is needed to score on debut. GENERAL JONES (4) gets a narrow vote to score. COSMOPOLITAINE (2) ran well on debut and with improvement expected should fight out the finish again. BANSHIE (1) is also capable of contesting the finish.

# C4 - PRIX GEORGES CAMPRUBI - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 2 Race - Flat - EUR € 22,000

- 1. KINGSALE Disappointing last run when tenth at Deauville last time out over this distance. Has won at this track before and is not out of it
- **2. BRUANT -** Holding his form well and was third last time out in a Conditions race at Mont-de-Marsan over 2450m on 19 July. Has won at this track and can bounce back to score
- **3. MIRADERO -** Has some fair form and was 5th last time out in a handicap at Lyon-Parilly over this distance on 1 June. Returns from a break but could play a minor role
- **4. SOKNA -** Did not show her best when 8th last time out in a handicap at Vichy over 1600m on 23 August. Better this distance and has a place chance
- **5. SISTERLAND -** Did not show her best when 7th last time out in a Listed race at Marseille0Borely over this distance on 16 September. Capable of contesting the finish
- **6. DANCING QUEEN -** Unreliable and was well beaten last time out in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1600m on 4 July. Others are preferred
- **7. ALBINE -** Broke the ice with a handicap win at Vichy over 1600m on 23 August. Capable of making the frame
- **8. YAKAMOUN -** Did not show her best when 6th last time out in a Conditions race at Toulouse over this distance on 19 June. Could need this run returning from a break

**Summary:** BRUANT (2) is consistent and likes soft track so gets a narrow choice in a very competitive-looking race. KINGSALE (1) has won at this track before and is capable of winning a race like this. SISTERLAND (5) was not disgraced in a Listed race last time out and deserves the utmost respect. ALBINE (7) showed improvement when scoring last time and could have more to offer.

# C5 - PRIX DE LA LIBERTE - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 4 Race - Flat - EUR € 14,000

- **1. KHANWEILER -** Won two of his last three runs, the latest was in a Class 4 race at Fontainebleau on September 22nd over 2000m. Can play a lead role
- **2. QUDILLERO -** Ran well when 2nd last time at Auch in a Class 4 handicap over 2000m on September 8th. And a win at Dax in July. Consider
- **3. JUSSIFER -** Unplaced last time, 2nd before that over 1900m at Deauville on August 22nd in a Class 3 handicap. Can be competitive
- **4. SPORT COUPE -** Credible 3rd last time at this track and a win before that over 1600m in a Class 4 handicap at Vichy on August 23rd. In the mix
- **5. CARTER AND GO -** Has been 3rd on his last two runs, the latest over 2400m at Salon Provence on September 9th in a Class 4 race. One to respect
- **6. ROI DE FLANDRE -** Unplaced several times of late, the latest over 2000m in a Class 4 handicap at Vichy on September 23rd. Out of form and best avoided
- 7. VENT DU REVE Fair 4th last time at Auch over 2000m in a Class 4 handicap on September 8th. Place chance at best
- **8. WUKOLINA -** Unplaced last time, 4th before that over 2000m at Vichy on August 19th in a Class 4 race. Others make more appeal

**Summary:** KHANWEILER (1) has been in top form recently, with two wins from his last three runs. He scored at Fontainebleau 8 days ago and will be ready for this. SPORT COUPE (4) might be the one who makes the selection work the hardest. He likes this track and ran well on his latest start when third 21 days ago over 1800m. CARTER AND GO (5) is the one to side with each way. He has numerous place efforts recently. JUSSIFER (3) heads the remainder.

# C6 - PRIX RAYMOND GODINEZ - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Handicap - Flat - EUR € 18,000

- **1. BALIROS -** Unplaced on the last two runs, won before that over 1600m in a maiden at Vittel on July 25th. In the mix
- **2. PLACID'OO -** Good placed form of late and a win on July 24th at Vichy in a claiming race over 1600m. One to pay attention too
- **3. HAPPY TOGETHER -** Unplaced on the three runs so far, the latest over 1800m at Marseille Borely in a maiden on September 2nd. Has shown talent and can be involved
- **4. AMERICADREAM -** 5th last time, 3rd before that over 1600m at Vichy on July 24th in a claimer. Makes limited appeal
- **5. NEW WAY BABY -** Three unplaced runs since a win over 1300m in a claimer at Argentan on June 5th. Needs to get back on track
- **6. PROMESSE -** Ran well when 2nd last time on her third start over 1950m in a claimer at Le Mans on September 13th. Not to be discounted
- **7. BOMBONERA -** Fair 2nd last time over 1700m in a claimer at Divonne on September 1st. Might find a few of these too smart
- **8. MAKING WAVES -** 2nd last time in a claimer at this track over 1800m on September 8th, and a win before that at Divonne on September 1st. Player
- **9. TAGA -** Unplaced last time, 3rd before that over 1600m in a claimer at Vichy on July 17th in a claimer. Has place claims
- **10. COTE D'OR -** Three unplaced runs so far, the latest over 1200m at Marseille Borely on September 16th in a maiden race. Hard to recommend

**Summary:** MAKING WAVES (8) ran a good race when second in a claimer last time. She is the selection ahead of the top-weight BALIROS (1) who won at Vittel in late July and has not been disgraced on his latest two runs. HAPPY TOGETHER (3) has shown ability in all three of his runs and could be well handicapped. He looks like a good option each way. PROMESSE (6) ran her best race when she was second at Le Mans earlier this month and can not be overlooked.

- **1. ALROMY -** Unplaced last time, won before that over 2400m at Vichy in a Class 4 handicap on august 15th. Needs a few to misfire
- **2. SHE'S ALL -** Won on her last outing over 2600m at Marseille Borely in a Class 4 handicap on September 16th. Has a penalty for that win but can not be ignored
- **3. MISS ROAZHON -** Solid effort when 2nd at Marseille Borely on September 16th in a Class 4 handicap when last seen. Leading chance
- **4. SYLVER SAMBA -** 5th last time at Lyon Parilly over 2400m in a Class 4 handicap on September 17th. Unlikely to trouble some of these
- **5. AMIATA -** Won last time at Vitteaux over 2600m in a Class 4 race on September 22nd. Warrants plenty of respect
- **6. EXHIT -** Nice 5th in a Class 4 handicap over 2400m at Lyon Parilly last time on September 17th. Player
- **7. BRAZING -** Three unplaced runs since he was 2nd at Lyon La Soie on March 15th in a Class 4 handicap. Better suited to the PSF
- **8. YAVAIKA -** Has several unplaced runs of late, the most recent over 2000m in a Class 4 race on September 22nd at Vitteaux. Pass over
- **9. AIRA -** Credible 2nd last time over 2400m at Lyon Parilly in a Class 4 handicap on September 17th. Has work to do

**Summary:** EXHIT (6) has been shaping well without winning of late. He was fifth at Lyon Parilly earlier this month and is the tentative selection ahead of MISS ROAZHON (3) who was recently second at Marseille Borely in mid-September when she was beaten under a length by SHE'S ALL (2) who is now carrying a penalty for that win. The roles can be reversed this time. AMIATA (5) makes up the shortlist.

# C8 - PRIX GERARD NOUGIER - 2400m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 17,000

- **1. DECBOU -** Has eased in the ratings after some unplaced efforts this year. Unplaced at Vichy on July 18th over 2800m in a Class 3 race on the last outing. Fairly treated on his best form
- **2. FOLLOW YOU -** 5th last time over 3000m at Chantilly in a Class 3 handicap on September 26th. Among the leading chances
- **3. KINGORI -** Ran well when 3rd over 2600m in a Class 4 handicap at Marseille Borely on September 16th. Won twice in the Spring. One to keep safe
- **4. FASHIONSPAN -** Two unplaced runs of late, 3rd before that over 3000m at Vichy on August 15th in a Class 4 handicap. Others make more appeal
- **5. NABUNGA** Has been in decent form recently, won in June, and has faired well since that success. 3rd over 2400m in a Class 4 race on August 9th on his latest outing. Consider
- **6. DOCTEUR TOURNESOL -** 2nd last time over 2200m in a Class 4 race at Zonda on June 30th. Has outside place claims
- **7. VERLAN -** Placed on the last three runs, the latter when 3rd over 2000m at Marseille Borely in a Class 4 race. Looks ready to score
- **8. HADLEIGH -** Won last time over 2400m at this track in a Class 4 race on September 9th. Can make the frame
- **9. MOUTRAKI -** Has three unplaced runs of late, 4th before that over 2400m at this track on June 25th in a Class 3 handicap. Needs to get back on track

- **1. CITYLANDOR -** Has five unplaced runs of late, the latter over 1300m at Craon in a handicap on September 22nd. Hard to be enthusiastic about
- 2. TARPLEY Unplaced on his only run-over 1600m at Nantes on September 10th. Unlikely to be a threat
- **3. SITOI -** Fair effort when 2nd at Compiegne last time over 1600m on September 17th. That was his first run in 6 months and he will be sharper for that
- **4. SEPTIMUS -** 5th last time over 1600m at Compiegne on September 17th in the same race as SITOI (3) ran in when 2nd. Has an each-way chance
- **5. CONCERTATION -** Has numerous placed efforts, the latest when 4th in a Class 3 race at Parislongchamp on September 8th over 1600m. Deserves a win and has a leading chance
- **6. AURORA'S BEAUTY -** Has been placed on all of her starts when with Charlie Appleby in the UK. Her latest effort was when she was 2nd at Newmarket over 1600m on June 29th. Can be involved on her French debut
- **7. ANDARTIS -** Newcomer by Le Brivido, the dam won three times in the UK. The betting market can be the best guide to his chances
- **8. A LIGHT MIST -** Newcomer by Robin Of Navan, the dam was a maiden. Should be well prepared by connections and is one to watch in the betting for clues
- 9. ZALA One unplaced run over hurdles at Lyon Parilly on April 20th. Best watched on her flat debut
- **10. JAVELINA -** Unraced filly by New Bay, stable runners tend to need a run or two. Watch the betting for any support

**Summary:** CONCERTATION (5) has been placed on several occasions, her last effort when she was fourth at Parislongchamp earlier this month. She can edge this from SITOI (3) who was second last time on his return from an absence of six months. He should be a lot fitter for that outing. AURORA'S BEAUTY (6) had some solid form in the UK and was second at Newmarket last time. She warrants respect. SEPTIMUS (4) is also one to consider.

- 1. OUT OF AFRICA Won a Class 2 race at Craon last time over 1650m on September 22nd. Can not be ruled out
- **2. GIUSEPPE BALLOCCO -** Has plenty of experience, 2nd last time in a Class 2 race at Craon over 1650m behind OUT OF AFRICA (1) on September 22nd. Hard task ahead
- **3. SILIUS -** Unplaced in a Group 3 race last time, but a good 4th before that in a Listed race at Deauville on August 17th over 1600m. Player
- **4. LADY OF ANDROS -** Fair effort when 4th in a Class 2 race at Saint-Cloud on September 13th over 1200m. One to pay attention too
- **5. EURASIA -** Won on her debut in a newcomers race at Dieppe on August 21st over 1400m. Can improve a good bit for that run and could be useful
- **6. ADDICTION GAGNANTE -** Won a maiden at Le Lion D'Angers over 1400m on June 9th when last seen. Might find a few of these too smart
- **7. OCEAN TREATY -** Won a maiden last time at Lyon Parilly over 1350m on September 4th. Has an outside place chance

**Summary:** EURASIA (5) won on her debut at Dieppe in August in a race for newcomers. The third and fourth that day have both won since, so it was probably a decent effort. She will improve and can get the better of SILIUS (3) who was fourth in a Listed race two starts ago and won a Chantilly maiden on his second run. LADY OF ANDROS (4) can also have a say in proceedings. OUT OF AFRICA (1) bolted up last time. This will require a lot more but she can be on the premises.

- **1. CLOSE TO YOU -** Unplaced on the last two runs, won before that over 1600m in a Class 4 race at Royan on August 4th. Has place claims at nice odds
- **2. FECAMP -** 4th at Le Mans over 1400m on September 13th in a Class 4 handicap. Has eased to a reasonable handicap rating and is not to be ruled out
- **3. MINO PICO -** Decent 2nd last time over 1400m at Le Mans in a Class 4 handicap on September 13th. Can make an impact
- **4. COOLMEEN ROYAL -** 3rd last time over 1000m in a Class 4 handicap at Fontainebleau on September 22nd. One to pay attention too
- **5. MADMOISELLECHANG -** Has four unplaced runs of late, the latter over 1400m at Le Mans in a Class 4 handicap on September 13th. Looks vulnerable
- **6. SHAMASUN -** Two placed efforts of late, the latest when 3rd at Le Mans on September 13th in a Class 4 handicap. Ought to be in the shake-up

- **11. STANTO -** Two unplaced runs this year, the latter over 1400m in a Class 4 handicap at Le Mans on September 13th. Opposable

- **2. PHILOSOPHY -** Three good runs recently, the latter when 3rd over 3000m at Craon in a Class 3 handicap on September 22nd. Live chance
- **3. SOULOU MALPIC -** 5th last time, 3rd before that over 2400m in a Class 4 handicap on September 15th at Le Lion D'Angers. Ought to be in the shake-up
- **4. LEPTI PRINSADI -** Unplaced last time, 2nd before that over 2650m at Cahteaubriant on August 16th in a Class 4 handicap. Others seem better equipped

**Summary:** PHILOSOPHY (2) has shown good honest form of late and was a decent third at Craon 8 days ago when he finished third in a Class 3 race. SHATTERHAND (1) will be dangerous. His run on his penultimate start when he was fourth at Parislongchamp was a nice effort and if emulating that, he can play a lead role. HENOUVILLE (8) has been consistent all year and can once again have a say at the business end. SOULOU MALPIC (3) is also worth a mention.
