Maglev Primo Wings Of War

Galileo Gold had one of his progeny register the first Listed success of his fledgling stallion career last week and another of his offspring, MAGLEV, could get off the mark here. The hammer went down at 210,000 pounds for the youngster in the spring and he represents William Haggas' top-class operation. George Boughey's string continues to thrive and that brings his Primo into calculations, while Wings Of War is a 140,000-pound son of Dark Angel, who starts out for a team that does well with juveniles.

Neptune Legend Yaahobby Triple Time

NEPTUNE LEGEND, a half-brother to Group 3-winning sprinters Eastern Impact and Summerghand, made an encouraging start when second at Nottingham and Hugo Palmer's expensive youngster can put that experience to good use. William Haggas' Kodiak colt Yaahobby is out of a former smart juvenile and could be one of the more likely newcomers. Others who could figure on debut include 200,000-pound breeze-up buy Dhabab and the Frankel colt Triple Time, who is a half-brother to some smart performers, including Derby contender Third Realm.

MUHALHEL's form is much better than it perhaps reads on paper and the 72-rated Lope De Vega colt could prove much too good for the opposition here. Accrington Stanley was found wanting in the closing stages at Brighton, but has plenty of experience to call upon and is interesting returned to this distance in a first-time tongue-tie. Sadie's Day, dropping back in trip in a first-time visor, completes the shortlist.

Both of his career victories have come at Yarmouth, but he has the chance to advertise his talents elsewhere now. Croeso Cymraeg was a neck away from catching all-the-way winner Bit Of A Quirk over track and trip, while Flying West was beaten the same distance at Lingfield and steps up from a mile off only a 1lb higher rating. John Mackie has his string in good order and that brings Polyphony into calculations on her return to turf.

Night Moment's pedigree suggests that he should relish this distance and the Mark Johnston-trained colt warrants respect, while handicap debutant Night Of Dreams is still unexposed and could build on his latest run.
