Two trials to date since arriving by the sire Mikki Isle. Well held in his trials in good time and could be an eye catcher at his debut run for the Japanese master trainer.

4th Pick: MYSTERY POWER (2)

Caught the eye running on strongly last start in class 4. Gets to class five for the first time today and could be good value off that form. Big watch.

Shooting for a hat-trick of wins after being very strong in weaker races. This is a stronger class but a small field could see him in the exotics.

Just a one-time winner in nineteen starts. Has had some hard luck stories in a few of his recent starts. Stable going well and don't dismiss for multiples.
