Race Summary: Cracking sprint to start off the 10-race programme. NORTH POINT won impressively after two build-up performances. He could be headed for better races. ORBIT is also promising. He won well before a no-show effort when tried in a feature. Gelding may have done the trick with him. IRELAND FOREVER is also highly regarded. He is better than his run in the Grade 3 Cape Of Good Hope Nursery and is worth considering. AMEN CORNER won her debut as she liked and is open to improvement.

Watch out for RANDOLPH HEARST who made a fair debut for the powerful yard of trainer Justin Snaith. He should relish the extra and could be hard to peg back jumping from a plum gate. CAPTAINS ALLIANCE can improve over the extra, along with BALZI ROSSI. More with earning potential in it.

A set of blinkers could see a bolder performance. Watch out for newcomer LOWVELD LILY who is well related. She won't need to be a star to win it.

his last run. He has shown potential. ARIOVISTUS has drawn well and can earn.

She has Richard Fourie up form a fair barrier. HOW RIGHT YOU ARE, SWEETSUMMERLOVE and BEAUTIFUL SIDE can upset.

KWITE A KING is another hard knocker that may prove effective over the extra distance. He can't be faulted on his consistent form. WOOD WORLD has more to do after winning his maiden. HELIOTROPE rates the dark horse at the weights.
