Kenilworth, 27.11.2022, Race 1, Gallops, 900m, Turf, R120.000, 12:30GMT+2

Race Summary: The baby race in Cape Town and the betting should provide clues to the chances of these 2yo fillies on debut - follow the market movers. MISS HANNIGAN, SUNSHINE DAY, and Lancaster Bomber debutantes SAVIC and well-related RUNWAY BOMB must be respected given the encouraging trainer comments.

Race Summary: Another 2yo newcomers' race, so the betting should be closely monitored with regards to the chances of these on debut. JEWEL CAT, MANCHESTER FIGHTER, SPEEDING BULLET and NISHINO make most appeal given their trainer comments. Watch the betting!

Race Summary: Tricky work riders' event. ELECTRIC FEELS rates the one to beat and wouldn't be winning out of turn having finished 2nd in her last 2 starts, both over this trip. BARNBOUGLE, NIGHT TIGER and NOT IN DOUBT are closely matched on the form of a recent meeting over the course and distance. They're all capable of making their presence felt and there shouldn't be much separating the trio once more. FUTURE TURN has both consistent form and the experience to pose a threat but may find this a touch on the sharp side dropping right back to this trip after races over a lot further.

Race Summary: CONTIGUOUS has been 2nd in 3 of his last 4 starts, the latest of which was over this trip, and has since been gelded so could have even more to offer - one to beat with improvement likely. DOUBLING UP finished behind that rival over 1200m but should fare better over this distance and can be expected to pose more of a threat. INSIDE STORY disappointed over 1200m last time after a promising debut and could be worth another chance now stepping up in trip. MADISON BLUES wasn't far off the mark over this trip when last seen and could get into the action again. CAPTAIN CORRUPT may have more to offer.

Race Summary: This won't take much winning, so the chances of likely improvers CRIMSON WINGS and CATCHUSIFYOUCAN must be respected with the longer run-in over this trip expected to bring about improvement. DAISY DUKE and MEDLERS TART have both the form and experience to fight out the finish, although it could be worth taking a chance on the latter's stablemate, ROYAL INVITATION, who caught the eye when staying on from a long way back (wide draw) last time out.

Race Summary: Good race, featuring 4 last-start winners including progressive hat-trick seeking SILVANO'S DASHER who has won both starts after gelding and is likely to have more to offer now stepping up in trip. Stablemates RUNNING RIFLES and well-related NIGHT RULER have more to do upped in class but are capable of making their presence felt. However, veteran NORTHERN SONG and consistent SUGAR MOUNTAIN could pose more of a threat if reproducing the form of recent efforts over this distance. On that form, WECANGOALLNIGHT ought to be competitive and, as such, should be included in all bets. Must watch!

Race Summary: Good race. Leading 3yo CHARLES DICKENS was impressive in his comeback win and could well head into the Guineas with an unbeaten record by preserving that unblemished record in his peak outing. Regally bred stablemate NARINA TROGON caught the eye with a fast-finishing 5th over a shorter trip last time and should have more to offer now stepping up in trip. Fellow 3yo KINGDOM OF HEAVEN won his last start and could be a Derby prospect. He ought to improve but will need to do so to make his presence felt in this company. WINCHESTER MANSION and RUSSIAN ROCK could pose more of a threat, as a result.

Stablemate MA BLACK is a dual track-and-trip winner so will also appreciate reverting to this distance. CITYSCAPE, another likely to enjoy a return to 1000m, has more scope for improvement and should be competitive with progress expected. PALO QUEEN, down in class, and APOLLO MOON are also capable of making their presence felt. FASHION MISTRESS and WHERE'S THE PARTY are others to consider.
