

RACE 1 8:40 PM | SAR95,000 | RIYADH | 1351m

2	VULTAR	Classy UK import with two all-weather successes in his time with trainer Clive Cox. Down the field on local debut on dirt but should be much more at home on turf.
4	SHAYEKH	Second of seven over 1200m on turf last December off a mark of 77. Now 12lb higher but enters this race after some good dirt displays.
6	WILLIAM TELL	Smart sprinter who has drawn well inside. Fifth of 18 in a 0-90 dirt handicap last month and could fare better here.
3	CUBAN TIGER	Weakened at the halfway stage on both local outings on dirt since moving from the UK. Switches to turf and blinkers fitted.

RACE 2 9:05 PM | SAR40,000 | RIYADH | 1200m

13	THAMER ALMOGHSTARAH	Unraced Requito colt out of an unraced but well-bred mare. Can make an impact on debut for powerful connections.
9	MADYSOON	Unraced Commissioner colt out of a limited Irish-bred mare. Leading jockey booked for debut.
14	WAFI ALKHEIR	Third of 17 over course and distance on his penultimate outing. Similar effort here two weeks ago and sets the form standard.
17	SOREB	Showed plenty of early speed when third of 17 over course and distance last week. Should make a bold bid from the front.

RACE 3 9:35 PM | SAR100,000 | RIYADH | 2100m

3	BOLTAWAY	Course-and-distance winner who finished second over track and trip last week. Perhaps should have won that race but gets an immediate chance for compensation off the same mark.
5	GAASY	Two-time 2000m winner on dirt this season and not disgraced in Listed company last week. Switches to turf for the first time but bred to handle it.
1	ALMURTAJIZ	Four-time winner who drops in grade after finishing seventh of nine in a 2400m Cup race on dirt last month. This is his turf debut.
7	COOL LEGEND	Course winner over 3000m in January. Only sixth of 10 over track and trip last week and will do well to reverse the form with Boltaway.

RACE 4 10:00 PM | SAR85,000 | RIYADH | 1200m

1	ALRAFE'AH	Yet to find her best form this term but she's a three-time winner over this trip who is dropping out of Open company. Dangerous.
12	SAHAB ALMOGTARH	Unexposed filly with two victories over track and trip to her name. Only seen once this term and has to prove that she has trained on, but she could be well handicapped.
4	NEMER ALMOGTARAH	Course-and-distance scorer off this mark back in October. Solid form since over a variety of trips and worth a second look now given optimum conditions.
3	LAMA ALZULFI	Secured her fourth career success with a victory at this level over 1400m last month. Now drops in trip off a 6lb higher mark.

RACE 5 10:30 PM | SAR150,000 | RIYADH | 1200m

4	FIGHTER	Two-time course-and-distance winner last season who should relish the return to 1200m. Wide draw complicates matters.
12	SAODAD	Lovable veteran with 21 wins from 56 starts. Might not be the force of old, but his recent performances still give him a good chance in this contest.
10	SAEBOUT	Unexposed sprinter who finished second of 14 over course and distance last month, beating several of these. Open to more improvement and can't be discounted.
5	INHIMR	Won the Shubra Cup at Taif in July last year. Didn't match that form at this venue and returned in a quiet manner three weeks ago.

RACE 6 11:00 PM | SAR100,000 | RIYADH | 1400m

2	ISTEGLAL	Unexposed performer with winning course-and-distance form. Third of 11 in a better handicap here last week and isn't without a chance.
7	JESSAN	Won a better handicap over 1600m here last year off a mark of 102. Races off just 89 here but might need a longer trip.
1	AWAMIR	Three-time winner whose last success came in this grade off a 5lb lower mark in February. Struggled in a 1600m Open in October.
6	BAIRAQ ALHEZAM	Dropping down the handicap but still failing to appeal. Hasn't won since July 2024 and needs a greater test of stamina.

RACE 7 11:30 PM | SAR85,000 | RIYADH | 2000m

3	AL SUWEIDA	Prolific seven-time scorer with solid form at this level. Down to an enticing mark and should play a part if her wide draw doesn't inconvenience her.
10	PRINCE AMER	Consistent veteran who finished fifth of 18 over track and trip in a 0-80 handicap last month. Could run another place.
14	AL AMBHRA	Secured a second career success when scoring off 4lb lower over track and trip last month. Not without a chance of following up.
20	NAAME	Unexposed performer who wasn't beaten far by Al Ambhra over course and distance two weeks ago. Don't discount him.

RACE 8 12:00 AM | SAR85,000 | RIYADH | 2000m

3	ALNISHAAR	Produced a huge career-best performance when upped to this trip in maiden company two weeks ago. Dangerous now in a handicap.
8	KAFOO KAREEM	Third of 20 in a 0-70 handicap over 1800m two weeks ago. Boasts winning course-and-distance form and could repeat the feat.
12	ALBRONZE	Strong-staying type who finished third of 19 in a 1600m maiden on his penultimate outing. Not as good in Open company last time but dangerous to overlook in this field.
4	IBN HADHBAAN	A six-time winner who has dropped to an attractive mark and has indicated a win is around the corner.

RACE 9 12:25 AM | SAR120,000 | RIYADH | 2000m

3	MR TRINKET	Highly tried gelding who is rounding into form and wasn't disgraced when sixth of 16 over course and distance last month. Leading player.
2	MOORE'S LAW	Smart US import with winning form at Saratoga. Yet to score locally after four attempts but has shaped fairly over longer trips.
4	MY FRANKEL	Talented veteran who won Group 1 races in 2022 and 2023. Hasn't scored since and might be preparing for a turf campaign.
1	BAROQUE BUOY	UK import who recorded his first local success in a 0-85 handicap over 1600m at Taif in September. Should relish the return to this trip but does he have the quality to win?

RACE 10 12:50 AM | SAR165,000 | RIYADH | 1600m

1	AL HARAM	Overcame a slow start to make an impressive winning debut over course and distance. Open to plenty of improvement and should play a part.
2	AL THARB	Built on a solid debut at Taif by running out an easy course-and-distance winner here in October. Should be capable of challenging for the win.
4	ALHISHAM	Emphatic debut winner over course and distance last month. This \$400,000 purchase is deserted by Camilo Ospina but should be on your shortlist.
3	ALAQEEQ	Looked professional in victory over track and trip last month. Leading rider takes over and must be feared.

RACE 11 **1:20 AM** | SAR85,000 | **RIYADH** | **1600m**

1	ALAEWAAGEE	Second of 20 in this grade off a 2lb lower mark here last week. That was over 2400m and this is a big drop in trip, but he is bang in form.
11	AURAL	Third of 18 behind Alaewaagee here in October off 3lb higher. Shaped well in a couple of sprints and now steps back up in trip.
2	HEZAAM	Ran herself into form at Taif this summer and ended that campaign with a runner-up finish over 1600m. Same trip, same mark and should play a part.
15	ALAJWAH	Second of 18 behind Alaewaagee here in October, finishing ahead of Aural in the process. Now races off a 1lb lower mark.
