| 4  | ALROOZ ALAHMR | Not beaten far when fourth of 17 over track and trip here last week. Quickly turned out and drawn well again.  |

| 1 | ABEYYAH            | All four starts over 1400m but she clearly has the speed to compete over this shorter distance. Gutsy in victory in an Open last time and should be tough to hold. |
| 4 | LAE OYOUN MASHA'EL | Only 14th of 19 in a 0-75 handicap over 1400m here last week. Finished well when fourth of 18 over this trip on her penultimate start.                             |

**RACE 3 9:25 PM | SAR75,000 | RIYADH | 1200m**

| 7 | ARTAJIL        | Speedy colt who should be well suited by this drop in trip. Unexposed and represents leading connections, so must have a good chance.  |
| 4 | IBN ALREEB     | Clearcut second over 1400m here last week. Stays in the same grade off an identical mark and should go close to making all.            |
| 2 | NASEER ALENAYA | Course-and-distance winner at this level in February 2025. Yet to win in four starts this term but is back down to an attractive mark. |
| 5 | MITOLEYA       | Made some late headway to finish fourth of 18 over 1400m here seven days ago. Dropped 2lb for that effort.                             |

| 9  | KHABAYA   | Placed in a conditions race over course and distance and looks to boast the best form. Winless from eight starts but should go close.    |
| 11 | LIQAAT    | Speedy type who finished second of 17 over track and trip four weeks ago. Not disgraced last time and should be dangerous in this field. |

| 4  | ASHJAA ALSAYED     | Plugged on to pass tired rivals when fourth of 11 over 1200m last week. Needs more to win this.   |

**RACE 6 10:50 PM | SAR650,000 | RIYADH | 1400m**

| 1  | SALAT SUYOF    | Two-time course winner over 1200m this season. Should stay this longer trip but hasn't drawn well.  |
| 14 | ROGHM ALDHROOF | Interesting participant given she failed to stay 1600m on her penultimate start and lacked the necessary speed to compete over 1200m last time.   |
| 3  | TMADY          | Impressive debut winner over course and distance and shouldn't be dismissed now upped in grade.   |

**RACE 7 11:20 PM | SAR650,000 | RIYADH | 1600m**

| 2  | ABO SAEED         | Caused a massive shock by finishing third of 17 in the Group 1 King Abdullah Cup in December. Only 13th here last time and could be vulnerable. |
| 7  | AZIZ FAHAD        | Nicely bred type with a progressive profile. Runner-up in a 1400m conditions event last time and cannot be totally dismissed.                   |

| 15 | NHALINZA       | Sixth of 12 over course and distance here last week. Quickly turned out again in a slightly easier race.      |
| 6  | NOFAT AL ZAMAN | Top-rated mare in this line-up but she hasn't managed to replicate her French form on this surface yet.       |

| 2  | ALASHQARI     | Endured a wide trip when third of 20 over 1600m here three weeks ago. Drawn much better this time and should play a leading role.              |
| 3  | ALBAAJEY      | Deep-closing type who has finished well over 1400m and this trip on his last two starts. Place candidate.                                      |

| 5  | FHRI          | Fifth of 18 over 1400m here last week. Not a prolific type but capable of competing at this level.   |
| 10 | MOTAMASEK     | Last of 20 in a 0-75 handicap here in December. Capable of better and shouldn't be far away.   |

| 1 | AHMADY        | Just one win from 25 starts and most recently finished 11th of 20 in a conditions race over 1800m. Prefers longer trips but now down in grade. |
| 4 | MEZN ALSAHAAB | Lightly raced mare whose sole success came over track and trip. Fifth of 19 in a 0-70 handicap last time and not without a chance here.        |
| 2 | BAHR ALENAYA  | Third of 18 in a course-and-distance maiden here last week. Interesting runner on handicap debut.  |
