**Seoul Race 4: Class 5 (1300M) Handicap / KRW 45 Million**

(8) JANGBI DAEUN got her maiden win in fine style at stat number two over 1200M back on May 19<sup>th</sup> pulling away to win by a full thirteen-lengths in a quick time. She comes up in class and races for the first time in ten weeks, but the manner of that victory makes her hard to oppose here. (2) NAVY CHROME got her maiden win three starts back and has since run 2<sup>nd</sup> in two tries at this class, both over the 1400M. From a great draw, she can be expected to set the pace here and can be in the finish again. (4) DANGCHAN NANGBO is finally up in class after fifteen goes around in class 6. Her latest three have seen her place at this distance and under a light weight, she can be coming from off the pace and running into the money again. (1) SMART CAT and (9) THUNDER BRAVO other placing chances.

**Seoul Race 5: Class 5 (1200M) Handicap / KRW 45 Million**

Fillies only here. (9) CHILSAN DAEGYO arrives having won at this class and distance in a similar all-filly race on June 8<sup>th</sup> when racing handy throughout and stopping the clock in a much quicker time than any of the others here have posted. The same apprentice who won on her claims 4kg again, keeping her in under a light weight and she can go back-to-back. (1) MINT PLAY beat three of these on her way to 2<sup>nd</sup> at class and distance on June 23<sup>rd</sup>. She remains a maiden after fifteen attempts, but her recent form reads well, and she can be there or thereabouts again. (4) BRIGHT KAI was a somewhat surprising winner on June 15<sup>th</sup> over 1300M when on pace throughout. She comes up in class here but is down in the weights and can measure up at what should be an each-way price. (6) MO CHUISLE and (3) LADY CODI are others to consider.

### Seoul Race 6: Class 4 (1400M) Handicap / KRW 60 Million

(2) SPARK THUNDER has won two of her latest three, most recently at this class over 1300M on June 2<sup>nd</sup>. She stays under a relatively light weight, she draws well, and the slight step up in trip can suit. (8) KNIGHT CHARM comes rapidly up in class, having won his latest two both over 1300M and both times showing on pace throughout. He comes down in the weights and can lead again and having already placed over this distance, the step back up to 1400M should be no problem. (1) QUEEN TOP enters off back-to-back 3<sup>rd</sup> place finished over 1300M and a mile. Nicely drawn and weighted, she will be in the mix again. (9) LOVE COWGIRL and (11) ENDING FIRE are other possibles.

### Seoul Race 7: Class 3 (1600M) Handicap / KRW 75 Million

(5) GLADIUS was an also -ran in the first leg of the Triple Tiara in April but has been in good form since, with a win at 1400M followed by a strong runner-up finish on her first try at this class over a mile on June 30<sup>th</sup> when she led a race that ultimately finished with the track record being set. Form a central gate, she can lead again, and this time can go all the way. (9) SPEED ONE is a winner of four from six and all of his last three. He comes up in class but is down significantly in the weights and Moon Se-young, who is three for three on him, stays aboard. (4) SUNNY ROAD has won two of his latest three to come up rapidly in class. His latest was his first try at a mile on June 23<sup>rd</sup> when leading all the way and down in the weights and drawn well, he can measure up. (8) VIKING HEART and (2) GEOLJAK ONE are among plenty of others in at least the placing frame.

### Seoul Race 8: Class 4 (1700M) Handicap / KRW 60 Million

(9) CHOEGANG TIME returned from five months off in early June to win over 1200M, making all. He promptly followed up on June 29<sup>th</sup> at 1300M, this time settling handy and pulling clear late. That brings him rapidly up in class and while he doesn't benefit from an apprentice claim this time around, he can win again. (8) SPECIAL HILL has run 3<sup>rd</sup> in two starts at this class, most recently over this distance on June 29<sup>th</sup>. He has won at 1700M at a lower level and with Moon Se-young climbing on, he may well start as favourite. That will mean overturning the form on (7) BARAMUI GEOM, who ran 2<sup>nd</sup> in that June 29<sup>th</sup> race, coming from well off the pace. He'll settle back again here and can be a danger late. (5) POWER ETCHED and (4) BIG SMART others in the placing frame.

### Seoul Race 9: Class 2 (1800M) Handicap / KRW 90 Million

(8) BLACK BELT led from gate to wire to score at this class on June 29<sup>th</sup> on what was his first try at this level. An apprentice is engaged today which means he stays under the same light weight and a repeat is possible. (1) DRAGON STAR ran a close 2<sup>nd</sup> in that race having previously been 4<sup>th</sup> in the Listed Sports Chosun Trophy in May. He has won at this distance, and it would be no surprise if he was sent off as the betting favourite to overturn the form on Black Belt. (4) SPO BLADE was 4<sup>th</sup> in the June 23<sup>rd</sup> race, settling midfield and running on. He has sixteen to-five finishes from twenty starts and can be in the mix again. (6) RAON THE ARIA along with the up in class (11) WONPYEONG LIST are others to consider.
