3rd Pick: PACIFIC HERO (1)

Dropping back from the G2 Three-Year-Old Classic where he led from a wide draw but dropped off sharply at the end. His performance before that will see him as a leading player in this lineup.

4th Pick: IMA (7)

Can pop up when you least expect him to. Will settle back in the field and if they go hard up in front early on he can rattle over the top of them late. Multiples player.
