

RACE 1 6:00 PM | AED50,000 | **JEBEL ALI** | 1000m

6	MEN BU DHABI AL HAZER (AE)	Consistent performer with two strong 1400m seconds on turf; showed pace in previous 1000m dirt run and, despite the wide gate, looks the one they all have to beat.
13	FARAH BAYNOUNAH (AE)	Good second over 1200m earlier in the year and has displayed consistent speed; drawn well and capable of giving a bold sight at 1000m.
12	BAHIYYA (AE)	Has run some honest races over 1400–1600m; back to 1000m and drawn favourably, can finish off well if pace suits.
1	AASIR (AE)	Back to 1000m for this 4YO+ race; has placed 4th three times over similar trips, but will need to lift against stronger class.
14	KRESTALA (AE)	Ran respectably over 1400m and 1600m earlier in the year; back to sprinting and capable of finishing on for a minor prize.

RACE 2 6:30 PM | AED100,000 | **JEBEL ALI** | 1400m

1	QUARTIER (URU)	Useful sprinter-miler with strong overall record; drops in grade from tougher Meydan company and, despite recent below-par runs, looks well placed to bounce back over 1400m.
2	ELJENOB (FR)	Consistent performer who has placed here over 1600m; racing well in recent starts on both surfaces and should be competitive again back to 1400m.
4	FIGHT ZONE (USA)	In good form with recent wins and placings over 1000–1400m; drawn well and capable of another solid showing at this distance.
3	YAA WALE (IRE)	French import with consistent European form; showed promise in France over a mile and first local run should offer improvement with experience.
5	GUARANI (USA)	Good effort when second over 1200m here two starts ago; up in trip and class but form is sound enough to claim a minor placing.

RACE 3 7:00 PM | AED72,000 | **JEBEL ALI** | 1200m

1	ASHWAAN (USA)	Debuted with an impressive trial earlier this month, showing sharp early speed; draws well again and looks the one they all have to beat.
4	MARAPAT (USA)	Sound trial effort finishing a close fourth; should come on with that experience and poses a strong threat stepping up to 1200m.
5	RAKAAN (USA)	Runner-up on debut trial and showed natural ability; form suggests another competitive showing here.
6	SHAYESH (USA)	Strong second on debut trial and wasn't far away; should be suited by the step up to 1200m and remains in the mix.
8	WATCH COLLECTOR (USA)	Finished close up when fourth at a trial; improving type who may finish off well with further experience.

RACE 4 7:30 PM | AED72,000 | **JEBEL ALI** | 1200m

5	ON THE WAY (USA)	Consistent type with two good 2nds at Jebel Ali in similar company; form reads well for the step back to 1200m and looks ready to break through.
6	PIPES AND DRUMS (GB)	Ran well over 1200m on turf last start and has been competitive in dirt maidens; with natural improvement can make his presence felt.
8	ROYALCORRESPONDENT (IRE)	Good 2nd over 1000m here earlier this month; stepping back up to 1200m and remains one of the more consistent chances.
4	MUZAAHIM (USA)	Placed 3rd over 1000m last start showing early speed; should be competitive again with more experience at 1200m.
2	MNAWISH (USA)	Two honest 4ths in recent starts including here over 1000m; stepping back to 1200m and capable of producing a forward run.

RACE 5 8:00 PM | AED120,000 | **JEBEL ALI** | 1000m

1	BILLY WEBSTER (IRE)	Classy sprinter with strong 1000–1200m credentials; drops in grade after contesting Listed races at Meydan and looks well placed to return to form over this sharp trip.
2	DESPERATE HERO (GB)	Has completed in Group races at Meydan and holds solid sprint form; suited returning to 1000m at Jebel Ali and rates a major chance.
3	AL SHIBLI (GB)	In good form with a recent Meydan win over 1000m; handles dirt well and shall be finishing strongly.
6	ZANDVOORT (USA)	Good 3rd over 1000m here last start and continues to improve; carries competitive weight and can feature again.
4	RABAAH (IRE)	Lightly raced sprinter resuming from UK turf form; may need this first local run but has the quality to pick up a minor placing.

RACE 6 8:30 PM | AED120,000 | **JEBEL ALI** | 1800m

1	ELRAAED (GB)	Strong winner over 1400m here last start and proven in higher-grade dirt handicaps; rising to 1800m but racing in top form and looks the one to beat.
3	PRINC ROUZ (RUS)	Consistent middle-distance performer with solid 2000m–2400m form; handles dirt well and dropping back to 1800m should see him run prominently.
5	DELOREAN (IRE)	Runner-up over 1600m here in March and generally reliable around this distance range; drawn well and capable of another strong effort.
2	KING OF TIME (IRE)	Quality performer on turf with multiple wins over 1600–1800m; dirt is a query but class will help and a forward showing would not surprise.
4	ARAGON CASTLE (IRE)	Well proven in UK handicaps and has run fairly in Meydan this season; if adapting to Jebel Ali dirt, can be competitive for a minor placing.

RACE 7 9:00 PM | AED86,000 | **JEBEL ALI** | 1950m

2	FAYADH (USA)	Strong 2nd over 1600m here earlier this month and shaping as though the rise to 1950m will suit; in good form and looks ready to go one better.
5	GUN CREW (USA)	Game 3rd over 1800m last start behind the re-opposing winner; consistent at similar trips and rates a major contender again.
1	GOLDSPUR (IRE)	Impressive winner over 1800m here last start, showing strong staying ability; up in weight but remains a key chance over 1950m.
7	POSTER PAINT (IRE)	Consistent in recent turf runs including a close 3rd over 1800m at Meydan; if transferring that form to dirt, can be competitive.
3	DECIDUOUS (GB)	Placed over 2400m earlier in the season and has been racing in stronger company; step down in class gives him a chance to run on late.
