RACE 1: BRITISH EBF FILLIES' NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 4) (2YO ONLY)

YELLOW DIAMONDS - HAVIN A FLYER - TEA QUEEN

Race Preview: YELLOW DIAMONDS has run with plenty of credit since joining the Kevin Philippart De Foy yard and she looks the one to beat if building upon a strong runner-up effort at Southwell. Havin A Flyer has sound claims if bouncing back to the form of her seconds over C&D, while Tea Queen can be expected to perform better than her disappointing debut effort when sent off an odds-on favourite at Beverley.

3	WITH GLORY	Foaled 10 Mar. Half-sister to Mekhled, won at 6f. Unplaced in both starts. Beaten 7l behind March Ahead at 11-1 when last of 7 on her latest outing at Carlisle over 6f (good to firm) in August.
4	YELLOW DIAMONDS	Foaled 20 Feb. Placed twice in four starts. Beaten 2l by Hypnotised when second of 8 at 11-2 on her latest outing at Southwell over 5f last month.

RACE 2: 75MEDIA EDINBURGH GATEWAY GALLOP HANDICAP (CLASS 6) (3YO PLUS)

FILEY BEACH - AHAMOMENT - JESMOND DAWN

Race Preview: FILEY BEACH did it well when scoring comfortably from the reopposing Ahamoment (second) over C&D and, despite being 3lb worse off at the weights, Ruth Carr's charge looks well capable of upholding the form. High on the shortlist after strong placed efforts the last twice, Jesmond Dawn is 4lb lower than for his last success, while 2024 winner The Gay Blade is another to note.

3	AHAMOMENT	He has won four times at 7f on good to firm and good ground and on the all-weather. Third of 9 behind Albeyours beaten 3 1/2l at 9-4fav on his latest outing at Leicester over 7f (good to soft) last month.
4	JESMOND DAWN	Successful at 6f and 1m on good to firm ground. Beaten 1 3/4l by Fire Eyes when second of 12 at 4-1 on his latest outing at Redcar over 7f (good to soft) last month.
5	COMMANDER ATKINSON	Placed twice in 12 starts. Finished 5l behind Beerwah when fifth of 9 at 12-1 on his latest outing at Beverley over 5f (soft) last month.

6	FILEY BEACH	Successful twice at 7f on good and good to soft ground. Won on his latest outing when 10-3fav over this course and distance (good to soft) last month, beating Ahamoment by 1 1/2l. Has also won at Catterick this season.
7	GOLDEN VALOUR	Winner of five races from 7f to 1m 3f on ground varying from good to firm to good to soft and on the all-weather. Finished 2l behind Penelope's Sister when fifth of 9 at 13-2 on his latest outing at Ayr over 1m (soft) last month.
8	THE GAY BLADE	Winner of six races from 6f to 7f on good and good to soft ground and on the all-weather. Third of 6 behind Green Valentine beaten 2l at 11-4 on his latest outing at Hamilton over 6f (soft) last month.
9	MONHAMMER	He has won four times at 7f on ground varying from good to firm to good to soft. Beaten 3 1/2l by Highland Olly when second of 9 at 15-2 on his latest outing over this course and distance (good) in August.
10	ON THE BUBBLE	A winner at 1m on soft ground; has also won a hurdle. Beaten 7l behind Second Fiddle at 17-2 when seventh of 9 on her latest outing at Hamilton over 1m (soft) last month.
11	IGNAC LAMAR	Winner of five races from 6f to 7f on good to firm ground and on the all-weather. Finished 4 1/2l behind Filey Beach when fifth of 10 at 9-1 on his latest outing over this course and distance (good to soft) last month. Has won at Hamilton and Southwell this season.
12	YELLOW LEMONS	Yet to place in 12 starts. Beaten 10l behind Golden Valour at 28-1 when 9th of 11 on her latest outing here over 1m (good) last month.

RACE 3: RACING TV NURSERY (CLASS 5) (2YO ONLY)

LYRICAL SONG - WILLOWINGHURN - SAILOR BATT

Race Preview: A career-best second over C&D last time out when he had Panthere Noir a position behind, LYRICAL SONG could be well treated off a mark of 70 on his nursery debut and he can go one better. Runner-up on his last two starts, Willowinghurn is entitled to be thereabouts again on the step back up in trip, while Sailor Batt attempts to build upon a strong effort over 6f at Redcar last week.

3	PANTHERE NOIR	Foaled 3 Apr. Placed once in five starts. Third of 10 behind Suddenly I See beaten 1 1/4l at 22-1 on his latest outing over this course and distance (good) last month.
4	WILLOWINGHURN	Foaled 15 May. A winner at 6f on good to firm ground. Beaten 1 1/2l by Mossvale Diva when second of 10 at 7-2 on her latest outing at Redcar over 6f (good) last month.
5	SAILOR BATT	Foaled 13 Feb. Placed once in four starts. Beaten 1 1/4l by Soul Warrior when second of 14 at 11-2 on his latest outing at Redcar over 6f (good to soft) last month.

6	RESDEV TIME	Foaled 16 Jan. Placed once in three starts. Third of 8 behind Caim beaten 4 1/2l at 8-1 on her latest outing at Beverley over 7f (soft) last month.
7	CIAO CAPO	Foaled 4 Apr. Unplaced in all three starts. Well beaten at 150-1 behind Simplify when 15th of 16 on his latest outing at Thirsk over 6f (good) last month.

EMPIRESTATEOFMIND - I AM ME - CANNON ROCK

Race Preview: It is difficult to oppose EMPIRESTATEOFMIND, who holds outstanding claims on these terms. The seven-year-old was just touched off in a similar event at Chester when conceding 9lb to the winner and, with much less to prove than his rivals, this looks a good opportunity. C&D winner I Am Me could be the main danger, while Cannon Rock appeals most of the remaining duo.

3	I AM ME	A winner at 1m 1f on good ground. Beaten 10l behind Mawood at 14-1 when eighth of 10 on his latest outing at Redcar over 1m 2f (good to soft) last month.
4	BINT AL KARAMA	Successful at 1m and 1m 1f on good ground. Well beaten at 40-1 behind Cisco Disco when last of 9 on her latest outing at Ayr over 1m (soft) last month.
