RACE 1:VICKERS.BET APPRENTICE HANDICAP

Arthalot Asense It's How We Roll

The hat-trick seeking Asense must enter calculations in her current mood, although there are grounds to take the four-year-old on now encountering her most testing conditions to date. With that in mind, it may be worth taking a chance on the returning ARTHALOT, who won under similar conditions off a 1lb lower mark at Lingfield in May 2021. It's How We Roll arrives in good form and is another to note.

- 1 BEGGARMAN He has won three times from 1m 6f to 2m on the all-weather. Beaten 19l behind Lusaka at 15-2 when 10th of 14 on his latest outing here over 1m 6f (good to soft) last month.
- 2 IMPERIAL CULT Placed in four of nine starts. Beaten 2 1/4l by Sophar Sogood when second of 11 at 7-1 on his latest outing at Kempton over 2m last month.

Dallas Star and Calvert are others who arrive here with valid form claims, while Flowering is a newcomer to note. Palace Green unseated his rider at the start on his racecourse bow at Newbury and he should not be underestimated.
