However, a chance is taken on course winner BONNE VITESSE, who ran well here on her penultimate start. The daughter of Fast Company is well treated at the weights with the three-year-old allowance and has an ideal draw. Temper Trap is turned out again quickly after his recent success at Hamilton but will have to carry a 5lb penalty. International Law and Straight Ash also warrant respect if translating their all-weather form.

Skittlebombz also has claims but has a wide draw to overcome, while Rambuso Creek and Ravenglass could fare best of the newcomers.
