Orbital Chime Danger Alert Georgiava

A trappy affair to get proceedings underway on Town Moor, so only a tentative vote goes to ORBITAL CHIME. James Horton's charge made light work of testing conditions when winning at Redcar last month and, though an 8lb rise in the weights will make life tougher, there could be more to come. Danger Alert must be of interest ahead of his handicap debut along with Georgiava, who finished a good fourth in a competitive event at Newmarket on her latest outing.

Although Darmoiselle hasn't shown the same level of form as some of her rivals, she is open to improvement.
