## Keep Bidding Cuban Grey Matching Sox

KEEP BIDDING arrives with the best form after a debut second at Nottingham followed by a fourth in the Woodcote, when starting slowly and keeping on over the sixth furlong. She may make the most of a drop in class here and put her experience to good use. Cuban Grey looks an interesting newcomer as a son of Havana Grey and is worth a market watch, along with Matching Sox, who is related to numerous winners.
