Candy Rain finished two places behind the selection on the Rowley Mile that day and should know more this time, while newcomer Lady Hollywood is a daughter of promising first-season sire Havana Grey and is also worth noting.

Mokaman returned to winning ways at Musselburgh on his latest start and could make a bold bid, while Cuppacoco may prove a different proposition with the blinkers back on and cannot be discounted either.

A chance is taken on GO FOX, who was not beaten far at Thirsk on his latest outing. The gelding's prominent style of racing should be beneficial at a venue that can often favour horses up with the pace, while a 2lb ease in the handicap could see him to greater effect. Haven Lady remains unexposed at this trip and is considered despite her wide draw. Belvedere Blast is fit from a run over hurdles at Hexham last month and enters calculations back in this sphere.

- 3 THIRD AVENUE A winner at 1m 6f on good ground. Well beaten at 15-2 behind Vita Veritas when eighth of 18 on his latest outing at Galway over 1m 4f (heavy) in October last year. Having his first run for a new stable today, previously with John C McConnell in Ireland.
