RACE 1: DOWNLOAD THE AT THE RACES APP APPRENTICE CLASSIFIED STAKES

Tulane Pump It Up Double Legend

Some pretty uninspiring form figures here, but TULANE was a good third at Chepstow two starts ago and although he's disappointed at Kempton since, he makes the most appeal here. Pump It Up should be monitored closely in the betting on his debut for Michael Roberts after a break, while Double Legend has form that would give him a solid chance if he's ready to go here after a seven-month absence.

- 2 DOUBLE LEGEND He has won three times at 1m 4f on polytrack. Beaten 7l behind Capricorn Prince at 14-1 when seventh of 11 on his latest outing here over 1m 4f in January.
- 3 LONGVILLE LILLY Placed once in 14 starts. Beaten 13l behind Infiniti at 33-1 when eighth of 13 on her latest outing at Chepstow over 2m (good) in June.

She made a winning start here on the turf in May and if in the same form after a break, she looks capable of winning again. Hoof It Hoof It was well supported in the market in both of her starts and could be the one to fill the frame here.

Inclement Weather looks to recoup losses after coming home fourth when favourite at Kempton in June.
