RACE 1: BET 10 GET 40 WITH BETMGM HANDICAP (CLASS 6) (4YO PLUS) (FROM LINGFIELD RACE 2)

PROFIT STREET - ASHFORD HILL - GLOBAL WARNING

Race Preview: Ashford Hill showed the benefit of a break to score over C&D last month and whilst a 3lb rise looks fair, PROFIT STREET might be the answer. The Profitable gelding's latest win came over 6f at Wolverhampton in December but he's been lacking an extra gear over that trip in recent starts, so this additional furlong could be exactly what he needs now. Veteran Global Warning appeals most of the remainder.

1	PROFIT STREET	He has won three times from 5f to 7f on the all-weather. Finished 2l behind Betties Bay when fourth of 11 at 10-1 on his latest outing at Southwell over 6f last month.
2	TAM LIN	He has won three times from 7f to 1m including 2 wins on polytrack. Finished 4 1/2l behind Al Waqidi when sixth of 8 at 9-1 on his latest outing at Chelmsford City over 1m last month.
3	GLOBAL WARNING	Winner of six races from 6f to 7f on the all-weather (1 PO). Finished 1 1/2l behind Poke The Bear when fourth of 8 at 5-2fav on his latest outing over this course and distance last month.
4	SEMSER	Winner of five races from 1m to 1m 4f on polytrack. Third of 8 behind Rising Force beaten 2l at 16-1 on his latest outing here over 1m last month.
5	RUMBA BAY	She has won three times from 6f to 7f including 2 wins on the all-weather (1 PO). Finished 3 1/2l behind Big Bard when fifth of 9 at 10-1 on her latest outing at Kempton over 6f last month.
6	ASHFORD HILL	Successful twice at 7f on polytrack. A winner at 16-1 over this course and distance on her latest outing last month, beating Cuban Fiesta by 1 1/4l.
7	WORLD OF DARCY	Winner of five races from 5f to 6f. Finished 7l behind Poke The Bear when fifth of 9 at 11-1 on his latest outing here over 1m last month.
8	EMPEROR'S LOGIC	Yet to place in five starts. Well beaten at 125-1 behind How's The Guvnor when last of 12 on his latest outing at Southwell over 1m last month.

RACE 2: MIDNITE, BUILDING THE FUTURE OF BETTING HANDICAP (CLASS 4) (4YO PLUS) (FROM LINGFIELD RACE 3)

FIDELIUS - STAR CHORUS - TOOLATETONEGOTIATE

Race Preview: Star Chorus nearly backed up last month's Southwell win with a C&D success but ultimately came out third best in a tight finish. Mike Murphy's charge looks sure to launch another strong challenge, but FIDELIUS could be too strong. The Harry Angel gelding has posted a couple of creditable efforts in two 0-95 contests recently and can show his class in these calmer waters. Conversely, Toolatetonegotiate steps up in class following a narrow C&D triumph, but she should not be underestimated.

2	STAR CHORUS	He has won four times at 5f including 3 wins on the all-weather. Third of 8 behind Atomic Force beaten 1/2l at 4-1 on his latest outing over this course and distance last month.
3	NOGO'S DREAM	He has won four times at 5f including 2 wins on the all-weather (1 PO). Finished 10l behind Another Baar when fifth of 8 at 16-1 on his latest outing at Goodwood over 5f (heavy) in September last year.
4	DIOMED SPIRIT	Winner of six races at 5f on the all-weather (4 PO). Finished 2l behind Atomic Force when fifth of 8 at 13-2 on his latest outing over this course and distance last month.
5	TOOLATETONEGOTIATE	She has won three times at 5f on polytrack. A winner at 11-4 over this course and distance on her latest outing last month, beating Lequinto by a head.

FIRST ENCOUNTER - UNKNOWN JOURNEY - GALETTE

Race Preview: A drop into classified company proved just the tonic for recent Wolverhampton winner FIRST ENCOUNTER. The five-year-old should have more to offer at this level and a switch to Polytrack is unlikely to prevent another bold bid. Galette arrives on the back of a respectable third at Dunstall Park, but consistency hasn't been her strong suit in the past. With that in mind a bigger threat may emerge from Unknown Journey, who hit the frame over C&D 12 days ago.

2	EYE OF THE WATER	Has won eight races from 6f to 1m including 2 wins on the all-weather, but last win was over two years ago. Finished 4l behind How's The Guvnor when fifth of 9 at 33-1 on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 7f last month.
3	FIRST ENCOUNTER	He has won four times from 1m to 1m 2f including 2 wins on the all-weather (1 PO). A winner at 9-2 at Wolverhampton over 1m 1f on his latest outing last month, beating Bossy Parker by a neck.
4	GALETTE	Placed twice in 16 starts. Third of 10 behind Von Krolock beaten 4 1/2l at 80-1 on her latest outing at Wolverhampton over 7f earlier this month.
5	RAINBOW SIGN	He has won three times from 7f to 1m including 2 wins on polytrack. Finished 6l behind Celtic John when sixth of 11 at 25-1 on his latest outing over this course and distance last month.
6	ROSEMARY'S ROSE	Unplaced in all ten starts. Beaten 15l behind Timely Affair at 12-1 when 11th of 12 on her latest outing at Southwell over 1m last month.
7	SENSEOFENTITLEMENT	A winner at 1m 1f on the all-weather, but that win was over two years ago. Beaten 15l behind Birthday Angel at 250-1 when eighth of 10 on his latest outing at Brighton over 1m 2f (good to soft) in October last year.
8	UNKNOWN JOURNEY	Placed once in 18 starts. Third of 9 behind Poke The Bear beaten 5l at 12-1 on his latest outing over this course and distance last month, his only placing from 18 starts.

ANGELICA K - TILSWORTH MAX - WRIST ART

Race Preview: Having finished third behind a subsequent winner over 7f here recently, Tilsworth Max must enter calculations in his current heart. However, the six-year-old has yet to convince with his stamina over a mile, and it could be worth chancing ANGELICA K. Simon Hodgson's mare finished a respectable fifth in handicap company at Kempton last month and a similar performance may prove sufficient. Wrist Art is the pick of the remainder.

3	HEADSHOT	He has won four times from 1m to 1m 1f including 3 wins on the all-weather. Beaten 4 1/2l behind Captain Pickles at 10-1 when seventh of 10 on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 1m 1f last month.
4	LISABETTA	She has won three times from 7f to 1m 1f including a win on polytrack, but last win was over two years ago. Beaten 17l behind Blackjack Hills at 22-1 when 10th of 15 on her latest outing at Gowran Park over 1m (heavy) in October last year. Having her first run for a new stable today.
5	NICELY CURVED	Placed once in nine starts. Beaten 16l behind Last Call Paul at 22-1 when 9th of 11 on her latest outing at Del Mar over 5f in August last year. Having her first run for a new stable today, previously with Neil Drysdale in United States.
6	SPIRIT CHARMER	Placed once in 13 starts. Finished 7l behind Tilsworth Max when sixth of 9 at 50-1 on her latest outing here over 7f last month.
7	TILSWORTH MAX	A winner at 7f on polytrack. Third of 9 behind Royal Jet beaten 4 1/2l at 15-2 on his latest outing here over 7f last month.
8	WRIST ART	Successful at 1m and 1m 1f, but last win was over two years ago. Well beaten at 4-1 behind I Can Boogy when last of 8 on his latest outing at Newcastle over 1m earlier this month.
