Pure Charmer was only beaten a length off a mark of 60 two starts ago and she is clearly the main threat to the selection. The rest do not inspire a lot of confidence but Golden Prosperity is arguably the pick of them.

The mare is turned out quickly under a 5lb penalty and could take all the beating if returning in the same form. Stablemate Twin Appeal cannot be dismissed either, while multiple C&D winner Kylie Rules should mount a bold bid following a third-placed finish on the Westwood earlier this month.
