RACE 1: BETVICTOR CARNARVON STAKES (LISTED)

Ehraz	Tiber Flow	Hierarchy

EHRAZ bounced back from an underwhelming display in the Acomb at York when shaping as though he needed his return when third in the Pavillion at Ascot. Richard Hannon's colt travelled nicely before tiring in the final furlong and, with that run under his belt, the son of Showcasing is expected to step forward, with this flatter track potentially aiding his cause, and reverse the form with the runner-up from that contest, Hierarchy. Tiber Flow was just denied in his attempt to maintain his unbeaten record at Newcastle and he warrants plenty of respect on his turf debut, while the aforementioned Hierarchy and Cadamosto appear best of the remainder.

SCOPE improved plenty at the back end of last season when running out an impressive winner at Ascot in October before following up in the Prix Royal-Oak at Longchamp later that month. Despite having to give away a Group 1 penalty to the opposition, this appears to be a suitable opportunity for the son of Teofilo to make a winning return to action. Eshaada won on Champions Day at Ascot and she could have more to offer on just her sixth career start, while Ilaraab is likely to improve from his C&D return last month.

ISRAR is bred in the purple, being out an Oaks winner, and he remains on the same mark as his handicap debut when third behind a couple of progressive types at Newmarket. John and Thady Gosden's colt has the potential to improve and in a contest that has thrown up Pattern-class individuals over the years, with six of the last seven winners going on to succeed at Group level, it wouldn't be a surprise to see him continue that trend. Surrey Mist has won twice on the all-weather following his sole juvenile effort and he is likely to enter the reckoning along with Mr Big Stuff, who travelled notably well when second on his return at Nottingham, and Luminous Light.

The return of the brilliant BAAEED makes this a fascinating renewal and, after ending last year as the joint-highest rated miler in the world, the question will be, just how high can the son of Sea The Stars go this season? Given he only started his career last June and has just six starts to his name, it is fair to assume that there may be more to come and he can extend his unbeaten record here en route to a likely outing at Royal Ascot, where connections may be tempted to test him above a mile for the first time. In the event that he fails to fire, the classy Real World, who should prove a different proposition back on turf, and last year's 1000 Guineas winner Mother Earth can pick up the pieces.
