RACE 1: CASUMO BET 10 GET 10 NOVICE STAKES (PLUS 10) (DIV 1)

Soundlikethunder Ensyaby Achelois

SOUNDSLIKETHUNDER took a big step forward when getting off the mark on his seasonal debut over 7f at Doncaster in late March and he should be hard to beat once again today, despite carrying a 6lb penalty. Ensyaby has shown promise in all four of his previous starts and he may improve for the first-time application of cheekpieces. Achelois was well held on her handicap debut earlier in the month but it would be no surprise to see her make the frame today.

Codify Gisburn Kingmax

Gisburn displayed plenty of promise when finishing fourth on his debut over 6f here last month but a chance can be taken with CODIFY. The son of Lawman lacks race experience but he is a half-brother to the dual Group 3 winner New Providence and he represents a yard who can get one ready first time. Kingmax cost 120,000 pounds as a yearling and his dam won a Group 2, albeit over 1m4f. Others to note are Golden War, Harrow and Seattle King.

Barbill May Sonic Beyond Equal

BARBILL made an encouraging return to action when finishing second at Kempton in late March and he arrives here just 2lb above his last winning mark. May Sonic has won twice on the all-weather already this year and he should go well if transferring that form to the turf, while Beyond Equal and Concierge are others who merit a place on the shortlist.

1 MAY SONIC Winner of five races from 6f to 7f on good to soft ground and on the all-weather. A winner at 7-2 at Chelmsford City over 6f on his latest outing last month, beating Aljady by a nose.

2 BARBILL Winner of five races from 5f to 6f on ground varying from good to firm to good - yielding. Beaten 2 1/4l by Great Ambassador when second of 7 at 11-1 on his latest outing at Kempton over 6f in March.

3 MAJOR JUMBO Winner of seven races from 5f to 6f on good to soft and soft ground and on the all-weather. Finished 3 1/2l behind Venturous when fifth of 6 at 7-1 on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 6f in March.

4 APLOMB He has won four times at 6f on good to soft and soft ground. Beaten 8l behind Tomfre at 9-1 when eighth of 15 on his latest outing at Doncaster over 7f (soft) in November last year. Having his first run for a new stable today, previously with W J Haggas.

5 TYPHOON TEN He has won three times from 6f to 7f on good to firm ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 6l behind Fresh at 22-1 when 14th of 18 on his latest outing at Ascot over 6f (good to soft) earlier this month.

Beheld Badlands Sunset

BEHELD was doing her best work late when making a winning debut over course and distance last summer and the Frankel filly could prove tough to beat now encountering slightly better ground. Badlands was an encouraging third at Newcastle last month and could be an improver, while Sunset didn't have the smoothest passage when starting out here in the autumn, but was staying on at the finish and is also noted, representing a top operation.

Potenza Zillion Party Island

The ultra-consistent POTENZA was not for catching once hitting the front at Chester last week and could quickly strike again off the same rating here having escaped a penalty for that victory in an apprentice riders' contest. Zillion stormed to a six-length victory over two miles at Chepstow recently and now drops back in trip following an 8lb rise. Callum Hutchinson takes over to negate 7lb of that burden with his claim, while Party Island looks to replicate his Lingfield success now returning to turf. City Tour, Byron Hill and Spring Glow are others who could get involved in a competitive event.
