Ajrad Royal Tribute Time Interval

AJRAD has placed in all five of his career outings so far and an aggressive ride could help the New Approach gelding to get off the mark here. The three-year-old probably doesn't have much in hand off a mark of 76, but front runners often do well here and there isn't much to fear in this opening contest. Royal Tribute didn't have a clear run when fourth at Nottingham last month and warrants respect along with Time Interval, who wears a first-time hood now dropped back to 7f.
