Snow Lantern Love Is You Creative Flair

Love Is You performed well for third on her reappearance in the Nell Gwyn at Newmarket (Divine Light sixth) and is closely matched with the Oh So Sharp third Shine For You on a line through Saffron Beach, form which looks strong after her second-placed effort in the 1000 Guineas. Creative Flair looks the pick of the Charlie Appleby runners judged on jockey bookings, and the Dubai Duty Free fourth and fifth Primo Bacio and Ville De Grace aren't out of this either. SNOW LANTERN gets the nod, though, as she looked a very smart filly when winning at Newbury.

Satono Japan and Blue Cup caught the eye in defeat during their respective seasonal returns and are considered, while United Front and Uzincso have both been in the very best of form on the all-weather and have to be respected.

Santiago was disappointing on his seasonal debut in the Group 3 Vintage Crop Stakes but a much better performance here would come as no surprise. However, Mark Johnston looks to have the strongest hand with consistent duo Nayef Road and SIR RON PRIESTLEY. The former wasn't far behind the legendary Stradivarius on his comeback run in the Group 3 Sagaro Stakes and he is likely to show up well again, but his hat-trick seeking stablemate Sir Ron Priestley looks the one to beat. Recent impressive victories at both Nottingham and Newmarket show him to be arriving in top form and he could bat off all challengers here.

TOM COLLINS wasn't at his best on stable debut at Thirsk earlier this month, but he was beaten less than six lengths despite finishing down the field and could bounce back on just his second start for William Haggas. The four-year-old is on a fair mark of 85 and could prove too strong for penalised Haydock winner Boardman, who wouldn't want the ground to dry out too much. Muntadab was second at Catterick 23 days ago and also appeals.
