Indication Ember Theatrically Englemere

There were plenty of positives to be taken from INDICATION EMBER's debut third in the Brocklesby at Doncaster last month. That experience could prove pivotal in a contest where Theatrically is the only other rival to have raced. Amy Murphy's charge was behind the selection in fifth that day and a subsequent close-up fourth at Kempton shouldn't prevent a prominent showing. Englemere, a half-sister to French Group 2 winner Family One, is the most intriguing of the newcomers and market support would be interesting.

However, the form of HUDDLE UP's reappearance third at Doncaster last month has worked out well, with three subsequent winners coming out from that event. The son of Anjaal edges the vote and a third career victory may well be imminent. Last-time-out winners Glory Fighter and J R Cavagin are sure to have their supporters too.

Little Venice and Likleman are also worth a second look.
