Macchiavello Lil Bit Of Magic Dirty Leeds

Dirty Leeds got loose before the start on his debut at this venue and he could be better than the bare result that day, but this race looks like it could be set up for one of the newcomers. The expensive two-year-old purchase MACCHIAVELLO particularly catches the eye as he has an attractive pedigree and his sire was Group 1-winning two-year-old. Lil Bit Of Magic is bred to be a sprinter so it would be no surprise if she can make an impact on debut as well.
